PAC Volleyball Player of the Week

RONNIE JO MEYERS Waynesburg College 5-8 senior outside hitter Windber, Pa./Windber H.S.

Meyers averaged 4.23 kills and 3.77 digs per game last week, as she led Waynesburg to a 4-0 record which extended the Yellow Jackets' win streak to 10 matches. She led the team in kills in three of the four matches. including 19 vs. Notre Dame, 12 against Bethany (with a season-high 21 digs) and 15 vs. Mount Aloysius.

Also nominated was senior MH Abbey Otto of Bethany, junior OH Kate DiMarco of Grove City, junior MH Jessica Erickson of Thiel, freshman S Jamie Gullen of Washington & Jefferson, and freshman MH Kate McDermott of Westminster.

Bethany Bison

The Bison dropped two PAC matches before defeating Chatham Saturday to end a six-game losing streak ... BC split the first two sets with Grove City before dropping the final two ... MH Abbey Otto posted a team-high 18 kills, while OH Shae Baxter totaled 16 kills and 13 digs on the night ... In the loss at Waynesburg, OH Peggy Emmerling led the team with eight kills, while Baxter had seven kills and nine digs ... The Green & White recovered from a loss in the first set to take three straight from Chatham at Homecoming Saturday... Otto paced the way with 18 kills and just two errors in 39 attacks, while Baxter registered 13 kills... Freshman Linzy Turner was solid with seven kills and 11 digs... Setter Brittany Vavrek collected 111 assists in the three matches.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

The Presidents split a pair of conference matches last week, falling at Waynesburg before defeating Westminster at the Henry Memorial Center on Thursday ... The win over the Lady Titans snapped a 15-match losing streak to WC and marked the first W&J win in the series since 1986 ... Freshman setter Jamie Gullen paced the Presidents with 39 assists, 24 digs and six service aces ... Junior outside hitter Jerica Lamens posted a double-double with 15 kills and 14 digs, while sophomore middle hitter Rebecca Fletcher added 12 kills and two blocks ... Senior outside hitter Dan Wright also amassed nine kills ... Gullen led the Presidents with 20 assists, three aces and two digs in the loss to the Yellow Jackets ... Lamens led the team in hitting with 11 kills.

PAC VOLLEYBALL NOTES

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City picked up its first PAC and home win of the season Sept. 30 against Bethany but then dropped a five-game decision in Greenville Thursday night ... Against Bethany, junior Kate DiMarco led Grove City with 10 kills and 21 digs, while Lisa Bodi and Kelly Tinney both had 19 kills in the loss at Thiel ... Carly Denniston had 95 combined assists in the two matches ... Thursday's match started a seven-match run of road matches for Grove City ... The Lady Wolverines will not play at home until October 21 as Grove City closes the regular season with three home matches ... Grove City is 2-4 in five-game matches this year ... Grove City finishes its non-conference schedule at D-II Slippery Rock Thursday and versus Penn State Behrend at W&J on Saturday.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg is enjoying a 10-match winning streak after four home wins this week, including three-game sweeps over PAC teams W&J on Tuesday and Bethany on Thursday to improve to 4-0 in league play ... The Jackets won both of their matches in a home tri-match with Mt. Aloysius (3-1) and Notre Dame of Md. (3-0) on Saturday to improve to 18-4 ... Senior OH Ronnie Jo Meyers, who had 4.23 kills and 3.77 digs per game this week, led the Jackets in kills for three of the four matches, including 19 vs. Notre Dame while posting a .864 hitting percentage ... Including her 12 kills against Bethany, Meyers had a season-high 21 digs ... Other notables for the week include junior S Katie Beall with 49 assists in each of Saturday's matches, and sophomore MH Brittany Morrow with a match-high 14 kills against W&J.

Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats went 1-1 in PAC action last week, falling in straight sets to Westminster 3-0 before capping an amazing comeback against Grove City College with a 3-2 victory ... Senior S Tiffany Snyder totaled 21 assists and freshman libero Erin Plaso finished with 11 digs in the Westminster loss ... After trailing 2-0 against Grove City, Thiel would force a fifth game and after trailing 13-9 in the final game were able to bounce back and claim their first PAC win of the season ... Junior MH Jessica Erickson was credited with 19 kills and a season-high nine blocks, while freshman OH Megan Viebranz had 19 kills and 16 digs coming off of the bench ... The Tomcats are 2-0 in five-game matches and are a perfect 3-0 at Rissell-Beeghly Gymnasia this season.

Westminster Titans

Westminster split a pair of PAC matches last week, sweeping Thiel in three sets at home on Tuesday before W&J snapped the Lady Titans' three-match win streak with a fourset win in Washington Thursday ... Against Thiel, senior OH Diana Barnes led the way with a match-high 15 kills, followed by freshman MH Kate McDermott with 10 and sophomore OH Erin Hinks with eight ... Freshman Rachael Cooper recorded teamhigh totals of 16 assists and three service aces, while senior McKenzie Crowell added eight digs and junior Sarah McKain tallied three blocks ... McDermott led the way at W&J with 13 kills while adding a three solo blocks, followed by Barnes with 12 kills and a three service aces ... Junior Lauren Lalama set up 14 assists in the loss, while classmate Sara Miller added 13 digs.
