PAC VOLLEYBALL 2009 - Week 9 Conference Notes

SAINTS CLINCH TOP SEED: The Thomas More Saints have clinched the top seed and hosting rights for the 2009 PAC Volleyball Championship Tournament, scheduled for Nov. 3-7 ... TMC clinched the top spot by virtue of a thrilling five-set home victory over Thiel on Sunday ... The Tomcats are now in a battle with defending PAC champion Westminster and Washington & Jefferson for the second seed and a first-round tournament bye ... Grove City and Bethany have also clinched tournament berths.

NEWS & NOTES: Sophomore S **Emily Bohman** set up 176 assists and added 49 digs and 10 aces during a 4-1 week for Thomas More ... Saint Vincent clinched its fourth consecutive 20-win season, and 14th in team history, after going 2-1 last week behind 33 kills by **Natalie Hozak** ... Junior OH **Courtney Holdrieth** had 13 kills, 12 digs and three aces in a pair of PAC wins for W&J last week ... Senior OH **Sam Botzum** averaged 4.09 kills and 3.45 digs per set last week for 3-1 Westminster.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: Chatham raised nearly \$1,000 for the fight against breast cancer in the Cougars' "Dig Pink" match against W&J ... Freshman S **Jessica Zavatchen** posted 154 assists and 58 digs in four matches for 2-2 Bethany ... **Adriane Blake** had 45 kills in three matches for 1-2 Geneva at the Juniata Invitational ... Freshman MH **Kelly Barzak** recorded 43 kills and five blocks for 2-3 Thiel last week ... Freshman S **Carly Smithyman** had 27 assists for Waynesburg in a 3-1 PAC loss to Bethany.

Bethany Bison (14-13, 4-8 PAC)

The Bison went 2-2 last week, but most importantly, clinched a spot in the PAC Tournament for the first time since 2004 with a 3-1 win at Waynesburg ...

Jessica Zavatchen had 44 assists and 19 digs and **Lauren Goodwill** had 11 kills, as BC pushed Saint Vincent to the limit before falling 3-2 to open the week ... The playoff clinching win at Waynesburg was highlighted by 14 kills each from **Alyssa Schrecengost** and Goodwill and Zavatchen posting 44 assists and 18 digs ... After a 3-0 loss at Thomas More Saturday, the Bison beat Rose-Hulman (19-10) 3-1 to split at the Thomas More Tri-Match ... Zavatchen was the spark again, posting a career-high 51 assists and four players had double digit kills.



Chatham Cougars (1-23, 0-13 PAC)

Chatham completed its home schedule this week as they took on Washington and Jefferson College and Thiel College in Presidents' Athletic Conference action ... Both matches ended in a loss for Chatham, each in three sets ... The match against W&J was also the Cougars' Dig Pink match, in which the team raised nearly \$1,000 for the fight against breast cancer by conducting a bake sale, selling T-shirts, and accepting donations.



Geneva Golden Tornadoes (16-10)

The Golden Tornadoes managed one victory in four matches last week against some of the most difficult competition in the country ... Following a five-game loss to Thiel Tuesday, the GTs traveled to the Juniata Tournament over the weekend ... The tournament started well with Geneva defeating York in three games, but Saturday saw the Golden Tornadoes drop matches to Juniata and Carnegie Mellon ... Juniata entered the weekend with an overall record of 26-2 and the three opponents for Geneva had a combined record of 51-20 ... **Adriane Blake** finished the tournament with 45 kills ... The Golden Tornadoes will return home this week to close out their home schedule.



Grove City Wolverines (7-20, 4-8 PAC)

Grove City fell to 4-8 in the conference with three PAC losses last week ... The Wolverines opened the week with a 3-0 setback vs. Westminster ... **Anna McCurdy** tallied nine kills for Grove City ... Thursday, W&J earned a 3-0 win over the visiting Wolverines ... McCurdy again totaled nine kills ... Saturday, GCC competed in a tri-match at Thomas More ... The Wolverines fell to Thomas More, 3-0, then dropped a four-set battle with Rose-Hulman ... McCurdy had 13 kills while Rasmussen had 12 against Rose-Hulman ... Sophomore **Rebecca Yuhus** recorded a career-high 34 assists against Rose-Hulman ... Grove City has clinched one of the six spots in the PAC Championship Tournament.



