PAC Volleyball Player of the Week

BRITTANY MORROW Waynesburg College

6-0 junior opposite/middle hitter Beaver, Pa./Beaver H.S.

Morrow led the Yellow Jackets to 3-0 PAC sweeps over Grove City and Thiel, giving Waynesburg the league lead at 4-0. She posted 13 kills and 10 digs against GCC, then recorded 12 kills and 10 digs vs. the Tomcats, giving her six double-doubles in the past seven matches.

Also nominated was senior OH **Kate DiMarco** of Grove City, sophomore OH **Taryn Terchanik** of Washington & Jefferson, and senior MH **Sarah McKain** of Westminster.

PAC VOLLEYBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison

Bethany went 1-2 last week, falling to Westminster and Grove City by scores of 3-0, then rebounding to defeat Kenyon 3-1 ... The squad is now 7-11 this season and 0-3 in the PAC ... The Kenyon win snapped a five-match losing streak Peggy Emmerling led the Bison against Kenyon with 16 kills and two block solos ... Her 16 kills were the second-most she's recorded this season, just one behind her high of 17, which she also did against Kenyon in the first match of the season ... Lauren Spegal added a career-best 14 kills and 11 digs, while Linzy Turner had 12 kills and 20 digs ... Michelle Fowler led the team with 27 digs, while Angelina Allen had 22, along with 10 kills.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

Washington & Jefferson evened its conference record with a 3-0 victory at Thiel Monday, but dropped all four of its contests at the Colorado College Tournament this past weekend in Colorado Springs, Colo. ... Junior OH Lakia Gordon had a team-high nine kills in the win over Thiel ... Junior MH Rebecca Fletcher and sophomore MH Taryn Terchanik both added eight kills ... Senior OH Jerica Lamens racked up 41 kills and 37 digs in the four matches in Colorado ... Gordon added 33 kills in the four matches, while Terchanik posted 17 kills and seven blocks on Saturday in losses to Nebraska Wesleyan and Chapman ... The Presidents host Grove City and Chatham in home matches this week.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City split two PAC matches last week, as each match was decided in three games ... Kate DiMarco helped pace Grove City with a 10-kill, 14-dig effort against Bethany while sophomore Kelly Tinney had a team-high 13 kills ... Freshman setter Kim Walsh dished out 38 assists in the victory ... No Grove City player had more than five kills at Waynesburg last Tuesday night ... Sophomore Emily Rossol had 18 digs in the setback ... Grove City is undefeated at home so far this season (4-0) ... The Wolverines won just twice at home last season ... Grove City alternates between away and home matches over the next six contests, starting with Wednesday's tilt at Washington and Jefferson.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg continued its impressive play in conference this week with threegame sweeps of Grove City and Thiel ... The Yellow Jackets have won eight of their last 10 matches and extended their reqular season conference win streak to 18 matches ... Junior Brittany Morrow led the team with 4.17 kills per match during the week, while also recording 3.33 digs per match ... In both matches this week Morrow recorded double-doubles and has accomplished the feat six times in the last seven matches ... In the Thiel match, Kimberly Wilson and Kaci Hlad added nine kills eac, while junior libero Lauren Freeman tied Morrow for a team-high 10 digs ... Waynesburg has now won its last 19 games at the Marisa Fieldhouse, dating back to the 2002 season.

Thiel Tomcats

Thiel's winless streak extended to five last week after dropping a pair of PAC matches ... The Tomcats fell in straight sets at home against both W&J (Monday) and Waynesburg (Thursday) ... Senior MH Jess Erickson and freshman MH Christy Allen each finished with 11 kills while sophomore OH Erin Plaso and freshman OH Olivia Rogers added 10 digs apiece in the W&J loss ... Against Waynesburg, Erickson totaled nine kills and a pair of blocks while freshman S Molly Klink added 13 digs, 10 assists and four kills.

Westminster Titans

Westminster captured its only match of the week with a three-set sweep (30-24, 30-27, 30-22) at Bethany on Tuesday ... Westminster trailed 22-18 in the final game before rolling off 12 consecutive points to clinch the match. ... Pacing the Westminster offensive attack was senior MH Sarah McKain with a team-high nine kills ... Sophomore MH Heidi Kracker added eight kills and five total blocks (three solo, two assists), while sophomore S Rachael Cooper had a teambest 20 assists ... Senior libero Sara Miller and freshman OH Hannah Parker led the squad in digs with 18 apiece.
