Summers collected a total of 66 kills in four matches last week, as Grove City went 3-1 including a four-set win against Bridgewater, which was 20-2 entering the match. She recorded 20 kills and 16 digs in the Bridgewater win.

Bethany Bison

Bethany snapped an eight-game losing streak with a 3-0 victory over LaRoche on Saturday ... **Peggy Emmerling** had 10 kills and four blocks, while **Abbey Otto** totaled nine kills and four aces ... Earlier in the week, the Bison dropped their final two PAC matches of the season to Waynesburg and Thiel ... Against Waynesburg, **Shae Baxter** had 13 kills and Emmerling finished with 11 ... In the Thiel loss, Otto hammered down 14 and Emmerling tallied 13.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J's losing skid was extended to four games this past week with losses to Grove City (3-1) and Waynesburg (3-0) ... Senior setter Andrea Motta posted 34 assists and 23 digs to lead the Presidents in the loss to the Wolverines, while sophomore middle hitter Jerica Lamens totaled a team-high 10 kills and also added 15 digs and senior outside hitter Jessica notched seven kills ... Freshmen middle hitter Becky Fletcher and outside hitter Kristen Baressi also picked up six kills each ... Junior outside hitter Dana Wright and Lamens led the Presidents with eight kills a piece in the loss to Waynesburg ... Wright also added 14 digs ... Motta amassed 23 assists and 15

digs, while Fletcher totaled six kills and four blocks.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg is peaking at the right time, as the Jackets are riding a season-high six-match winning streak after topping Washington & Jefferson Thursday, 3-0, for its final regular season PAC match of the season ... Kathy Twaddle led the Jackets with 21 kills, while Katie Beall chipped in with 40 assists ... Ronnie Jo Meyers led the defense with 36 digs ... On Tuesday, the Jackets defeated Bethany, 3-1, on the road for the first time after nine straight home matches ...