Saint Vincent Bearcats (20-9)

The Bearcats clinched their fourth straight 20-win season, and 14th in team history, by going 2-1 on the week, defeating Bethany and Thiel before falling to Thomas More ... **Natalie Hozak** had 33 kills in the three matches and **Taylor Guido** 30, while **Rachel Pace** had a strong week at the net, posting 19 blocks, including eight in the win over Bethany ... Also in the Bethany contest, **Devin McGrath** served up a career-high 54 assists, while **Christa Calgano** notched her sixth 20+ dig performance of the year, with 22 ... In the win over Thiel, **Dawn Timko** had a career day, with 12 kills and nine blocks, while she also owned the team lead with six kills against Thomas More.



Thiel Tomcats (20-10, 9-3 PAC)

Thiel experienced more than its fair share of ups and downs during the second-to-last week of the regular season, as they extended their winning streak to ten, won 20 matches for the first time since 1986, but also fell to a trio of PAC opponents ... Thiel won its tenth match in a row on Tuesday night at Geneva ... The 3-2 win was Thiel's third five-set match in four games ... The Tomcats rebounded with an easy 3-0 win over Chatham on Saturday to win its 20th ... On Sunday, Thiel was swept at a PAC tri-match by Thomas More and Saint Vincent ... Thiel has two PAC matches on tap at Beeghly Gymnasium this week – they welcome Grove City on Tuesday and W&J on Thursday... Both matches begin at 7 p.m.



Thomas More Saints (25-9, 13-1 PAC)

The Saints went 4-1 last week, including a 3-0 mark in the PAC that clinched the outright PAC regular-season title and the No. 1 seed in the upcoming PAC Championship Tournament ... Sophomore OH **Brandi Corbello** led the Saints offense with 17 kills and 11 service aces, while also adding 56 digs and three blocks ... Sophomore S **Emily Bohman** recorded 176 assists and added 10 service aces and added 49 digs and five blocks ... Freshman DS **Danielle Beckenhaupt** led the team with 90 digs.



Washington & Jefferson Presidents (13-12, 8-3 PAC)

The Washington & Jefferson College volleyball team picked up two conference victories last week, defeating Chatham 3-0 (25-12, 25-18, 25-11) and Grove City 3-0 (25-21, 25-16, 25-13) ... With the victories, the Presidents are fourth in the conference standings, trailing Thomas More (12-1 PAC), Thiel (9-2 PAC) and Westminster (10-3) ... W&J controls its own destiny for the number two seed in the conference tournament if it can win its final three matches ... Junior OH **Courtney Holdrieth** had 13 kills, 12 digs and three aces last week.



Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (5-18, 2-11 PAC)

It was a light week for the Jackets as they hosted Bethany in their lone match ... The Bison took the contest by the final of 3-1, but sophomore **Jordan Barton** had a solid evening of work by putting down a team-high 12 kills ... Junior **Rachell Storm** added 24 digs, while freshman **Carly Smithyman** set up 27 assists.



Westminster Titans (12-19, 10-3 PAC)

Westminster went 3-1 in four matches last week including PAC wins at Grove City, 3-0, on Tuesday and at home with Thiel, 3-1, on Thursday ... The Titans then traveled to Capital for a tri-match on Saturday, losing to Otterbein 3-1, and beating Capital, 3-2, for their first five-set match of the season ... Senior OH **Sam Botzum** led the Titans with 4.09 kills per set during the week, including 17 in the four-set win over Thiel, the second-place team in the PAC ... She also had 14 kills vs. Grove City and Otterbein ... Other notables included sophomore MB **Lindsay Speidel** with 3.00 kills per set and 16 total blocks during the week, and sophomore OH **Tara Ott** with 2.94 kills per set and 4.25 digs per set.
