TOURNAMENT RESULTS

Quarterfinal #1 - November 4, 2008 - 7 p.m. Rissell-Beeghly Gymnasia - Greenville, Pa. #5 Waynesburg 3, #4 Thiel 1 (25-13, 25-22, 18-25, 25-20)

The first upset of the PAC Tournament belonged to the Waynesburg Yellow Jackets, who advanced to the PAC semifinals via a four-set road victory at Thiel. Leading the Yellow Jacket attack was senior OH Laurie Lindner (Cranberry Township, PA/Seneca Valley H.S.), who recorded a matchhigh 20 kills in the victory. Senior S Amanda Staudt (Cochranton, PA/Cochranton H.S.) set up 46 assists in the victory, while sophomore LIB Rachell Storm (New Waterford, OH/Crestview H.S.) contributed 23 digs for Waynesburg. Thiel was paced offensively by junior OH Abbey Kiger (Mineral Ridge, OH/Mineral Ridge H.S.) with 14 kills, while sophomore S Madison Chylik (Valley View, OH/Cuyahoga Heights H.S.) posted 32 assists and sophomore DS Danielle Dwyer (Dalton, OH/Dalton H.S.) recorded 16 digs in defeat.

Quarterfinal #2 - November 4, 2008 - 7 p.m. Henry Memorial Center - Washington, Pa. #3 Washington & Jefferson 3, #6 Grove City 1 (25-14, 23-25, 25-13, 25-19)

The Presidents advanced to the PAC semifinal round by virtue of a four-set win over the visiting Wolverines. For W&J, sophomore MH Courtney Sherwin (Greensburg, PA/Latrobe H.S.) recorded a "double double" with 10 kills and 10 blocks. Junior MH Samantha Butler (Greensburg, PA/Greensburg Salem H.S.) added a team-best 12 kills along with four blocks for the Presidents, while sophomore S Mia Serene (Mohnton, PA/Holy Name H.S.) recorded 38 assists and 11 digs. The Wolverines were led offensively by freshman OH Anna McCurdy (Guys Mills, PA/Maplewood H.S.) with 13 kills.

#1 Westminster 3, #5 Waynesburg 1

The Yellow Jackets captured the opening set and appeared poised for a possible upset, but the top-seeded and defending PAC champion Titans regained control with three consecutive set wins to advance to the PAC Championship match. Westminster was paced by junior OH Beth Copp (Cranberry Township, PA/Seneca Valley H.S.) with a team-high 12 kills.

Senior LIB Hannah Parker (Guys Mills, PA/Maplewood H.S.) recorded a match-high 25 digs for the Titans, while junior MH Devin Kelley (Mercer, PA/Mercer H.S.) posted three solo blocks in the win. For Waynesburg, senior MH Amanda Jo Morgan (Perryopolis, PA/Frazier H.S.) led all hitters with 16 kills, while senior OH Laurie Lindner (Cranberry Township, PA/Seneca Valley H.S.) added 11 kills and a team-best 19 digs in the loss.

Semifinal #2 - November 7, 2008 - 8:10 p.m. Buzz Ridl Gymnasium - New Wilmington, Pa. #2 Thomas More 3, #3 Washington & Jefferson 1 (25-18, 18-25, 26-24, 25-14)

After splitting the first two sets with the third-seeded Presidents, the second-seeded Saints outlasted W&J in a tight third set beforeclinching the match and a berth in the PAC title match with a decisive fourth set. Freshman OH/MB Hillary Monnin (Russia, OH/Russia H.S.) and freshman MB Katie Sullivan (Cincinnati, OH/Seton H.S.) paced Thomas More offensively with 13 and 12 kills, respectively. Freshman S Michelle Clifford (Cincinnati, OH/McAuley H.S.) set up 37 assists, while freshman OH Emily Bohman (Yorkshire, OH/Versailles H.S.) recorded 19 digs. For W&J, juniors Monika Linden (Manassas, VA/Osbourn Park H.S.) and Samantha Butler (Greensburg, PA/Greensburg Salem H.S.) each recorded 10 kills in defeat.

The Titans captured their second consecutive PAC volleyball title after rallying from a first set loss to win three straight over the Saints. Westminster posted a balanced scoring attack as six player posted seven or more kills, led by junior OH Beth Copp (Cranberry Township, PA/Seneca Valley H.S.) with nine. Senior S Traci Hassell (Hubbard, OH/Hubbard H.S.) posted 23 assists and four blocks for Westminster, while senior LIB Hannah Parker (Guys Mills, PA/Maplewood H.S.) recorded a match-high 33 digs. For Thomas More, junior OH Kristine Rust (Independence, KY/Simon Kenton H.S.) recorded a match-high 10 kills in the loss, while freshman Emily Bohman (Yorkshire, OH/Versailles H.S.) contributed 12 assists and 28 digs.
