Also nominated was sophomore OH Megan Kay of Thiel, sophomore OH Brandi Corbello of Thomas More, senior OH Monika Linden of Wash. & Jeff., junior L Rachell Storm of Waynesburg and senior OH Sam Botzum of Westminster.



PAC VOLLEYBALL 2009 - Week 10 Conference Notes

IT'S TOURNEY TIME!: The 2009 PAC Volleyball Championship Tournament gets underway this week, with first round matches at Westminster and W&J Tuesday followed by the semifinals and finals at Thomas More over the weekend ... The #3 seed and defending PAC champion Titans host #6 Grove City in one opening round match, while the #4 Presidents host #5 Bethany in the other on Tuesday ... The PAC Tournament champion receives an automatic bid to the NCAA Division III Playoffs.

NEWS & NOTES: Geneva, which needs one win to clinch its second straight 20-win season, faces Malone and Mount Vernon Nazarene Tuesday in the NCCAA Regional Tournament ... The tourney winner gets an automatic bid to the NCCAA national tournament in Florida later this month ... Saint Vincent is awaiting word of a possible ECAC D-II playoff bid ... With 935 assists this season, Bethany freshman S Jessica Zavatchen needs 30 more to break the school single-season record, set by Acacia Iwaniec (964) in 2001.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: Thiel's 22 wins is the program's best since going 24-12 in 1986 ... Senior OH Monika Linden had 52 kills and 18 blocks for W&J last week ... Thomas More went 1-1 over the weekend at the Centre Invitational, as Brandi Corbello posted 21 kills and seven aces ... Sam Botzum had a career-high 24 kills for Westminster at W&J ... Anna McCurdy led Grove City with eight kills in a three-set sweep of La Roche ... Waynesburg and Chatham concluded their 2009 seasons.

Bethany Bison (16-14, 5-9 PAC)



The Bison built momentum for the PAC Tournament by taking both ends of a tri-match Saturday, which came after a hard-fought four-set loss to W&J Tuesday ... In the W&J match, **Jessica Zavatchen** had 32 assists, **Lauren Goodwill** pounded down 11 kills and **Sarah Slagle** totaled 13 digs and 4 aces ... Bethany played all 17 players who were dressed and coasted to a 3-0 win over La Roche Saturday ... **Alyssa Schrecengost** had 10 kills and **Zavatchen** finished with 34 assists and 11 digs ... The Bison closed the regular season with a 3-0 win over Grove City, their first since Aug., 2003 ... **Zavatchen** had 27 assists and 11 digs to lead the way, while **Schrecengost** collected seven kills, three aces and 10 digs.

Chatham Cougars (1-25, 0-14 PAC)



Chatham completed their 2009 season this week, losing on the road to both NCAA Division II Pitt-Johnstown in a non-conference match and Waynesburg University in PAC play ... The Cougars finished the season with an overall record of 1-25 and went 0-14 in the PAC.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes (19-10)



Geneva ended its home season on a positive note as the Golden Tornadoes defeated Westminster and Waynesburg in the final home matches of the season ... Geneva also defeated Saint Vincent on Saturday to get some revenge from an earlier season loss against the Bearcats ... The Golden Tornadoes are sitting at 19-10 and just one victory shy of their second consecutive 20-win season ... All that is left on the schedule is an NCCAA showdown against Malone and Mt. Vernon Nazarene on Tuesday ... The winner of that tri-match will receive an automatic bid to the NCCAA national tournament in Florida later in November.

Grove City Wolverines (8-23, 4-10 PAC)



Grove City is the No. 6 seed in this week's PAC Championship Tournament ... The Wolverines face third-seeded Westminster in a quarterfinal Tuesday night ... It is the third time in the last four years that Grove City will play a conference tournament match at Westminster but the first time that the Wolverines will play a true road match at Memorial Field House ... Grove City played W&J in 2006, then met Thomas More two years ago in the semifinal round ... Last week, Grove City went 1-3, earning a 3-0 win over La Roche in a non-conference battle at Bethany ... **Anna McCurdy's** eight kills led Grove City in that win ... Head coach **Susan Roberts** now has 697 total wins as a head coach at Grove City.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (22-10)



