PAC VOLLEYBALL 2008 - Week 6 Conference Notes



Defending PAC champion Westminster remained unbeaten in league action this week, followed closely by W&J, Thomas More and Thiel ... Saint Vincent continued its stellar season, as the Bearcats posted a 3-1 week (3-0 vs. PAC opponents) ... Geneva had its 11-match win streak snapped at Thomas More, 3-1.

WHO'S HOT: Senior DS Hannah Parker, who became the first player in Westminster history to surpass 2,000 career digs last week, averaged 5.78 dpg for the 3-0 Titans ... Junior OH Abbey Kiger had 49 kills and 25 digs for 1-2 Thiel last week ... Geneva freshman Rachel Kuegler recorded 18 kills in a 3-0 blanking of Grove City ... Sophomore OH Courtney Sherwin had 26 kills and 17 blocks for 2-2 W&J last week ... Junior OH Kristine Rust of Thomas More had 14 kills and three blocks in a four-set win over Geneva.


Grove City Wolverines (7-16, 2-6 PAC)
