The Saints and Titans will meet this Saturday (Oct. 10) at Thiel and Oct. 17 at Westminster.


#### Bethany Bison (10-8, 2-4 PAC)

It was a rough week for the Waynesburg volleyball team as they faced a trio of PAC opponents with winning records and couldn't find a way to pick up a

victory ... The highlight of the week was the work of junior Rachell Storm, freshman Presley Cupp and sophomore Jordan Barton, who all averaged over five digs a set ... Storm led the group with a 5.78 digs per set average, including 26 digs in three sets against Bethany. Cupp chipped in 5.67 digs per set, and Barton averaged an even 5.00 digs per set ... Sophomore Carly Schubert put up 12 kills in a hardfought match against Saint Vincent.

#### Chatham Cougars (1-15, 0-6 PAC)

Chatham took on Geneva in a PAC match ... The Cougars fell to the Golden Tornados in four sets, although Geneva is a NCAA Division III provisional member and the result does not count towards overall PAC standings ... Chatham then traveled to Thiel College for a tri-match against host Thiel and Bethany College, both PAC matches ... The Cougars lost in both matches in three sets.

#### **Grove City Wolverines** (6-12, 3-3 PAC)

Grove City's hopes of earning the top seed in the season-ending PAC tournament took a significant hit as the Wolverines dropped a pair of matches Saturday at

Westminster ... Anna McCurdy racked up 16 kills in a four-set defeat against Westminster ... Inge Rasmussen's 15 kills paced the Wolverines in a 3-2 loss to W&J ... McCurdy and Mary Masincup each had 10 kills ... Three of Grove City's last four matches with W&J have gone to five sets ... It marked the first time that GCC went to five sets in a match this season ... Wednesday, Grove City fell to Penn State Behrend, 3-0 as McCurdy had 10 kills ... The Wolverines host Thomas More Friday night before hosting Geneva and Roberts Wesleyan Saturday.
