Friday, the scene shifts to Metheny Fieldhouse in Beaver Falls, Pa., for the semifinals, as #1 Geneva hosts the THI/WES winner at 6 p.m., followed by #2 Bethany facing the TMC/SVC victor at 8 p.m. ... The title match is Saturday at 4 p.m. at Geneva.

NEWS & NOTES: Junior MH **Kelly Barzak** led Thiel to a perfect 3-0 week vs. PAC foes with 41 kills, four aces and 13.5 total blocks ... Freshman OH **Karsen Cronin** led Thomas More to a 2-0 week vs. PAC foes with a team-high 43 kills ... Geneva went 3-1 and finished second at the NCCAA East Regional, falling to NAIA member Malone 3-2 in the title match ... Senior OH **Tara Ott** averaged 2.6 kills and 2.4 digs per set for 2-1 Westminster ... Saint Vincent went 3-1 last week behind 165 assists (11.0 aps) from **Devin McGrath**.

The Saints put a damper on the festivities by winning 3-2, which was the Bison's first home loss this year in 10 home matches ...
