The defending PAC champion Titans will play the Thiel/Waynesburg winner in the first semifinal Friday at 6 p.m., followed by #2 seed Thomas More facing the Grove City/ W&J victor at 8 p.m. ... The Saturday finals time will be announced on Wednesday.

WHO'S HOT: Freshman S Michelle Clifford of Thomas More recorded 102 assists in three matches for the 3-0 Saints last week ... Saint Vincent improved its win streak to 10 matches with a 3-0 week and will now look to defend its ECAC D-II title ... Diana Petrovich had 24 kills and three blocks for SVC in a four-set win over Geneva ... Freshman MB Lindsay Speidel averaged 3.0 kills per set for 2-1 Westminster last week ... Waynesburg senior S Amanda Staudt had 34 assists and 14 digs in a win at Chatham.

NEWS & NOTES: Adriane Blake and Brandi Snavely of Geneva were each named to the NCCAA All-East Region Volleyball First Team last week ... W&J junior MH Samantha Butler was named to the All-Tournament team at Elizabethtown ... Alyssa Schrecengost recorded 14 kills and 11 digs in a 3-2 Bethany loss against W&J ... Thiel sophomore LIB Danielle Dwyer had 77 digs in four matches for the 1-3 Tomcats last week ... Grove City sophomore MH Inge Rasmussen had 32 kills last week.

Bethany Bison (5-24, 2-12 PAC)

had 56 digs last week to lead the Saints' defense ... Freshman S Michelle Clifford had 102 assists, six service aces, 11 kills, 19 digs and one block solo ... Sophomore OH Libby Mulrey had a team-high 27 kills as she hit .297 ... Through the Saints' 33 matches, freshman MB Katie Sullivan leads the team in hitting with a .320 percentage with 225 kills and has a team-high 61 blocks ... Sophomore OH Lindsay Svec leads the team in kills with 270, while Bohman leads the team with 545 digs and Clifford has 1,220 assists.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (10-19, 6-8 PAC)
