# **PAC Volleyball Player of the Week**

# CARLIE ROBERTS **Grove City College**

6-0 sophomore middle hitter Union City, Pa./Union City H.S.

Roberts helped Grove City hand defending PAC champion Waynesburg its first league loss of the season Thursday, as she posted 17 kills and six blocks in the four-set win. Earlier in the week, she recorded eight kills and three blocks in a three-set PAC sweep of Thiel.

Also nominated was senior MH Jessica Erickson of Thiel, junior OH Lakia Gordon of Washington & Jefferson, junior MH Brittany **Morrow** of Waynesburg, and freshman OH Hannah Parker of Westminster.

### **Bethany Bison**

Bethany lost two road matches last week, at W&J (3-0) and Chatham (3-1) ... The Bison took the first game against Chatham on Friday by a score of 30-17, but then lost the next three games, 30-23, 30-28, 30-28 ... Three Bison recorded over 30 digs in the contest, led by Michelle Fowler's 39, while Heather Bainey added 31 and Lauren Spegal had 30 ... Peggy Emmerling added a teamhigh 15 kills ... The Bison also had nine service aces, their most since recording 12 against La Roche on Sept. 14 ... Against W&J, the Bison lost by scores of 30-21, 30-24 and 30-24 ... Angelina Allen led the team with 15 digs.

## Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J won two matches, but was on the losing end of three others this past weekend ... Junior MH Rebecca Fletcher led the victory over the Tomcats with 17 kills, eight digs and five blocks ... Senior OH Jerica Lamens added 10 kills and 12 digs, while sophomore MH Taryn Terchanik posted nine kills ... Junior OH Lakia Gordon racked up 10 kills in the loss to Heidelberg Friday, while sophomore S Jamie Gullen notched 15 assists and eight digs ... Lamens drilled home 17 kills and added 13 digs and two blocks in the loss to Denison ... Junior libero Anne Reynolds also added 22 digs and two aces ... Following the Kenyon Tournament in which W&J placed fifth, Gordon was named to the All-Tournament Team.

# PAC VOLLEYBALL NOTES

### Grove City Wolverines

Grove City picked up a pair of PAC wins last week, including a 3-1 win over Waynesburg Thursday night ... The Wolverines snapped Waynesburg's 18-match PAC win streak ... Sophomore Carlie Roberts had 17 kills and six blocks in the victory while classmate Kelly Tinney added 13 kills ... Freshman S Kim Walsh racked up 45 assists in the win ... Senior Kate DiMarco tallied 14 kills Tuesday as Grove City swept Thiel ... Roberts added eight kills and three blocks while freshman Katie Skinner had a career-high eight kills ... Walsh had 36 assists and is averaging 10.55 per game since being inserted into the starting lineup late last month ... Gr ove City has matched its PAC win total from 2003.

## Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg had two lengthy win streaks snapped this week .. A five-game match against the Titans by the Jackets extended their home winning streak to 20 matches, while their regular season conference win streak was 18 straight matches ... Libero Lauren Freeman set a career-high 31 digs, after posting 30 in the previous match ... On Thursday, Grove City ended the Jackets' conference win streak with a four-game victory, while IUP on Saturday ended the Jackets' home win streak with another fourgame match ... The Jackets rebounded to take the final two games of the guad match this weekend against Fairmont State and Pitt-Johnstown ... Junior Brittany Morrow posted a team-best 4.30 kills per game average during the week.

### Thiel Tomcats

Thiel snapped its nine-match losing streak on Monday with a 3-2 come-frombehind victory over Point Park, but dropped a pair of conference matches ... The Tomcats fell at home to Grove City 3-0 on Tuesday and 3-0 at W&J on Thursday ... Senior MH **Jessica Erickson** finished with 17 kills, 10 digs and four blocks while sophomore S **Erin Plaso** added 36 assists and 20 digs in the Point Park victory ... Erickson totaled 20 kills, six digs and four blocks vs. Grove City and finished with 13 kills, five digs and three blocks at W&J.

## Westminster Titans

Westminster dropped a heartbreaking five-set decision at Waynesburg Tuesday before rebounding with straight-set wins over La Roche and Pitt-Bradford Saturday ... Freshman OH Hannah Parker had team-high totals of 13 kills and two service aces at Waynesburg, while junior OH Erin Hinks and senior MH Sarah McKain each added 10 and sophomore MH Katie McDermott recorded nine. Sophomore Rachael Cooper had a team-best 35 assists in the loss, while senior Sara Miller led the squad with 28 digs ... Parker had a team-high 11 kills vs. La Roche, while Hinks added 10 kills and a team-best three service aces ... Hinks tallied a team-high 15 kills and tied frosh Jessica Cooper with four solo blocks each vs. UP-B.
