## TOURNAMENT RESULTS Semifinal #1 - November 4, 2005 #1 Waynesburg d. #4 Westminster (30-24, 30-20, 30-23)

The two-time defending PAC champion Yellow Jackets opened defense with a three-game home sweep of Westminster. For Waynesburg, senior MH Brittany Morrow (Beaver, PA/Beaver H.S.) led the way with 14 kjills, while junior OH Kaci Hlad (Byesville, OH/ Meadowbrook H.S.) added nine and junior OH Kimberly Wilson (McMurray, PA/Peters Township H.S.) and freshman OH Laurie Lindner (Cranberry Township, PA/Seneca Valley H.S.) each had eight. Senior LIB Lauren Freeman (Economy Borough, PA/ Ambridge H.S.) posted 21 digs in the win, while Morrow added 20. Freshman S Amanda Staudt (Cochranton/Cochranton H.S.) set up 38 assists in the win. Westminster was paced by junior MH Katie McDermott (Austintown, OH/Austintown Fitch H.S.) with nine kills, while junior S Rachael Cooper (New Castle/Laurel H.S.) set up 28 assists.

## Semifinal #2 - November 4, 2005 #2 Washington & Jefferson d. #3 Thomas More (30-25, 30-24, 30-23)

The Presidents advanced to face Waynesburg for the PAC title with a three-game sweep of first-year PAC member Thomas More. W&J was paced by senior MH Rebecca Fletcher (Indiana, PA/Penns Manor Area H.S.) with 13 kills, while junior **Stacie Ley (Pleasant Hills,** 

PA/Thomas Jefferson H.S.) added 10 and senior OH Lakia Gordon (Pittsburgh, PA/Farrell H.S.) recorded nine. Junior Jamie Gullen (Steubenville, OH/ Steubenville H.S.) set up 41 assists in the victory, while senior LIB Anne Reynolds (South Park, PA/South Park H.S.) tallied 20 digs. For the Saints, senior MH mary Lape (Coovington, KY) posted team-high totals of 12 kills and five blocks, while sophomore Valeri Kuhn (Cincinnati, OH) posted 39 assists and senior LIB Laura Wiegele (Cincinnati, OH) added 17 digs in the defeat.

## PAC Championship - November 5, 2005 #2 Washington & Jefferson d. #1 Waynesburg (30-20, 30-28, 18-30, 30-21)

The Presidents captured their sixth PAC volleyball championship (and first since posting a four-year run of conference titles from 1996-99) while also snapping Waynesburg's two-year run as PAC champion. Senior OH Lakia Gordon (Pittsburgh, PA/Farrell H.S.) led the Presidents with 14 kills, followed by junior Stacie Ley (Pleasant Hills, PA/Thomas Jefferson H.S.) with 10 and senior MH Rebecca Fletcher (Indiana, PA/ Penns Manor Area H.S.) with eight kills and a teambest nine blocks. Junior Jamie Gullen (Steubenville, OH/Steubenville H.S.) set up 39 assists for W&J, while senior LIB Anne Reynolds (South Park/South Park H.S.) added a team-high 23 digs. The Yellow Jackets were paced by freshman OH Laurie Lindner (Cranberry Township, PA/Seneca Valley H.S.) with a matchhigh 15 kills, followed by senior OH Kimberly Wilson (McMurray, PA/Peters Township H.S.) with 14. Freshman Amanda Staudt (Cochranton, PA/Cochranton H.S.) recorded 47 assists in the loss, while senior LIB Lauren Freeman (Economy Borough, PA/Ambridge H.S.) contributed a match-high 24 digs.
