

PAC VOLLEYBALL 2010 - Week 6 Conference Notes

TMC STAYS UNBEATEN: Defending PAC champion Thomas More remained unbeaten in conference play and alone atop the PAC standings this week, as the Saints swept a key tri-match in Crestview Hills this weekend ... After defeating Bethany 3-0, the Saints swept second-place Westminster, also by a 3-0 count, to cement their conference lead ... In other key action, Thiel was 2-0 in a PAC trimatch at Saint Vincent as teams continue to jockey for position for the PAC Tournament.

NEWS & NOTES: Geneva is now 18-2 and has won nine straight matches ... Thiel went 2-0 over the weekend, as junior OH Megan Kay recorded 22 kills and 34 digs ... Junior DS Emily Bohman of Thomas More posted a combined 38 digs in PAC wins over Bethany and Westminster Saturday ... Junior MB Lindsay Speidel had 24 kills, the highest single-match total by a Westminster player in six years, in a 3-1 win over Saint Vincent ... Freshman OH Becca Moore notched a matchhigh 34 digs for W&J in a 3-1 loss to York.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: Saint Vincent senior Natalie Hozak posted 16 kills and 22 digs in a four-set loss at Westminster ... Carrie Talkington recorded 16 kills and seven blocks for Bethany in a four-set loss to Geneva ... S Casey Schmidt averaged 6.2 assists, 1.5 kills and 2.7 digs per set last week for 0-2 Grove City ... Junior OH Jordan Barton averaged 2.5 kills and 3.4 digs per set for 0-3 Waynesburg ... FY Mareija Bibbs had 16 kills and seven blocks in two PAC losses for Chatham.

Bethany Bison (16-6, 5-4 PAC)

After sweeping past Chatham to open the week, the Bison lost to three of the top teams in the PAC in Geneva and to Thomas More and Westminster at

TMC's tri-match Saturday ... Carrie Talkington posted eight kills and three aces and Jessica Zavatchen passed out 33 assists in the Chatham victory ... The Bison took the first set vs. Geneva, but the GTs rallied to take the next three and claim the victory despite 16 kills and seven blocks from Talkington and 14 kills from Taylor Cassidy ... Bethany was on the short end of matches against the top two teams in the PAC with 3-0 losses to Thomas More and Westminster ... Jessica Cole posted eight kills and seven digs in the TMC setback.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes (18-2)

The Geneva volleyball broken record continues to play with "Yes", another perfect week ... With only two matches, the Golden Tornadoes quickly took GOLDEN TORNADOES care of Bethany and Chatham to move its current

win streak to nine matches and improving their overall record to 18-2 ... Geneva sits just two victories shy of the best start in school history ... The 1976 women's volleyball team finished the year at 20-2 and then put together a 20-3 season in 1977 ... Deanna Briody had a very solid week with nearly 13 assists per game in Geneva's two victories ... Adriane Blake and Rachel Kuegler each had 20 kills with Maggie Bowersox checking in with 18 kills and four blocks.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (17-6, 6-3 PAC)

The Lady Bearcats struggled to a 1-2 mark on the week, falling to PAC foes Westminster and Thiel while defeating Waynesburg ... Diana Petrovich led the SVC offense, averaging 3.4 kills in the three matches while

tallying 11 blocks, including a season-high eight in the Waynesburg win ... Natalie Hozak averaged 2.8 kills and 5.2 digs, highlighted by a 16kill, 22-dig, 2-ace performance against Westminster, and she has now recorded at least one ace in 20 of 23 matches for the year ... Taylor Guido notched a pair of double-doubles, going for 11 kills and 17 digs vs. Westminster and 10 kills and 16 digs vs Thiel, while Devin McGrath totaled 13 kills, 32 digs, and 110 assists in the three matches.

Thomas More Saints (18-7, 9-0 PAC)

Thomas More went 5-0 last week, including a 3-0 mark in the PAC as it defeated Grove City, Bethany, Westminster, Defiance and Mount St.

Joseph ... In the five matches, senior OH Kristine Rust led the Saints with 56 kills ... In the PAC tri-match against Bethany and Westminster the Saints had got good defensive efforts from junior DS Emily Bohman with 38 digs and freshman MB Tyler Deaton with six total blocks in the two matches ... The Saints' seven-match winning streak is its second longest streak of the season, as TMC won eight straight from September 11-September 22.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (7-14, 1-8 PAC)

The Yellow Jackets went 0-3 this past week in matches against PAC opponents ... Junior OH Jordan Barton averaged a team-best 2.50 kills per set ... She also averaged 3.40 digs per set



Chatham Cougars (3-19, 0-10 PAC)

In the conference matches against Bethany and Geneva this week, FY Mareija Bibbs finished the evening with a total of 16 kills and team-high seven blocks ... FY Marie Voitus led the team in the assists column; she dished out a total of 24 assists in the Cougars' loss to Bethany ... Bibbs tallied a total of 24 kills in both nonconference losses on Saturday, while Leah Kirby racked up 34 digs for Chatham ... Tammy Veneski and Julianne Speeney added 15 and 12 digs also, respectively.

Grove City Wolverines (5-14, 2-7 PAC)

Grove City dropped a pair of home matches last week ... Thursday, Thomas More pulled out a 3-0 win over the Wolverines ... Elisabeth Willits led GCC with nine kills

... Kim Budd added 15 digs ... Casey Schmidt recorded 23 assists . Saturday against NAIA member Roberts Wesleyan, Schmidt, Ashley Branch and Shelby Mander all had seven kills each ... Budd had 15 digs while Schmidt had 13 digs ... The Wolverines visit Saint Vincent Tuesday before hosting Waynesburg Thursday ... Grove City caps the week with a road match at Thiel Thursday ... Schmidt leads the team with 15 aces this season ... She is aiming to become the first freshman to lead Grove City in aces since Julie Porter in 1998.

Thiel Tomcats (14-8, 6-2 PAC)

The Tomcats won their sixth and seventh straight matches with wins over Waynesburg and Saint Vincent on Saturday ... Megan Kay had eight kills

and 17 digs in a sweep over the Yellow Jackets... In a 3-1 win over the host Bearcats, Kay turned in a nice defensive effort with 17 digs while also adding 14 kills ... Alyssa Chine had 17 kills and nine digs, Madison Chylik had 51 assists and 20 digs and Jenna Samsa finished with 40 digs in the win over Saint Vincent.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents (6-11, 4-5 PAC)

W&J was only able to win one of five matches last week, including an 0-4 showing at the Susquehanna Tournament Friday and Saturday ... The Presidents began the week with a 3-1 victory at PAC opponent Waynesburg ... Senior Courtney Sherwin led the Presidents with

Junior S Jessie Szakacs became the eighth player in team history to reach 2,000 career assists with 49 in the Saint Vincent match before finishing with 106 (10.6 aps) for the week.
