



The Bison built momentum for the PAC Tournament by taking both ends of a tri-match Saturday, which came after a hard-fought four-set loss to W&J Tues-




Chatham Cougars (1-25, 0-14 PAC)


Grove City Wolverines (8-23, 4-10 PAC)

Washington & Jefferson Presidents (15-15, 10-4 PAC)


