PAC Volleyball Player of the Week

Twaddle earned her second PAC Player of the Week award this season after leading Waynesburg to a 4-0 week (including PAC wins over Grove City and Thiel). She finished the week with 65 kills and 13 service aces, including 19 kills against GCC and 21 versus Thiel. She had six of her service aces in a three-set sweep of Frostburg State on Saturday.

Also nominated was senior S **Cara Denniston** of Grove City, junior OH **Jan Willman** of Thiel, junior OH **Dana Wright** of Washington & Jefferson, and junior OH **Diana Barnes** of Westminster.

Bethany Bison

Bethany dropped three more matches last week to fall to 7-20 on the season ... **Peggy Emmerling** posted seven kills and five blocks, while **Abbey Otto** had six kills in the loss at Westminster ... Against Grove City, **Shae Baxter** had seven kills and 11 digs, and Emmerling and **Katie Critchfield** totaled six kills apiece.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

The Presidents were edged by Thiel in Greenville on Tuesday, 3-2, despite an 18-kill, 17-dig performance from junior outside hitter **Dana Wright** ... Sophomore outside hitter **Mari Lynne Starr** added 10 kills for the Presidents in the loss, while freshman **Kristen Baressi** notched nine kills and 13 digs ... Senior setter **Andrea Motta** also posted 38 assists ... Westminster also handed the Presidents a 3-0 loss on Thursday ... Starr led the Presidents with five kills ... Motta, junior outside hitter **Angela Lattanzio** and sophomore middle hitter **Jerica Lamens** all added four kills a piece ... Motta also notched 12 assists.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City returned to the break-even mark with a sweep at Bethany Thursday night, completing a season sweep ... **Katie Summers** totaled 10 kills while **Cara Denniston** posted 31 assists and 10 digs ... Denniston also had 31 assists against Waynesburg last Tuesday night ... **Lisa Bodi** had 13 kills while **Heather Hayden** posted 10 kills against Waynesburg ... **Kirsten Pedersen** and **Melissa Lawton** each had 13 digs ... Grove City will close its conference home schedule this week against Washington and Jefferson and Westminster ... The Lady Wolverines are 4-0 at the Grove City College Arena this year.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

A pivotal week for Waynesburg ended with ease Saturday as the Jackets won both matches as hosts of a quad match ... The Yellow Jackets (21-10, 5-3) recorded two 3-0 wins over Frostburg State and Kenyon ... The wins came after key PAC victories over Grove City on Tuesday and Thiel on Thursday ... The Jackets gutted out a 3-2 win over Grove City behind senior outside hitter **Kerri Petko's** 22 kills ... Junior setter **Katie Beall** served up 162 assists for the week ... Beall's 56 assists in the Jackets' 3-1 win against Thiel helped senior middle hitter **Kathy Twaddle** register 21 kills, followed by **Ronnie Jo Meyers**, **Elizabeth Sachar** and **Petko** with 17, 14, and 10, respectively.

Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats finished with a 2-1 mark last week, doubling their win total of a year ago (3) ... In a five-set victory over W&J, junior OH **Jan Willman** posted 26 kills and eight digs, while fellow junior S **Tiffany Snyder** added 63 assists and 12 digs ... Against LaRoche, Willman and freshman OH **Maggie Marsh** each totaled 12 kills and **Snyder** served up 54 assists ... In their four-set loss to Waynesburg, Willman finished with 12 kills and 17 digs, while senior OH **Tami Hassell** chipped in with 11 kills and 18 digs.

Westminster Titans

Westminster tightened its grip on first place in the PAC this week, with home sweeps of league rivals Bethany and W&J ... The Bethany win was the 250th victory for WC head coach **Tammy Swearingen** in her collegiate career ... She is now 251-108 (.699) in 10 seasons ... Senior MH **Katie Spehar** led a balanced offensive attack against Bethany with 10 kills, followed by classmate **Suzanne Fitz** and junior OH **Diana Barnes** with nine kills each ... Fitz and Barnes posted 14 and 11 kills, respectively, against W&J ... Senior **Carolee Reed** set up 41 assists in the victory, while Barnes added team-high totals of three service aces and 17 digs ... Westminster is now 27-0 against PAC teams since the 2000 season.
