PAC Volleyball Player of the Week

SUZANNE FITZ Westminster College

6-3 Senior Middle Hitter Strongsville, Ohio/Strongsville H.S.

Fitz led the Lady Titans to a 3-2 week, including threeset sweeps of PAC foes Grove City and Waynesburg. On Saturday in a match against Geneva, she became the all-time leader in kills at Westminster. Fitz now has 1,367 career kills, surpassing **Heidi Jorgensen** (1,325 from 1991-94). For the week, she tallied 69 kills (3.63 kpg), six solo blocks and nine block assists in five matches (19 games).

Also nominated was junior MH **Abbey Otto** of Bethany, senior OH **Kirsten Pedersen** of Grove City, junior S **Tiffany Snyder** of Thiel, sophomore OH **Mari Lynne Starr** of Washington & Jefferson, and junior OH **Ronnie Jo Meyers** of Waynesburg.

PAC VOLLEYBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison

Bethany dropped all three matches last week to fall to 7-17 on the year... Junior **Shae Baxter** had 13 kills and 15 digs, while junior **Abbey Otto** totaled 12 kills in the Thiel loss... Otto averaged 12.3 kills and three blocks per match, while Baxter averaged 10 kills and freshman setter **Brittany Vavrek** registered 26 assists per game.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

Freshmen MH Becky Fletcher and OH Kristen Baressi both posted 13 kills as Washington & Jefferson defeated Bethany, 3-1, on Thursday evening at the Henry Memorial Center ... Sophomore OH Mari Lynne Starr nearly totaled a double-double with nine kills and 10 blocks, while fellow sophomore MH Jerica Lamens also added nine kills ... Senior setter Andrea Motta led the Presidents with 21 assists and freshman setter Lori Dennis aided with 18 assists ... Senior setter Moira Lynch and junior OH Dana Wright also amassed a team-high 11 digs each ... In the loss to Waynesburg on Tuesday, Starr totaled 10 kills, while Wright added nine.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City completed a busy week with a pair of wins at the Juniata ASICS Tournament Saturday afternoon ... Kirsten Pedersen tallied 25 kills in the two victories Saturday while Cara Denniston racked up 79 assists ... Melissa Lawton tallied 16 digs against Frostburg ... Danielle McElhaney served three aces in the win over Frostburg while Kate **DiMarco** repeated that feat against Brockport ... Against Thiel, Lisa Bodi recorded a dozen kills while Pedersen had 14 digs ... Bodi and Katie Summers each tallied nine kills against Westminster ... This season, Grove City has not been more than three games above or below the .500 mark.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Despite a pair of three-game matches nearly all of Waynesburg's games were closely contested this week ... The Jackets win over Washington & Jefferson Tuesday included a 33-31 win and a pair of 30-28 wins, while threatening Westminster in two games of a 3-0 loss on Thursday ... Senior Kathy Twaddle recorded 19 kills and seven solo blocks in the win over W&J, while Katie Beall served up 40 assists ... Ronnie Jo Meyers paced the Jackets attack in the loss to Westminster with 12 kills ... The Jackets continue their seven match home stand this week ending with a quad match versus Frostburg State, Kenyon, and Seton Hill on Saturday.

Thiel Tomcats

Thiel went 2-3 last week ... The Tomcats won a grueling 5-set match over PAC rival Bethany on Monday, giving head coach Sarah Roseto her first PAC win of her career ... Thiel fell to defending PAC champ Grove City 3-0 on Thursday ... TC then finished 1-2 at the Westminster Invitational on Saturday, dropping two matches to Capital and Alderson-Broaddus and then defeating West Liberty State in the fifth-place match ... Junior Tiffany Snyder set up a careerhigh 60 assists and tallied 19 digs in the Tomcat win over Bethany ... Snyder had 48 assists while junior Jan Willman notched 18 kills, 11 digs and four service aces against West Liberty.

Westminster Titans

Westminster was 3-2 last week, with the Lady Titans improving to 5-0 in the PAC with three-set sweeps of Grove City on Tuesday and Waynesburg on Thursday ... WC then went 1-2 and placed fourth out of six teams at the Titan Invitational at Buzz Ridl Gymnasium on Saturday ... Senior MH Suzanne Fitz became the program's all-time kills leader during the team's loss to Geneva on Saturday ... Fitz now has 1,368 career kills, surpassing Heidi Jorgensen (1,325 career kills from 1991-94) at the top of the Lady Titan career charts ... Junior OH Diana Barnes was the lone Lady Titan named to the All-Tournament team on Saturday.
