Also nominated was sophomore F **Devin McGrath** of Saint Vincent, junior F **Ashley Kirkpatrick** of Wash. & Jeff., senior F **Elisha Jones** of Waynesburg, and freshman G **Courtney Zitt** of Westminster.



### PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL 2010-11 - Week 6 Conference Notes

**SVC NAMES INTERIM COACH:** For the first time in the 27-year history of women's basketball at Saint Vincent, the Bearcats will take to the floor without longtime head coach **Kristen Zawacki**, who tragically passed away on Dec. 25<sup>th</sup> ... Zawacki amassed a 512-276 career record and led the Bearcats to a 9-1 record this season ... The reins of the team have been handed to fifth-year assistant coach **Jimmy Petruska**, who was named interim coach.

**NEWS AND NOTES:** Thomas More's **Nicole Dickman** had a double-double in two games as she had 28 pts. and 11 rebounds against Ithaca and then had 12 pts. and 11 rebounds against Centre ... **Elisha Jones** led Waynesburg with a team-high 15 points in the win against La Roche ... **Emily Fenton** led Saint Vincent over Randolph Macon with 18 points. ... **Ashley Kirkpatrick** sparked W&J off the bench in the second half vs. Hiram with back-to-back baskets and finished with eight points, eight rebounds and four blocks.

**AROUND THE LEAGUE:** **Katie Hughes** led tWestminster with 9.0 ppg, including a season-high 13 against Salve Regina ... Chatham's **Kayla Hilko** and **Colleen Kiss** both finished with 12 points in a non-league win at Cal Tech ... Bethany's **Audra Droginske** is the team's leading scorer with 10.6 ppg ... Grove City is the only conference team to have two players in the top five in scoring in league leader **Christine Slater** (18.1) and **Leah Gibson** (14.8) ... Thiel fell to NAIA member Notre Dame (Ohio).

# PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

## Bethany Bison (6-4, 1-1 PAC)



The Bison closed out the first semester with a three-game winning streak to push their record to 6-4, their best start since the 2003-04 season, which was the last time Bethany claimed the PAC title ... BC has made a habit of winning the close games, as their last five victories have been by an average of 5.4 points ... Junior **Audra Droginske** is the team's leading scorer with 10.6 points per game and has made 10 consecutive three-pointers dating back to the first half of the Dec. 7 win at Ohio-Eastern ... Sophomore **Kayla Taormina** is the only other Bison averaging double digits with 10.0 points per game and is coming off her first career double-double in the Dec. 15 win over Mount St. Joseph.

## Chatham Cougars (5-6, 1-3 PAC)



The Chatham University women's basketball team traveled across the country this weekend to take on California Institute of Technology in Pasadena, CA in their first contest of the New Year ... The Cougars defeated their non-conference opponent by a final score of 57-42 and had two women finish in double figures ... The first was senior **Kayla Hilko** who finished with 12 points ... The second Cougar to finish in double figures was sophomore **Colleen Kiss** who also scored 12 points in her debut performance at Chatham.

## Geneva Golden Tornadoes (6-4)



Geneva managed to slip past Carlow University 42-36 in Pittsburgh last Thursday night ... It was the lowest winning point total for a Geneva women's team since the school's first ever intercollegiate victory in 1972 ... The Golden Tornadoes moved to 6-4 on the season marking their best start to a season in three years ... **Leah Prisuta** led the way with ten points and a career best nine pts. while **Valerie Hamilton** chipped in with nine pts. ... Geneva held Carlow to just 13 first half pts. and was able to hold off a charging Celtics team in the second half to secure the victory ... The Golden Tornadoes are now set to get back into PAC action with a busy three game week.

