PAC Volleyball Player of the Week

BRIANNE MALLOZZI - Waynesburg College

6-0 Senior Middle Hitter - Baden, Pa./Ambridge H.S.

Mallozzi earned PAC Player of the Week honors for the second time this season after leading Waynesburg to wins over PAC leader Grove City (3-1), who was previously unbeaten in PAC play, and league rival Bethany (3-0). She recorded 39 kills and 14 solo blocks in the two matches, tying the Waynesburg school record for blocks in a match with nine against Grove City.

Also nominated was sophomore hitter **Shae Baxter** of Bethany and sophomore outside hitter **Dana Wright** of Washington & Jefferson.

Bethany Bison

A 3-1 week for the Bison was capped off with a 3-1 win over Pitt-Johnstown, who entered the game with a 24-3 record ... Five Bison recorded double digit kills, led by **Katie Critchfield** with 15 ... For the week, Critchfield posted 42 kills, while **Shae Baxter** hammered down 38 kills ... **Lori Edwards** was strong defensively, recording 86 digs for the week ... She had a big offensive game against UPJ, with 13 kills and zero errors in 41 attacks ... **Caci Iwaniec** averaged 29 assists over the four matches.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J finished the week with a 1-1 record with a loss at Westminster and a PAC win at Thiel ... The Presidents ended its PAC schedule with a 3-5 record ... Junior outside hitter **Jessica Dott** and freshman outside hitter **Mari Starr** each posted a team-high seven kills in the win over the Tomcats ...
