5-6 junior setter Beaver, Pa. Beaver H.S.



Walsh averaged 13.3 assists per game for the 2-1 Wolverines last week, posting 50+ assist efforts in

all three matches. After recording 58 assists in a 3-2 PAC loss at Waynesburg, she totaled 57 in a 3-1 win at PAC foe Bethany and 58 more in a 3-1 league victory at Thiel.

Also nominated was senior LIB **Angelina Allen** of Bethany, freshman OH **Latoya Locke** of Thiel, freshman MB **Leslie Hoelscher** of Thomas More, junior OH **Gabby Zagari** of Waynesburg, and junior OH **Diana Conzett** of Westminster.

Bethany Bison

Bethany's losing streak reached six matches with three PAC losses last week ... The Bison dropped a 3-0 decision to PAC front runner Westminster to open the week ... Lauren Spegal had seven kills and Linzy Turner started a good

week with six kills and 15 digs in the defeat ... BC was able to claim a game from Grove City Thursday, but ended up on the short end of a 3-1 loss to the Wolverines ... Turner matched her career-high with 18 kills and Spegal had 13 kills and 19 digs ... The week concluded with a 3-0 loss to W&J, although it was a historic night for **Angelina Allen** ... The senior libero became just the third player in Bethany history to surpass 1,500 career digs when she brought up 33 ... Turner had 10 kills in the contest as well.



Grove City Wolverines

Grove City went 2-1 on the road in PAC play last week, closing the week with wins over Bethany and Thiel ... At 17-7, Grove City owns its best record after 24 matches since the 1996 squad also won 17 of its first 24 ... Four Grove

City players had 14 or more kills in a four-game win at Bethany Thursday night ... **Kate Skinner** led the Wolverines with 16 kills while **Natalie Liberati** (15), **Carlie Roberts** (14) and **Heather Fraiz** (14) also reached double-digits ... Fraiz's 15 kills led Grove City in a 3-1 win at Thiel Friday night ... S **Kim Walsh** had 58 assists in the victory ... Tuesday, Grove City opened the week with a 3-2 loss at Waynesburg in PAC action ... Fraiz tallied 20 kills and 16 digs against the Yellow Jackets ... **Meghan Glenn** served five aces.



Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats broke their 13-match losing streak with a win over Oberlin Saturday at the Oberlin Tri-Match ... Freshman OH **LaToya Locke** had a career-high 23 kills to go along with eight digs and three blocks in the Tomcats' 3-1 loss to Grove City ... The very next day, she shattered

her own mark with a 30-kill effort against Oberlin at the Oberlin Tri-Match ... Freshman OH **Abbey Kiger** added 14 kills and eight digs in the victory, while freshman S **Kristen Martin** handed out 59 assists and **Erin Plaso** tallied 25 digs.



Thomas More Saints

The Saints hosted the Thomas More Invitational and went 1-3, including 1-1 in PAC action ... Freshman **Leslie**

Hoelscher recorded 60 kills for the week with a .351 hitting percentage ... She added eight block solos for the week, leaving her one block shy of tying the school's single-season NCAA mark and two from tying the single-season record ... Freshman Kristine Rust led the team with 61 kills ... Junior Valeri Kuhn recorded 115 assists for the week, while junior Jenny Schutte had a career-high 44 kills in the loss to Hanover ... Sophomore Sara Corry recorded a career-high nine blocks (five assisted and four solos) in the Hanover loss ... Thomas More will round out its seven-match homestand with three matches this week.



Washington & Jefferson Presidents

Washington & Jefferson has won seven of its last eight matches heading into this week's play ... The Presidents fought back from a pair of deficits on Wednesday to edge Geneva by a 3-2 margin ... Junior OH **Gabby Zagari** led the way with 17 kills and 13 digs, while senior OH **Stacie Ley** posted 11 kills and 20 digs ... The victory over

the Golden Tornadoes was the sixth in 16 all-time meetings for W&J ... Freshman LIB **Erin Ponter** racked up 23 digs and four service aces in a 3-0 win over Bethany on Friday ... Senior OH **Amanda Williamson** and junior MH **Beth Mihalik** supplied a teamhigh seven kills, while senior S **Jamie Gullen** dished out 28 assists.



Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Waynesburg volleyball team opened the week with a five-game win, 3-2 (28-30, 30-25, 30-23, 22-30, 15-9), over Grove City on Tuesday ... In the win, OH **Laurie Lindner** recorded 20 kills and 18 digs, while junior

Ashley Kreinbrook added 11 kills and 13 digs ... The Yellow Jackets recorded 20 blocks at the net against the Wolverines, including seven (six solo) by MH Amanda Jo Morgan ... Freshman LIB Caitie Morgan led Waynesburg with 26 digs, while S Amanda Staudt posted an assist/dig double-double against Grove City with 12 digs and a season and career-high 53 assists ... Saturday, the Yellow Jackets competed at the Thomas More invitational, losing to both the host Saints and Christopher Newport.



Westminster Titans

Westminster compiled a 2-3 record last week, including two PAC wins each in three games over Bethany at home on Oct. 10 and at Thomas More on Oct. 15 to remain in first place in the league with a 6-1 mark ... The Titan losses were against No. 22 Capital (0-3), Hanover (2-3) and Piedmont (0-3) all played at the Thomas More Invitational over the weekend ... Junior OH **Diana Conzett** was the Titans' leading hitter during the week with 3.18 kills per game, including team highs of 13 and nine in the matches against Thomas

More and Piedmont ... Sophomore OH Rachel Terzak posted 2.60 kills per game, including a team-high 10 vs. Bethany and 11 kills and seven aces at TMC ... Sophomore DS Kylene Hoch recorded 100 digs, while sophomore S Traci Hassell averaged 9.65 apg.



Saint Vincent Bearcats

Saint Vincent posted a 3-0 home sweep of PAC rival Thiel Monday before posting a pair of threegame wins against Kenyon and the host Gators at Allegheny Saturday ... The Lady Bearcats have now won 12 consecutive matches by 3-0 scores, for a total of 36 consecutive game vic-

tories ... Junior S **Kristin Hozak** recorded 9 aces against Thiel ... Senior **Shannon McVay** had 5 blocks and 5 aces against Kenyon, then added 16 kills and 7 blocks against Allegheny ... McVay is averaging 1.19 blocks per game ... Hozak is averaging 13.57 assists per game.
