Hozak had a big week for the 2-1 Bearcats, as she recorded 27 kills (3.4 kps)

and 63 digs (7.9 dps) to go along with six blocks and four service aces in eight sets for Saint Vincent. She posted nine kills. 24 digs and thre blocks in a loss at PAC leaderr Thomas More, then tallied nine kills, 26 digs and two aces in a sweep of Waynesburg. She played just two sets in a sweep of PAC foe Chatham, recording eight kills, 13 digs and one ace. She now has 15 20+ dig performances this season and at least one ace in all 23 Bearcat matches.

Also nominated was junior MB Carrie Talkington of Bethany, junior MH Kelly Barzak of Thiel, junior OH Brandi Corbello of Thomas More, senior MH Courtney Sherwin of Washington & Jefferson, and junior MB Lindsay Speidel of Westminster.

Defending PAC champion Thomas More remains in control of the top spot and home court advantage throughout the tournament, as the Saints remained unbeaten in league play with a 3-0 week ... W&J and Grove City, who meet on Tuesday, are battling for the sixth and final tournament slot.

Saint Vincent senior OH Natalie Hozak had 27 kills, 63 digs and six blocks for the 2-1 Bearcats last week ... Junior MB Lindsay Speidel had 38 kills in a pair of PAC matches for 2-0 Westminster ... Freshman S Deanna Brody posted 52 assists for Geneva in a four-set win at Thiel.

Barzak hit .389 last week with nine toal blocks for 2-2 Thiel ... Junior MB Carrie Talkington had 28 kills for Bethany during a 1-1 PAC week ... Elisabeth Willits led Grove City in a four-set loss at Westminster with 16 kills ... Waynesburg ended a 10-match losing streak with a 3-0 PAC home sweep of Chatham Friday ... Sophomore Julianne Spinney posted 38 assists for Chatham during two matches at Waynesburg (with Saint Vincent).

Bethany Bison (20-10, 8-5 PAC)

After losing to PAC leader Thomas More in three sets, the Bison posted a historic victory at Grove City ... Carrie Talkington's 13 kills were not enough

in the loss to Saints, as Bethany lost its first match of the season at home (7-1) ... The four-set win at Grove City was sparked by 15 kills from Talkington and 12 from **Taylor Cassidy**, while **Jessica Zavatchen** passed out 46 assists and brought up 15 digs ... The win was the 20^{th} of the year for BC, just the fourth 20+ win season in school history ... It was also the Bison's first-ever victory at Grove City in a series that dates back to 1985 and was the eighth conference triumph of the year, which ties the school-record for PAC wins set by the 1987 Bison team.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes (23-5)



Adriane Blake averaged nearly 4.5 kills per game in helping Geneva to a 2-1 week ... The Golden Tornadoes did fall to Thomas More 3-0 Saturday, but not before victories against Waynesburg and

Thiel pushed Geneva's overall record to 23-5 in matching the record for most wins in a season set back in 1986 ... Geneva is a perfect 7-0 and will try to accomplish its first perfect home season in school history when it hosts Grove City Thursday night ... Freshman S **Deanna Briody** picked up 52 assists in Geneva's 3-1 victory over Thiel Thursday and finished the week with an average of 11.0 assists per game.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (21-8, 10-5 PAC)



The Bearcats went 2-1 in three PAC matches on the week, rebounding from a 3-0 loss at Thomas More on Monday by sweeping a PAC tri-match with Chatham and Waynesburg Friday ... Natalie Hozak averaged

3.37 kills and 7.8 digs per set, posting nine kills in both the Thomas More and Waynesburg matches ... She also totaled six blocks and four aces

... **Diana Petrovich** and **Taylor Guido** each posted 19 kills on the week, with Petrovich totaling six blocks, while S **Devin McGrath** had 88 assists, 35 digs, and four aces on the week ... With the win over Chatham Friday, the team clinched its sixth straight 20-victory season, and 13th in the 25-year history of the program.

Thomas More Saints (23-7, 13-0 PAC)

Junior DS Emily Bohman led the team in digs with 91 and junior S Michelle Clifford led the team in assists with 84.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (8-19, 2-12 PAC)



The Waynesburg women's volleyball team went 1-2 this past week and ended a 10-match losing streak in the process ... The Yellow Jackets swept through

Chatham in a home tri-match this past Saturday, before falling to Saint Vincent later in the day ... Freshman **Katelyn Blaich** led the Yellow Jacket attack with 2.22 kills per set ... Another freshman, **Shayla Mitrik**, led the team's defense with a squad-best 3.5 digs per set ... Yet another first-year athlete, **Mabel Culp**, piled up a team-best eight blocks.
