She recorded 14 kills in a sweep of Washington & Jefferson, then recorded a team-best 16 kills for the Bearcats in a 3-1 victory at Grove City as Saint Vincent ran its current win streak to five matches.

PAC VOLLEYBALL 2011 - Week 6 Conference Notes

TIED AT THE TOP: Bethany and Geneva remain tied for the PAC lead as we pass the midway point of conference play ... Both teams posted league home wins Wednesday, as the Bison avenged their only conference defeat with a 3-1 victory against Westminster, while Geneva maintained the pace with a 3-1 decision against visiting Thiel ... Saint Vincent posted a perfect 3-0 week vs. PAC opponents to remain in the race at 6-3, tied with defending champion Thomas More (6-3) with Thiel (7-4) just behind.

NEWS & NOTES: **Tiffany Hoffman** became just the second player in Bethany history to surpass 2,000 career digs last week ... Grove City went 2-1 in PAC play and gave **Susan Roberts** her 600th career head coaching win last week behind the play of junior OH **Elisabeth Willits** (3.33 kps, 2.75 dps) ... Thiel was also 2-1 in PAC play led by junior MH **Kelly Barzak**, who posted 44 kills and a .361 hitting percentage ... Sophomore MB **Rebecca Riemer** averaged 3.3 kps while adding seven aces and 12 blocks for 1-2 Westminster.

AROUND THE PAC: Senior MB **Katie Sullivan** posted 16 kills to lead Thomas More over W&J 3-1 in the Saints' only match of the week ... Geneva's lone match - a 3-1 home win over Thiel - saw sophomore OH **Ashley Davis** record a career-high 18 kills for the GTs ... Sophomore **Kaley Burkardt** led Saint Vincent with five kills at Chatham ... Senior DS **Alyssa Vukson** racked up 35 digs last week for 0-3 W&J ... Senior MH **Lauren Wagner** averaged 3.36 kills per set last week for 0-3 Waynesburg.

Bethany Bison (21-2, 9-1 PAC)



Bethany avenged its first loss of the season Wednesday with a hard-fought 3-1 victory over Westminster at Hummel Field House ... A trio of Bison hitters notched double digit kills, led by **Carrie Talkington** with 15, **Jordan Fenner** with 14 and **Taylor Cassidy** with 11, while **Jessica Zavatchen** passed out 47 assists ... Saturday, BC started a tri-match at Ohio Wesleyan with a 3-1 setback to Hiram, despite a career-high 21 kills from Cassidy and 50 assists from Zavatchen ... **Tiffany Hoffman** had 15 digs as well to become just the second player in Bison history to go over 2,000 in her career ... Bethany recovered to sweep Ohio Wesleyan, as Talkington pounded down a dozen kills, and Cassidy hit 10.

Chatham Cougars (1-20, 0-10 PAC)



Chatham is currently on a 13-match losing streak ... Despite the losses, the gap between scores is decreasing ... Chatham's lead scorers continue to be **Mareija Bibbs**, **Martha Giesler** and **Julianne Speeney**.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes (14-7, 9-1 PAC)



Geneva's volleyball team played just once last week but took care of business with a 3-1 victory over Thiel ... After spotting the Tomcats a 1-0 lead, the Golden Tornadoes rallied back to take the next three games ... In game three, Geneva was forced to overcome a 10-1 deficit and in game four came back from down 9-3 ... **Ashley Davis** led the offense with 18 kills while **Kristland McCracken**, **Rachel Kuegler** and **Maggie Bowersox** each came away with 12 kills and four blocks ... The Golden Tornadoes have won seven of their last eight matches and are sitting with an overall mark of 14-7 including a 9-1 record in the PAC which is good enough for a first place tie with Bethany.

Grove City Wolverines (12-9, 4-6 PAC)



Grove City went 2-1 last week in PAC action ... Wednesday, Grove City pulled out a 3-2 win at Waynesburg, giving head coach **Susan Roberts** her 600th victory as a head volleyball coach ... **Elisabeth Willits** led Grove City with 17 kills while **Casey Schmidt** had 38 assists ... The win marked GCC's second straight five-set win at Waynesburg ... Saturday, Grove City split a home tri-match with W&J and Saint Vincent ... In a 3-0 win over W&J, Willits paced the Wolverines with 11 kills ... She also served three aces ... Grove City then fell to Saint Vincent in four sets despite 12 kills from Willits ... Schmidt had 20 digs ... At 12-9, the Wolverines are off to their best start since 2007.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (16-5, 6-3 PAC)



Saint Vincent stretched its win streak to five games by going 3-0 in PAC action this week, dropping only one set ... At Chatham, sophomore Megan Lucas recorded nine digs ... **Kaley Burkardt** and **Natalie Hozak** each totaled two aces in the win ... Against W&J Saturday, Hozak posted a team-high 14 kills while classmate **Taylor Guido** added 12 ... Sophomore **Emily Rosati** added six kills in the 3-0 win ... Junior S **Devin McGrath** collected 42 assists, while also being one of three Bearcats to total double-digit digs ... Sophomore **Brittany Hauser** had five blocks ... Against the host Wolverines, Hozak, Guido and sophomore **Ariel Rocco** each totaled double-digit kills with 16, 14 and 12, respectively.

Thiel Tomcats (12-8, 7-4 PAC)



The Tomcats continued PAC play, going 2-1 in the league last week ... In the first match, Thiel dropped their second meeting of the season to Geneva, 3-1 ... Junior MH **Kelly Barzak** notched 18 kills and just three errors ... She also added six blocks (3s, 6a) and was responsible for 25 points ... Junior **Chelsea Meister** added 30 assists and freshman LIB **Lauren Downs** notched 28 digs defensively ... In the second match of the week, the Tomcats defeated Westminster 3-1 ... Barzak again led the Tomcats as she again notched 18 kills ... Junior **Megg Andrews** added 11 kills and Mesiter added 40 assists...Thiel then swept Waynesburg ... Junior **Alyssa Chine** and senior **Megan Kay** had 10 kills apiece.

Thomas More Saints (10-8, 6-3 PAC)



The Saint rallied from a 1-0 deficit to defeat Washington & Jefferson, 3-1, in its lone match last week ... The Saints had three players with double-digit kills as freshman MH **Karsen Cronin** with 16, senior MB **Katie Sullivan** with 16 and junior OH **Hanna Lietz** with 13 ... Junior S **Tori Verville** had 38 assists, while senior S **Michelle Clifford** finished with 15 assists ... Defensively, the Saints were led by freshman DS **Kelsey Castiglioni** with 15 digs and freshman DS **Christina Brackett** with 11 digs ... For the season, Sullivan has a team-best .402 hitting percentage with 170 kills, while Clifford leads the team in assists with 464 and Castiglioni leads the Saints' defensive effort with 295 digs.
