PAC Volleyball Player of the Week

LESLIE HOELSCHER Thomas More College

6-1 freshman middle blocker Fort Loramie, Ohio Fort Loramie H.S.

Hoelscher led the Saints to a 3-0 week (2-0 against PAC competition) by posting 52 kills (4.73 kpg),

and 20 blocks (1.82 bpg). She now has 48 blocks on the season, breaking the old Thomas More single-season mark of 44.

Also nominated was senior OH Linzy Turner of Bethany, senior MH Carlie Roberts of Grove City, freshman OH Latoya Locke of Thiel, junior MH Beth Mihalik of Washington & Jefferson, and junior OH Diana Conzett of Westminster.

Bethany Bison

After a 3-0 loss at Thiel, the Bison snapped a seven-game losing streak with a 3-0 win over Penn State-Fayette ... Senior **Linzy Turner** had nine kills and 15 digs, while sophomore **Kim McKay** recorded 18 assists and 12 digs in the

setback to Thiel ... Senior **Angelina Allen** led the defense with 29 digs ... The Bison then sent their three seniors out on a winning note with the victory over PSU-Fayette ... All three played big roles in the triumph, as Turner had seven kills and 14 digs, while **Amanda Bashioum** totaled seven kills, 10 digs and three blocks ... Allen paced the defensive effort with 16 digs ... The offense was led by **Lauren Spegal**, who hammered 14 kills, and McKay, who set 25 assists ... The Bison will play three non-league matches this week, plus their final PAC contest of the season at Waynesburg Saturday.



Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats won their first PAC match in nearly two years last week when they swept Bethany 3-0 (30-24, 30-13, 31-29) ... Freshman OH **LaToya Locke** led the Tomcats in that match with 18 kills while freshman S **Kristen Martin** handed out 40 assists ... Also, **Erin Plaso** and

Leah Snyder combined for 22 digs ... The Tomcats lost a pair of matches at the Thomas More Tri-Match Saturday, falling to Thomas More 3-1 and Case Western Reserve 3-0 ... The Tomcats close out the 2006 campaign this week with a pair of home matches against Washington & Jefferson and Westminster ... The team's final action of the season will take place on Saturday, Oct. 28 at the Waynesburg Tri-Match.



Washington & Jefferson Presidents

The Presidents posted a 2-1 record during the week to clinch its third winning season in the past four years ... The Presidents swept a pair of matches on Saturday as junior OH **Gabby Zagari** notched 12 kills and 10 digs in the victory over Westminster ... Junior MH **Beth Mihalik** added 11 kills and seven blocks, while senior setter

Jamie Gullen amassed 45 assists, 10 digs and six kills ... Eleven different Presidents notched at least one kill in the 3-0 win over Point Park ... Zagari had five kills, while Mihalik notched five blocks and two service aces ... Junior Emily Yaros and freshman Anna Miskis-Neilson led the defense with eight digs ... Gullen recorded 35 assists and two kills in the loss to GCC ... Senior OH Amanda Williamson and senior MH TarynTerchanik totaled eight kills each.



Westminster Titans

Westminster enters this week in sole possession of first place in the PAC, one half-game ahead of the three teams tied for second place ... The Titans began the week with a come-from-behind 3-2 PAC home win over Waynesburg Tuesday ... The Titans trailed 2-0 before winning the final three games, including the fifth game that was tied 13-13 until junior **Diana Conzett** and senior **Rachel Cooper** scored the go-ahead and deciding final two points ... Conzett hit a career-high 23 kills ... The Titans then lost at W&J Saturday in four

games, as senior **Katie McDermott** paced the team with 14 kills and 18 digs, while sophomore **Traci Hassell** totaled 36 assists. McDermott and sophomore **Rachel Terzak** led the Titans with nine kills each in a 3-0 non-league win over Point Park at W&J Saturday.



Grove City Wolverines

Grove City moved closer to clinching a berth in the season-ending PAC Tournament by splitting a pair of PAC matches last week ... The Wolverines opened the week with a 3-0 home loss to Saint Vincent Tuesday ... However,

GCC bounced back for a home sweep of W&J Thursday ... It is Grove City's first regular-season sweep of W&J since 2001 ... Carlie Roberts posted a dozen kills vs. W&J, while Heather Fraiz added 10 kills and sophomore Natalie Liberati had four blocks ... Saturday, the Wolverines went 1-1 at Thomas More ... Grove City fell to TMC but rebounded for a neutral-site win over Case Western in four games ... Roberts had 18 kills against Thomas More, helping her average 3.64 kills for the week ... Grove City is now 10-3 on neutral floors this year.



Thomas More Saints

The Saints lost just two game in going unbeaten for the week as they were 3-0 overall, 2-0 in the PAC ... Freshman

Leslie Hoelscher set a new single-season solo block record in the win over Wilmington ... For the week, the 6-1 middle blocker had 52 kills (4.73 per game) and 20 blocks (1.82 per game) ... She added seven service aces, 10 digs and two assists ... Sophomore Jessica Tyner recorded 36 kills, including a season-high 17 against Grove City, and freshman Kristine Rust had 40 kills ... Junior Valeri Kuhn dished out 51 assists in the win over Grove City, for her seventh 50-plus assist match of the season.



Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Yellow Jackets suffered three straight defeats, including a conference loss to Westminster and nationally-ranked Hiram ... Against the Titans, Waynesburg won the first two games before dropping the next

three games and the match ... Sophomore Laurie Lindner led the Yellow Jackets with 20 kills, while senior Kaci Hlad and freshman Mary Beth Crouch added 17 and 13, respectively ... Freshman Caitie Morgan led the team with 26 digs and Lindner posted a double-double with 17 digs ... The Yellow Jackets dropped a pair of matches at a tri-match hosted by Hiram ... Against Kenyon, Hlad led the team with 11 kills, while Morgan had 12 digs ... Against 16th–ranked Hiram, Hlad and Crouch led the team with eight kills, while four players netted 10-plus digs.



Saint Vincent Bearcats

After posting sweeps of PAC rival Grove City and Mount Aloysius, the Lady Bearcats have won 14 consecutive matches by 3-0 scores, for a total of 42 consecutive game victories ... Against Grove City, **Jaime Kelly** tallied 13 kills, with no errors in 20 attempts ... She also blocked

four shots and had two service aces ... **Shannon McVay** had 11 kills, with no errors in 21 attempts ... McVay blocked five shots. **Lauren Paddick** had 9 kills, with no errors in 17 attempts and five blocks.