## Grove City Wolverines (4-5, 1-2 PAC)



Grove City returns to action this week after having been off for final examinations and Christmas ... The Wolverines visit Bethany Thursday before hosting Thiel Saturday in conference action ... Grove City is the only conference team to have two players in the top five in scoring in league leader **Christine Slater** (18.1) and **Leah Gibson** (14.8) ... Slater is also fourth in rebounding (8.3) and leads the league in minutes played (36.9) ... Grove City is the only team in the league to have not played 10 games this year ... The Wolverines will make up for that with six games in 11 days from January 6 to January 17.

## Saint Vincent Bearcats (9-1, 3-0 PAC)



The Bearcats were victorious in their only action over the holiday break, wrapping up a perfect 2-0 trip to Florida with a 74-52 win over Randolph Macon on Dec. 20<sup>th</sup> in the Daytona Beach Shootout ... Saint Vincent led for the entire 40 minutes, thanks to a balanced scoring attack and a solid defensive performance ... **Emily Fenton** led SVC with 18 points, including a 5-for-9 mark from behind the three-point line, while **Devin McGrath** posted 16 points, **Brittany Sedlock** 12, and **Ariel Rocco** 10 ... McGrath added 12 rebounds for her second double-double of the year, while also contributing team-highs of six steals and four blocks ... SVC forced 30 turnovers, and held RM to just 30 percent (19-for-62) from the floor.

## Thiel Tomcats (1-9, 0-2 PAC)



The Tomcats continued their struggle as they dropped their fourth consecutive contest ... The Tomcats were defeated 72-48 by Notre Dame College on Monday the 27<sup>th</sup> ... Thiel once again struggled in the second half as they shot just 30% from the field and only did not make a three-point basket ... The team kept it close in the first half but were outscored 42-21 in the second half on route to their fourth straight defeat.

## Thomas More Saints (10-0, 3-0 PAC)



The Saints moved up to No. 5 in last week's D3hoops.com Top-25 ... Thomas More defeated Ithaca, 74-73 in overtime, and Centre, 66-60 ... Senior center **Nicole Dickman** had a double-double both games as she had 28 points and 11 rebounds against Ithaca and then had 12 points and 11 rebounds against Centre ... Two other Saints averaged in double-figure scoring the last two weeks as sophomore guard **Chelsea Tolliver** averaged 12.0 points per game and sophomore guard **Allison Long** averaged 11.0 ppg ... For the season, the Saints are led in scoring by Tolliver with 15.1 ppg, and Dickman with 14.0 ppg., and is led on the boards with Dickman with 8.6 rpg.

## Washington & Jefferson Presidents (4-6, 2-0 PAC)



Hiram held Washington & Jefferson to its lowest point total at the Henry Memorial Center since Dec. 1, 1981 during its 50-38 victory at the Henry Memorial Center on Dec. 30 ... The Presidents were held to 30 points versus NCAA Division II Pitt-Johnstown in the 1981-82 season opener, which marked W&J's sixth year of varsity collegiate basketball ... Junior forward **Ashley Kirkpatrick** sparked the Presidents off the bench in the second half with back-to-back baskets and finished with eight points, eight rebounds and four blocks ... Junior forward **Kayla Strimel** grabbed 10 rebounds.

## Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (8-2, 2-1 PAC)



The Waynesburg University women's basketball team wrapped up the 2010 portion of their schedule with a 59-51 road win at La Roche ... Four different Yellow Jackets put up at least 10 points each in the win over the Redhawks ... Senior forward **Elisha Jones** led the group with a team-high 15 points ... Sophomore guard **Brittany Spencer** added 13, freshman guard **Jessi Drayer** picked up 11 and junior point guard **Hannah Hunter** contributed 10 points to go along with nine rebounds in the winning effort.

## Westminster Titans (3-8, 0-4 PAC)



Westminster posted a 1-1 record at the Bahamas Sunshine Shootout ... The Titans lost to Salve Regina, 63-59, in double overtime before edging Oswego State, 51-50 ... F **Katie Hughes** led the Titans with 9.0 ppg including a season-high 13 pts., one shy of a career high, in the loss to Salve Regina ... She also pulled down 13 rebounds for her third career double-double ...
