PAC VOLLEYBALL 2008 - Week 8 Conference Notes

TMC HANDS TITANS 1ST PAC LOSS: The Thomas More Saints handed the Westminster Titans their first PAC loss of the year Saturday, tightening up the top of the league standings ... W&J, with three PAC wins last week, now stands 1/2 game behind the Titans while TMC is 1 1/2 games out ... W&J travels to Westminster for a key PAC matchup on Tuesday evening ... Geneva finished 2-2 and in third place in the five-team NCCAA Eastern Regional, hosted by the Golden Tornadoes in Beaver Falls.

WHO'S HOT: Junior OH **Kristine Rust** hit .302 with 25 kills, seven digs and five blocks for 3-0 Thomas More last week ... Senior MH **Natalie Liberati** posted 4.11 kps and 2.78 dps for 2-1 Grove City last week, including 14 kills each against Saint Vincent and Penn State-Beaver ... Bethany freshman OH **Courtney Meadows** posted double-doubles for the Bison in five-set losses to Geneva (11K, 12D) and Thiel (22K-15D) last week ... **Diana Petrovich** had 41 kills for 3-0 Saint Vincent last week.

NEWS & NOTES: Freshman MB **Lindsay Speidel** led Westminster to a 2-1 week by averaging 3.17 kips, including 14 kills at Thomas More and 13 vs. Waynesburg, while adding 13 total blocks for the week ... Freshman OH **Megan Kay** posted 33 kills and 39 digs in 10 sets for 1-1 Thiel last week ... Senior OH **Laurie Lindner** posted 63 kills last week, leading the 0-4 Yellow Jackets in all four matches ... Junior **Erika Juran** posted double-digit dig totals in all three matches for 0-3 Chatham last week.

Bethany Bison (5-19, 2-8 PAC)

The Bison are playing their best volleyball of the season at the right time, as they battled Geneva and Thiel to five-set losses on the road before sweeping Chatham Saturday ... **Courtney Meadows** had 11 kills and 12 digs, **Megan Hoffman** gave out 27 assists and **Tiffany Hoffman** had 25 digs in the setback at Geneva ... Meadows had another stellar night at Thiel, hammering 22 kills and bringing up 15 digs, while Tiffany Hoffman tied a career-high with 29 digs and **Sumner Scott**, who had six blocks at Geneva, recorded another five against the Tomcats ... **Alyssa Schrecengost** led the Chatham victory with 12 kills and 10 digs, while **Carrie Talkington** had five blocks and Scott posted four.



Chatham Cougars (0-19, 0-10 PAC)

Chatham dropped three PAC matches this week ... Junior **Erika Juran** is leading the way on defense with double digit digs in each of the three games on the week, including a team-high 22 in a loss at Bethany College ... Chatham will look for its first win of the season when they host Thiel on Tuesday, October 21.



Geneva Golden Tornadoes (19-7)

After defeating Bethany in five games on Tuesday, the Golden Tornadoes took their shot in a five-team NCCAA Eastern Regional at Geneva over the weekend ... The Golden Tornadoes came away with a third place finish and a record of 2-2 in the round-robin format ... The Golden Tornadoes defeated Roberts Wesleyan and Nyack but lost matches to former AMC foes Malone and Mt. Vernon Nazarene ... It was MVNU with a perfect 4-0 record that captured the title and the automatic bid into the national tournament ... Geneva continued to serve brilliantly last week with a total of 55 service aces in five matches, averaging 2.75 aces per game.



Grove City Wolverines (9-18, 3-6 PAC)

Grove City earned its third conference win of the season Thursday night by sweeping visiting Chatham ... **Natalie Liberati** posted nine kills while **Inge Rasmussen** had seven kills ... Setter **Annie Barry** recorded 32 assists ... Earlier that evening, the Wolverines blanked Penn State-Beaver ... Liberati posted 14 kills while Barry had 37 assists ... The teams had only met once prior, with Grove City winning in 1979 ... The Wolverines opened the week with a setback at Saint Vincent ... Liberati collected 14 kills while **Kim Budd** had 17 digs ... Grove City visits Washington & Jefferson Thursday night before hosting Thomas More Saturday at 11 a.m.



Saint Vincent Bearcats (18-7)

The Lady Bearcats went 3-0 on the week with a trio of three set victories ... In Tuesday's win over Grove City, **Diana Petrovich** led both sides with 12 kills, while **Dawn Timko** added 10 ... **Christa Calgario** posted 17 digs and **Taylor Guido** 15, while **Kelsie Bumbarger** dished out 32 assists to go with 10 digs and three aces ... At Saturday's tri-match with Allegheny and Kenyon, Petrovich tallied 29 kills in the two victories and Timko 16 ... Calgario had 21 digs and Guido 20, while Bumbarger had 66 assists and **Anna Wasik** eight blocks.



Thiel Tomcats (12-13, 7-4 PAC)

Thiel went 1-1 last week in a pair of PAC games ... On Oct. 16, Thiel downed Bethany, 3-2, in a hard-fought battle at Beeghly Gymnasium to improve to .500 on the season ... In Oct. 18's loss at Washington & Jefferson, the Presidents vetoed a Thiel win by coming back from a 2-1 deficit to win in five games ... Freshman outside hitter **Megan Kay** paced Thiel by firing 33 kills on the week (10 sets) hitting .385 (3.3 kps) ... Defensively, she compiled 39 digs (3.9 dps)... Kay registered a double-double in each match.



Thomas More Saints (21-5, 7-2 PAC)

Thomas More extended its win streak to seven last week with three wins ... Junior OH **Kristine Rust** hit .302 last week with 25 kills, seven digs and five blocks ... Freshman S **Michelle Clifford** led the team with assists with 124 and also had 37 digs and 10 kills with a .270 hitting percentage ... Freshman DS **Emily Bohman** led the Saint defense with 68 digs, while freshman OH **Hillary Monnin** led the team in blocks with nine ... Through the Saints' 26 matches, sophomore OH **Lindsay Svec** leads the team in kills with 224, while Bohman leads the team with 419 digs and Clifford has 979 assists.



Washington & Jefferson Presidents (13-8, 9-2 PAC)

The Presidents went a perfect 3-0 this week, including a pair of home victories which required comebacks from 2-1 deficits ... Sophomore S **Mia Serine** brought W&J back versus Waynesburg Thursday, finishing with 37 assists, 16 digs, three aces and two blocks ... Sophomore MH **Courtney Sherwin** had 12 kills and five blocks, while classmate **Courtney Holdrieth** had 11 kills and 13 digs ... Sherwin set a career-high with 24 kills against the Tomcats, while also picking up nine blocks ... Serine added 47 assists, while junior LIB **Nellica Davis** had 20 digs ...
