PAC Volleyball Player of the Week

BRITTANY MORROW Waynesburg College 6-0 sophomore midle hitter Beaver, Pa./Beaver H.S.

Morrow led Waynesburg to a 6-0 week by averaging 4.82 kills per game, as the Yellow Jackets posted their school-record win streak to 18 matches and clinched the top seed for the PAC Tournament. She was named Tournament MVP at the Clearwater Christian Invitational after averaging 4.47 kpg in five matches, including a career-high 32 kills against the host Cougars.

Also nominated was senior MH Abbey Otto of Bethany, junior OH Rachel Peterson of Grove City, junior MH Jessica Erickson of Thiel, junior OH Jerica Lamens of Washington & Jefferson, and sophomore OH Erin Hinks of Westminster.

PAC VOLLEYBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison

Bethany split a pair of matches last week and is now carrying a 12-13 record... The Bison cruised to a 3-0 win over Pitt-Greensburg behind 11 kills from Abbey Otto and Shae Baxter ... Otto had two aces and three blocks as well, while Lindsey Cowser finished with 30 assists in the match ... Despite sterling efforts from Otto and Baxter against Grove City, the Bison fell in four to the visiting Lady Wolverines ... Otto posted 18 kills and just two errors in 37 attacks, while Baxter collected 16 kills and nine digs in the match ... Cowser dished out 50 assists in the setback, which was Bethany's sixth consecutive defeat in PAC play.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J evened its overall record at 12-12 this week by defeating Thiel, 3-2, in its only match of the week ... Junior outside hitter Jerica Lamens totaled 19 kills, seven digs and three blocks to lead the Presidents ... Sophomore middle hitter Rebecca Fletcher added 14 kills, six blocks and five digs, while freshman setter Jamie Gullen dished out a game-high 51 assists to go with five blocks ... Senior outside hitter Dana Wright posted nine kills, four digs and three blocks and sophomore middle hitter Ashley Savage also contributed nine kills, five digs, four blocks and three service aces ... W&J continues its conference schedule on Tuesday by traveling to New Wilmington, Pa., to battle Westminster at 7:00 pm ... The Presidents snapped a 15match losing streak to the Lady Titans earlier this year in Washington.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City kept its hopes for a winning conference record alive last week ... Six Grove City players had at least nine kills against Bethany, led by 13 each from Lisa Bodi, Kate DiMarco and Kelly Tinney ... Junior Rachel Peterson had a career-high 10 kills in the win ... Grove City opened the week with a 3-0 loss at Waynesburg, giving the season series to the Yellow Jackets ... Grove City closes the season with three straight home matches against league opposition ... Grove City is looking to snap a 12-match losing streak against Westminster this Thursday ... The Lady Wolverines last beat Westminster in 1996, 2-1 ... Grove City has never finished with a losing record in PAC play ... In 2002, Grove City went 6-4 in league play.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg set a school record when it traveled to Clearwater, Fla., over the weekend ... The Jackets won the Clearwater Christian College Invitational with five wins, the team's 18th straight win breaking the mark of 17 set by the 1985 team, which finished 37-3 as NAIA District 18 champs ... Sophomore Brittany Morrow was named tournament MVP after averaging 4.47 kills per game, including a career-high and team season match-high 32 kills in the first of two wins over the host Cougars ... Ronnie Jo Meyers was named to the all-tournament team as she averaged 3.58 kills per game ... Waynesburg also clinched at least a tie for the No. 1 seed in the PAC Tournament after defeating Grove City, 3-0, on Tuesday ... Morrow had 21 kills in the win, giving her 4.82 kills per game last week.

Thiel Tomcats

Thiel went 1-2 overall and 0-2 in PAC action last week ... Both conference losses last week came by way of five-set matches ... The Tomcats have went to five sets in five of their last six matches (2-3) ... Junior MH Jessica Erickson finished with 20 kills and nine blocks in the Tomcats' 2-3 loss against W&J ... Thiel finished with four posting doubledigit kills in their 3-1 win at Ursuline ... Erickson (17), sophomore MH Maggie Marsh (16), senior OH Jan Willman (14) and freshman OH Trisha McLaughlin (11) each had double digits in kills in the non-conference victory, while senior S Tiffany Snyder totaled 59 assists ... Thiel traded sets with Westminster but fell 15-10 in the fifth to suffer the 2-3 defeat... Erickson had another tremendous effort with 16 kills and nine blocks.

Westminster Titans

Westminster won its only match of the week, as the Lady Titan spikers posted a five-set victory victory at Thiel College ... Three players posted double-digit kill totals for Westminster in the win ... Leading the way for the Lady Titan spikers was sophomore outside hitter Erin Hinks with 23 kills ... Senior outside hitter Diana Barnes posted 12 kills, while freshman middle hitter Kate McDermott added 11 ... Junior middle hitter Sarah McKain and freshman outside hitter/ setter Rachael Cooper recorded eight kills apiece ... Sophomore Candice Anderson and junior Lauren Lalama posted 28 and 22 assists, respectively ... Junior Sara Miller bumped up a team-best 20 digs, while McKain added a team-high eight blocks (five solo, three assisted).
