Thomas More will host Thiel on Sunday at 10 a.m., as the Saints will look to avenge their only conference defeat of the season, a five-set loss to the Tomcats in Greenville on Oct. 10 ... Thiel also currently only has one league loss, a five-set defeat at W&J on Sept. 21

#### Bethany Bison (12-11, 3-7 PAC)

In their only action of the week, the Bison roared back from a 0-2 deficit to stun Geneva in five sets last Thursday, the program's first win over the GTs

since 1992 ... After losing the first two sets, BC took the third and led 23-19 in the fourth before Geneva rallied and had match point ... The Bison would fend off that point and pulled out a 30-28 win in the fourth, then controlled the decisive game to post their first five-set victory since 2007 ... City College ... Both losses were in three sets ... The Cougars will host Washington and Jefferson College on Tuesday, October 20th at 7 pm in their "Dig Pink" match, as they try to raise money for breast cancer awareness ... The team will round out the week of conference play as they host Thiel College on Saturday, October 24th ... The match is set for 1:30

#### Geneva Golden Tornadoes (15-7)

Geneva suffered through its first losing week of the season dropping two of three matches ... The Golden Tornadoes watched Bethany rally from two GOLDEN TORNADOES games down to steal a 3-2 decision last Thursday