The Bearcats went 2-1 on the final week of the regular season, defeating Waynesburg and Grove City, both in three sets, before falling 3-2 in the regular season finale to Geneva on Saturday ... Against the Yellow Jackets on Tuesday, the Bearcats surrendered a season low 30 points over the three sets, with **Taylor Guido** pacing the SVC offense with 13 kills ... **Natalie Hozak** had 16 digs and four aces, while **Dawn Timko** tallied three solo blocks ... In SVC's win at Grove City, **Diana Petrovich** had nine kills and **Timko** eight, while **Hozak** recorded four aces ... SVC wrapped up the regular season with a five-set loss to longtime rival Geneva Saturday.

Thiel Tomcats (22-10, 11-3 PAC)



Thiel finished its regular season on a high note, winning its last two contests and clinching the second seed in the upcoming PAC tournament ... With a, 3-0, win over W&J Thursday, Thiel put the finishing touches on a 22-10 (11-3 PAC) campaign, which is the program's best since going 24-12 in 1986 ... The Tomcats' 11 conference wins is a team record ... Thiel also wrapped up its home season with a 9-1 mark and notched their 15th 3-0 win of the year ... Earlier in the week, Thiel notched a quick 3-0 PAC win over in-county rival Grove City ... Sophomore **Megan Kay** tore it up for the 'Cats last week, playing in all six sets ... She earned two double-doubles, while totaling of 26 kills and 26 digs on the week.

Thomas More Saints (26-10, 13-1 PAC)



The Saints went 1-1 last week at the Centre College Halloween Bash in Danville, Kentucky as they defeated Centre, 3-0, but fell, 3-2, to Maryville (Tenn.) College ... Sophomore OH **Brandi Corbello** led the team in kills (21) and services aces (seven) and also added 17 digs and two blocks ... Sophomore S **Emily Bohman** led the team in assists with 72, while freshman DS **Danielle Beckenhaupt** led the team in digs with 24 and sophomore OHs **Colleen Meyers** and **Aimee Ryan** led the team in blocks with five each.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents (15-15, 10-4 PAC)



Prior to dropping its final two games of the regular-season against Carnegie Mellon and Elizabethtown, the Washington & Jefferson volleyball team picked up a 3-2 come-from-behind victory against Westminster ... The Presidents dropped the first two sets, but were able to regroup and rattle off three straight wins to collect the 3-2 victory ... Junior **Courtney Sherwin** had 11 kills and nine blocks, while senior **Monika Linden** contributed 15 kills ... W&J has earned the No. 4 seed in the PAC Tournament and will host Bethany in a quarterfinal contest on Tuesday evening at 7 p.m. ... W&J swept the Bison this season by scores of 3-2 at home and 3-1 at BC.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (6-20, 3-11 PAC)



Though the week started slowly, the Waynesburg volleyball team ended it, and the 2009 season, on a high note by sweeping Chatham 3-0 during Senior Day at the Rudy Marisa Fieldhouse ... In the win over the Cougars, two different Yellow Jackets recorded double-doubles ... Sophomore OH **Jordan Barton** recorded team highs in kills (14) and digs (22) ... Freshman S **Carly Smithyman** had perhaps her best performance of the season with a Waynesburg-best 30 assists, while also chipping in 12 digs ... Junior LIB **Rachell Storm** tied Barton with 22 digs ... During her final match with the Jackets, senior **Amber Wallack** recorded a personal-best eight kills and boasted a .467 attack percentage.

Westminster Titans (12-22, 10-4 PAC)



Westminster lost three matches last week to finish the regular season with a 12-22 record and a 10-4 mark in the PAC, which means the Titans have drawn the No. 3 seed in this week's PAC Tournament. The Titans lost at Geneva, 3-0, on Tuesday before dropping two matches at Washington & Jefferson on Saturday, a PAC match to W&J, 3-2, and a non-conference match to Elizabethtown, 3-1 ... Senior OH **Sam Botzum** became just the eighth player in team history to register 1,000 career kills as she posted a career-high 24 kills vs. W&J and added eight more against E-town to give her 1,016, which ranks seventh all-time ... Sophomore **Tara Ott** led the Titans with eight kills vs. Geneva.
