Chine posted double-digit kill totals in all three PAC matches for the 3-0 Tomcats, finishing the week with 58 kills (4.83 kps), 34 digs (2.83 dps) and a .292 hitting percentage. She opened the week with a career-high 31 kills and just four errors in a 3-2 win over defending PAC champion Thomas More, then added 10 and 17 kills, respectively, against league foes Saint Vincent and Bethany. All three league wins for Thiel were against teams bound for the PAC Tournament.

Also nominated was junior MB **Carrie Talkington** of Bethany, sophomore MB **Lauren Plummer** of Chatham, sophomore S **Deanna Briody** of Geneva, senior OH **Mary Masincup** of Grove City, junior S **Tori Verville** of Thomas More, sophomore S **Natalie Ranallo** of Waynesburg, and senior OH **Tara Ott** of Westminster.



PAC VOLLEYBALL 2011 - Week 7 Conference Notes

GTs TAKE OVER FIRST: As we head into the final two weeks of the PAC volleyball regular season, the Geneva Golden Tornadoes are alone in first place atop the conference standings ... The GTs, in their first year of eligibility for the PAC title, went 3-0 on the week, surviving a pair of five-set scares vs. Grove City and Saint Vincent with 3-2 wins ... Bethany, which entered the week tied with Geneva for first, suffered its second conference setback of the season with a 3-1 loss at Thiel Saturday.

NEWS & NOTES: Senior MB **Carrie Talkington** recorded 43 kills for 2-1 Bethany last week, becoming just the second Bison player to ever surpass 1,000 career kills ... Thomas More was 4-1 on the week, as junior S **Tori Verville** recorded 123 assists and 32 digs for the Saints ... Thiel junior S **Chelsea Meister** posted a career-high 55 assists for the Tomcats in their five-set home victory against Thomas More Tuesday ... **Devin McGrath** posted 51 assists for Saint Vincent in a five-set loss to Geneva.

AROUND THE PAC: Senior OH **Tara Ott** led Westminster to a 3-0 week by averaging 4.25 kills per set and posting a .400 (34-4-75) hitting percentage ... Senior OH **Mary Masincup** averaged 2.1 kills per set on the week for 1-3 Grove City ... Sophomore **Samantha Chorney** posted 11 kills and 16 digs last week for 0-2 W&J ... Sophomore MB **Lauren Plummer** posted six kills and nine digs last week for 0-2 Chatham ... Sophomore S **Natalie Ranallo** averaged 8.5 aps for 0-3 Waynesburg.

Bethany Bison (23-3, 10-2 PAC)



Bethany won a pair of home matches to open the week, but suffered a 3-1 loss at Thiel Saturday ... BC raced to a 19-0 lead in the first game against Pitt-Greensburg and never looked back in a 3-0 win ... **Carrie Talkington** had 15 kills and **Tiffany Hoffman** finished with 11 aces and 10 digs ... The Bison swept past Waynesburg, but the story of the match was Talkington, who had 14 kills and became just thesecond Bison player to reach 1,000 career kills ... **Taylor Cassidy** had 11 kills, 6 digs and 6 blocks in the win as well ... The Bison could not climb out of a 2-0 deficit and lost in four sets at Thiel Saturday ... Talkington had another strong game with 14 kills and **Jessica Zavatchen** recorded 40 assists.

Chatham Cougars (1-22, 0-12 PAC)



Chatham is currently on a 15-match losing streak after three-set road losses to Thomas More and Westminster last week ... Sophomore MB **Lauren Plummer** executed three kills, five digs, and a .250 attack percentage against Thomas More and added three kills and four digs against Westminster ... Plummer has been a consistent player for the Cougars all year.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes (17-7, 12-1 PAC)



Geneva remains at the top of the PAC mountain after a 3-0 week with victories over Grove City, Bethany and Saint Vincent ... With an overall record of 17-7 including a 12-1 mark in the PAC, the Golden Tornadoes are in the conference driver's seat with only five league matches remaining ... **Deana Briody** continued her great work at the setter position with 146 assists and an average of over 11 assists per game for the week ... Evenly distributing balls to Geneva's big four, Briody is third in the PAC in assists ... Freshman **Erin Smith** is starting to play a major role for the Golden Tornadoes ... Slowly increasing her playing time, Smith threw down 11 kills in Saturday's victory.

