# ERIN HINKS Westminster College

5-8 junior outside hitter Warren, Ohio/Mineral Ridge H.S.

Hinks posted 28 kills, 16 digs and four blocks last week, leading Westminster to a 2-0 week with PAC wins over Thiel (3-0) and at Grove City (3-1). She tallied a teambest 14 kills in each of the league victories.

Also nominated was freshman OH Lauren Spegal of Bethany, sophomore MH Kelly Tinney of Grove City, and junior MH Rebecca Fletcher of Washington & Jefferson.

# PAC VOLLEYBALL NOTES

## Bethany Bison

Bethany went 1-1 last week and gained its first PAC victory of the season at Thiel Thursday, by a score of 3-1 (25-30, 31-29, 30-28, 30-25) ... Four Bison recorded double-digit digs in the contest, led by Linzy Turner and Angelina Allen, who both had 16 ... Freshman Michelle Fowler added 15 and Lindsey Cowser contributed 11 ... Lauren Spegal had a career match with 23 kills for a .357 hitting percentage ... She easily eclipsed her previous career-high kill total of 14 ... She also had eight digs and three total blocks (two solo, one assist) ... Turner led the team with three service aces ... Earlier in the week, the Bison fell at home to Waynesburg, 3-0 ... Fowler led the team with 15 digs and Allen had 14.

### Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J picked up a pair of home victories to improve to 10-11 overall ... In the victory over Grove City, the Presidents were led by junior OH Lakia Gordon, who notched 13 kills and five digs ... Junior MH Rebecca Fletcher added 10 kills. seven digs and six blocks ... Senior OH Jerica Lamens and sophomore S Jamie Gullen both recorded eight kills ... Gullen also picked 20 assists, 15 digs and four blocks, while Lamens amassed nine digs ... Junior libero Anne Reynolds also racked up a game-high 32 digs ... Sophomore Stacie Ley led the 3-1 win over Chatham with 10 kills and 10 digs ... Fletcher racked up a team-high 13 kills to go with six digs and four blocks, while Gordon added nine kills, 11 digs and two blocks.

## **Grove City Wolverines**

Grove City dropped a pair of conference matches last week, falling to 2-3 in the PAC ... Sophomore Kelly Tinney led Grove City with 20 kills against Westminster Friday night while seniors Kate DiMarco and Melissa Lawton had 27 and 25 digs, respectively ... The loss to Westminster snapped Grove City's four-match win streak at home ... Washington and Jefferson dealt Grove City a 3-0 loss Wednesday night as no Grove City player reached double-digits in kills ... Tinney had eight while DiMarco collected seven kills ... Of the Wolverines' final six matches, three are at home and three are away from home.

## Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg volleyball put together a three-match win streak before traveling to take part in the Clearwater Christian Tournament this weekend, posting a 1-3 record ... Before traveling to Florida, the Jackets extended their regular season conference win streak to 19 matches with a 3-0 victory over Bethany ... Against the Bison, Brittany Morrow recorded her third straight double-double with a teamhigh 13 kills and 17 digs for her ninth double-double of the season ... Besides Morrow, a pair of Jackets posted doublefigure kills - Teia Suder and Lorelle Marker ... At the two-day tournament the Jackets faced NAIA schools Embry Riddle Aeronautical and Freed-Hardeman, along with host-Clearwater Christian, a Division II program.

#### **Thiel Tomcats**

Thiel saw its losing streak stretch to nine last week, dropping a pair of PAC contests during the week and a pair of nonconference matches at the Allegheny Tri-Match Saturday ... Senior MH Jessica Erickson had a combined 32 kills and seven blocks between in last week's conference matches while sophomore S Erin Plaso tallied 67 assists, 39 digs and 11 kills ... Against Kenyon, Erickson finished with 11 kills while freshman LIB Stephanie Monus and freshman OH Molly Klink each registered 11 digs ... Erickson had 11 kills against Allegheny while Plaso finished with 18 assists and six blocks.

#### Westminster Titans

Westminster posted PAC wins over Thiel (3-0) and at Grove City (3-1), as the Lady Titans ran their win streak to four matches, all against league foes ...
