Terchanik led W&J to a 3-0 week (all PAC wins) by posting 48 kills (3.8 kpg) and 12 blocks (seven solo) last week. She racked up 23 kills and eight blocks in a five-set win over Bethany on Thursday. In addition to topping Bethany, the Presidents also posted four-set wins over Waynesburg and Thomas More.

Also nominated was junior OH Lauren Spegal of Bethany, sophomore MH Natalie Liberati of Grove City, freshman OH Latoya Locke of Thiel, freshman OH Kristine Rust of Thomas More, sophomore OH Laurie Lindner of Waynesburg, and senior MH Katie McDermott of Westminster.

Bethany Bison

Bethany dropped three matches last week, although BC nearly knocked off the defending PAC champion ... The Bison started the week by falling to a red-hot Saint Vincent team that won its ninth match in a row ... **Lauren Spegal** and **Linzy Turner** both had seven kills in the setback ... Bethany then took W&J to five games, but fell just short of upsetting last year's conference champ as W&J claimed a 15-7 win in the fifth game to come away with the win ... Spegal had a big night with 14 kills, 26 digs and five blocks, while **Amanda Bashium** notched 10 kills and three blocks ... The week ended with a 3-0 loss to Thomas More, despite solid games from Turner (nine kills, 10 digs) and Spegal (eight kills, 10 digs).



Grove City Wolverines

Grove City went 4-0 last week, losing just one game ... The Wolverines opened the week with a 3-1 win over previously unbeaten (15-0) Penn St.-Behrend ... Junior **Heather Fraiz** highlighted the win with 15 kills while sophomore **Natalie Liberati** added 12 ... The Wolverines then went a combined 3-0 over the weekend ... In a sweep of Thiel Friday, **Carlie Roberts** and **Kate Skinner** both posted 11 kills while **S Kim Walsh** had 36 assists ... Saturday, Grove City swept both Pitt-Greensburg and Lake Erie ... Walsh distributed 48 assists in the win over UP-G while Liberati led with 12 kills ... Fraiz's 13 kills led the way vs. Lake Erie ... At 15-6, Grove City is off to its best start in 20 years ... In 1986, Grove City opened 17-4 and finished 36-6 ... Grove City faces three PAC opponents on the road this week.



Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats have lost 10 straight starting with a 1-3 loss to Penn State Behrend on Sept. 6 ... Last week, Thiel dropped a pair of three-set decisions to PAC rivals Westminster and Grove City ... The Tomcats were led last week by **LaToya Locke**, **Kristen Martin** and **Erin Plaso** ... Locked had 26 kills in two matches while Martin gave out 67 assists. Plaso came up with 32 digs.



Thomas More Saints

Thomas More went 1-2 in PAC action ... Freshman **Kristine Rust** had her sixth 20+ kill match of the season and her second in PAC action in the Saints' loss to W&J ... She added back-to-back 19 kill matches to start the weekend ... Rust averaged 5.27 kills per game with one solo block and 10 block assist ... Freshman **Leslie Hoelscher** recorded her first 20-kill match in a PAC contest, her team-leading seventh overall ... Junior **Valeri Kuhn** dished out 134 assists for the week, including her fifth 50-plus assist match of the season ... Sophomore **Jessica Tyner** had a career-high 41 digs against W&J, and junior **Jenny Schutte** had a career-high 35 digs in the same match.



Washington & Jefferson Presidents

Senior MH **Taryn Terchanik** led an undefeated week for the Presidents by posting 48 kills and 12 blocks ... Senior OH **Stacie Ley** racked up 14 kills and 19 digs in a 3-1 win at Waynesburg on Tuesday, while Terchanik added 14 kills and two blocks ... Terchanik helped fuel a 3-2 win at Bethany with 23 kills and eight blocks (five solo) ... Senior S **Jamie Gullen** dished out 58 assists and Ley chipped in with nine kills and 23 digs ... W&J dropped the first game to Thomas More on Saturday but rallied for three-straight wins behind Ley's 19 kills and 16 digs ... Junior OH **Gabby Zagari** added 12 kills and 14 digs.



Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Yellow Jackets posted a 2-2 record last week, including a 1-2 record in PAC play ... Waynesburg opened the week with a 3-1 loss to W&J Tuesday ... **Kaci Hlad** posted a team-best 12 kills and added nine kills, while freshman **Caitie Morgan** had 27 digs ... Friday, the Jackets registered a 3-1 win over Thomas More behind 21 kills, a .538 attack percentage and 12 digs from OH **Laurie Lindner** ... Hlad added 18 kills, while Morgan led four players in double figures with 24 digs ... Waynesburg hosted a tri-match on Saturday, losing to Westminster, 3-1, before defeating Chatham in three games, 3-0 ... Against the Titans, Lindner netted 15 kills and 16 digs, while Morgan and **Ashley Kreinbrook** added 30 and 21 digs, respectively. Freshman **Caitlin Metzger** posted a team-high 11 digs vs. Chatham.



Westminster Titans

Westminster moved into a two-way tie with Grove City for first place in the PAC by going 3-0 during the week including 2-0 in league matches ... The Titans beat Thiel at home Tuesday in three games before winning at Waynesburg Saturday in four ... They also defeated Chatham Saturday at Waynesburg in three games. The Waynesburg win was the Titans' first over the Yellow Jackets in four years ... Senior **Katie McDermott** paced the Titan hitters by averaging 3.75 kills per game, including 18 kills in the Thiel match and 11 against Waynesburg ... Junior **Diana Conzett** posted a match-high 19 kills against Thiel, sophomore **Kylene Hoch** registered a career-high 29 digs against Waynesburg, and senior **Rachael Cooper** amassed 17 aces during the week, including five against Thiel.



Saint Vincent Bearcats

The Lady Bearcats have won nine consecutive matches by 3-0 scores, for a total of 27 consecutive game victories ... **Shannon McVay** recorded 14 kills and **Jaime Kelly** added 12 against Bethany, while **Kristin Hozak** had 43 assists.
