## **PAC Volleyball Player of the Week**

## JAMIE GULLEN Washington & Jefferson College

5-7 junior setter Steubenville, Ohio/Steubenville H.S.

Gullen led the Presidents to a perfect 6-0 week with two PAC wins and the team title at the Virginia Wesleyan Invitational. She earned Tournament MVP honors with 133 assists and 23 digs in three matches played at Va. Wesleyan, including 54 assists, seven digs and six kills in a five-game win over Marymount for the tourney title. She averaged 12.3 assists per game for the week, while adding 36 digs, 22 kills, nine blocks and seven aces.

Also nominated was junior LIB/OH **Angelina Allen** of Bethany, junior MH **Carlie Roberts** of Grove City, senior OH **Jody Clyde** of Thomas More, freshman OH **Laurie Linder** of Waynesburg, and senior OH **Erin Hinks** of Westminster.

#### Bethany Bison

The Bison fell twice in PAC play last week to fall to 0-4 in the league ... On Wednesday, Bethany lost 3-0 at Grove City ... Junior **Angelina Allen** moved from her usual libero position to post team-highs with seven kills and 13 digs ... BC

then the first game against Waynesburg Thursday in heart-breaking fashion and the Yellow Jackets used that momentum to record a 3-0 victory ... The Green & White led 29-28 and was serving for the match, but Waynesburg battled back for a 35-33 game one win ... Sophomore Lauren Spegal tallied 14 kills in the defeat, while Amanda Bashioum had eight and Brittany Vavrek recorded 36 assists.



#### Thiel Tomcats

Thiel fell in its only contest last week, a 3-0 home loss to PAC rival Grove City ... The Wolverines posted 30-25, 30-16, and 30-15 wins in the PAC matchup ... The Tomcats were led by sophomore OHs **Molly Klink** and **Stephanie Monus**, as they finished with nine and eight kills, respectively ...

Junior S Erin Plaso added 25 assists, four blocks and three kills while Monus chipped in with 13 digs.



#### **Grove City Wolverines**

Grove City evened its PAC record at 2-2 and its overall record at 10-10 with a pair of victories last week in conference play ... Grove City opened the week with a sweep of visiting Bethany Wednesday ... Carlie Roberts led

Grove City with 17 kills and eight blocks while setter Kim Walsh had 40 assists ... LIB **Emily Rossol** had 23 digs ... At Thiel Friday, Grove City recorded its second sweep of the week ... Roberts had 12 kills and four blocks while **Natalie Liberati** added 10 kills on 15 attacks ... **Jennifer Plyer** added seven kills and 11 digs while Walsh again had 40 assists ... Grove City has its best 20-match record since 2001, the year of Wolverines' last PAC title ... The Wolverines host Westminster Tuesday before visiting W&J Thursday.



#### Thomas More Saints

The Saints lost a heartbreaking fivesetter to the Waynesburg Yellow Jackets, their first PAC loss of the season,

Saturday ... Freshman **Jessica Tyner** led the team with 21 kills, while **Jody Clyde** added 16 ... Sophomore S **Valeri Kuhn** distributed a career-high 69 assists ... The Saints will host Waynesburg this week, playing the Yellow Jackets for the third time in 13 matches ... In their non-conference win over Lycoming, Clyde led the team with 15 kills as Tyner added 14 ... Kuhn had 37 assists for the Saints, and senior **Laura Wiegele** had a team-high 29 digs.



### Washington & Jefferson Presidents

W&J posted a perfect 6-0 record last week with PAC wins over Waynesburg and Westminster and four victories in Virginia Beach to claim the Va. Wesleyan Tournament title ... The Presidents are off to their best start through 19 games since 1998 when W&J started 16-3 and finished with a 30-3 overall record ... Junior S Jamie Gullen, who is

ranked 11th in the nation in assists per game, was named the VWC LaQuinta Tournament MVP after 133 assists and 23 digs in the three played matches ... Senior OH **Lakia Gordon** was honored on the All-Tournament Team after recording 21 kills in the champion-ship match ... Senior **Rebecca Fletcher** was responsible for the last three points in the fifth game vs. Marymount with a kill, an ace and a solo block.



#### Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

After starting the week with a loss to W&J, the Waynesburg volleyball team recorded three straight PAC victories ... Against W&J, Lauren Freeman posted a team-high 26 digs while freshman Laurie Linder paced the offense with 14 kills ... Freshman S Amanda Staudt contributed 35 assists in the loss ... In the 3-0 shutout of Bethany,

four Yellow Jackets posted double-figures in digs, including a teamhigh 17 by Freeman ... In the five-game win over the Saints, Linder led a trio of Waynesburg players who reached into double figures in kills with 13, while **Kimberly Wilson** added 12 ... Against the Titans, Linder led the team with a career-high 19 digs and added 10 kills to post her second-straight double-double.





Westminster went 1-2 last week, including a pair of 3-0 PAC losses at W&J and Waynesburg before topping Lycoming 3-0 ... Against the Presidents, senior OH Erin Hinks had 11 kills in the loss, followed by sophomore MH Danielle Hogue with eight ... Junior S Rachael Cooper posted team-high totals of 25 assists and three aces ... Sophomore LIB Hannah Parker also had three aces in the loss while also contributing a team-best 18 digs ... In the opener against Waynesburg, Hinks had 11 kills followed by Parker with 10 ... Cooper set up 25

assists, while Parker and freshman LIB **Kylene Hoch** recorded 17 and 15 digs, respectively ... Hinks had 17 kills against Lycoming, followed by junior middle hitter **Katie McDermott** with 14 kills. Cooper set up 44 assists in the victory, while Parker added 20 digs.