Grove City Wolverines (13-12, 4-9 PAC)



A pair of 3-2 home setbacks against the PAC elite dimmed Grove City's bid to move into the league's upper echelon ... In a five-set match with Geneva Tuesday, **Ashley Branch, Taylor Gerent, Shelby Mander** and **Mary Masincup** all had eight kills ... Two nights later, Branch had 11 kills and **Elisabeth Willits** recorded 10 at Westminster ... Saturday, Grove City won the first two sets against Thomas More but the Saints rallied for the win ... Willits (13), Mander (11) and Branch (11) all posted double-digit kill efforts while **Casey Schmidt** had 39 assists ... Masincup highlighted a sweep of Hilbert Saturday with nine kills and a career-high seven aces ... Five different GCC players are averaging over 1.5 kills per set.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (17-7, 7-5 PAC)



The Bearcats went 1-2 this past week, including home losses to Thiel (3-0) and Geneva (3-2) ... In the win over Waynesburg, seniors **Natalie Hozak** and **Taylor Guido** and sophomore **Ariel Rocco** each posted seven kills ... Junior **Devin McGrath** directed the offense for 31 assists and sophomore **Megan Lucas** collected four aces ... Against Thiel, Hozak posted a double-double with 13 kills and 15 digs ... Guido added 10 kills and McGrath totaled 32 assists ... In the five-set match against Geneva, Hozak and Guido combined for 31 kills while sophomores **Brittany Hauser** and **Emily Rosati** added nine kills apiece ... Sophomore **Kaley Burkardt** registered four service aces in the match.

Thiel Tomcats (15-8, 10-4 PAC)



The Tomcat volleyball team had a great week that saw them notch a 3-0 record and move to third place in the PAC ... In the first match, career-days by juniors **Alyssa Chine** and **Chelsea Meister** helped the Tomcats defeat the Saints of Thomas More 3-2 ... Chine tallied 31 kills while making just four errors and Meister registered 55 assists from her setter position in the win ... In match two, the Tomcats traveled to Latrobe and swept the Bearcats 3-0 ... Senior **Megan Kay** and junior **Kelly Barzak** totaled 26 kills and just one error between them ... Thiel then got revenge on the Bison of Bethany, handing them just their third loss on the season as Thiel won 3-1 ... Chine again stood out as she totaled 17 kills.

Thomas More Saints (14-9, 9-4 PAC)



The Saints went 4-1 last week, including a 3-1 record in PAC matches as they lost to Thiel, but rebounded and defeated Chatham, Grove City, Waynesburg and non-conference opponent Hilbert ... The Saints had four players hit over .300 as freshman OH **Lauren Conradi** hit .391, freshman OH **Karsen Cronin** hit .344, sophomore MH **Tyler Deaton** hit .342 and senior MB **Katie Sullivan** hit .308 ... Junior S **Tori Verville** led the team in assists last week with 123 and freshman DS **Kelsey Castiglioni** led the team in digs with 76 ... For the season, Sullivan has a team-best .381 hitting percentage with 211 kills, while senior S **Michelle Clifford** leads the team in assists with 540.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents (7-16, 2-11 PAC)



Washington & Jefferson fell to Westminster and Geneva last week ... The Presidents have now lost five matches in a row ... Sophomore **Samantha Chorney** notched five kills and five digs against Westminster and 11 digs and six kills at Geneva ... Freshman S **Megan Stoehr** passed out 23 assists, six digs and two kills versus the Titans and 18 assists against Geneva ... W&J faces Chatham and Grove City this week.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (8-13, 2-11 PAC)



The Yellow Jackets went 0-3 against three of the top teams in the PAC this past week ... The Yellow Jackets dropped 3-0 matches to Saint Vincent, Bethany and Thomas More, but the week still featured a major highlight as the team hosted its annual Dig Pink match against the Bearcats on Oct. 11 ...
