Bethany Bison

Bethany lost three PAC matches last week to fall to 2-10 in the conference ... In the setback to Thiel, senior **Lauren Spegal** had 10 kills to break the

school's all-time kills record and with her 39 for the week, she now has 1,229 for her career ...Freshman **Emily Stewart** led Bethany in kills in two of the three matches, as she notched 11 against Thiel and 12 at W&J ... Spegal spearheaded the BC offense against Waynesburg with 17 kills ... Junior **Kim McKay** totaled 85 assists for the week, including 34 against Thiel, while the defense was led by sophomore **Rachael Dunham**, who double digits in digs all three matches, including 14 against Waynesburg.



Geneva Golden Tornadoes

The Golden Tornadoes went 3-2 last week, but the two losses proved to be costly at the NCCAA East Regional tournament ... Geneva dropped

matches to Mt. Vernon and Malone at the weekend tournament as they came back with a third place finish ...
