**WELCOME 2012:** The PAC women's basketball league schedule returns this week after a two-week break for holiday tournament and non-conference action ... Three teams remain unbeaten at 4-0 in PAC play entering 2012: five-time defending PAC champion Thomas More, 2011 NCAA D-III playoff qualifier Saint Vincent, and 2011 ECAC D-III South champion Waynesburg ... The Bearcats and Yellow Jackets face off in a key PAC matchup Wednesday in Latrobe.

**NEWS AND NOTES:** Thomas More is ranked 17th by the WBCA and 25th by [D3Hoops.com](http://D3Hoops.com) in their most recent national Top 25 polls ... Senior F **Renee Shepherd** earned All-Tournament honors in the Bahamas after averaging 12.0 ppg for 2-0 Bethany ... Junior F **Paige Pearce** averaged 12.5 ppg and 8.0 rpg for 2-0 Waynesburg ... W&J went 3-0 over break, led by senior PG **Vanessa Rivera** (7.0 ppg, 8.0 apg) ... Senior F **Brittany Sedlock** averaged 18.0 ppg and 8.7 rpg for 2-1 Saint Vincent.

**AROUND THE LEAGUE:** Sophomore G **Katie Kitchen** averaged 11.3 ppg and 9.7 rpg for 1-2 Thomas More ... Junior G **Kelly Muffley** averaged 14.5 ppg for 0-2 Thiel at the Catholic Tournament in Washington, D.C. ... **Beth DeLuca** led Geneva with 20 points against Plattsburgh ... **Lizz King** bucketed 18 points for Chatham in a non-league loss to Pitt-Greensburg ... **Leah Gibson** scored 14 for Grove City in a loss at Houghton ... **Andi Ridge** led Westminster with 10 points in a loss at Muskingum.

# PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

## Bethany Bison (7-4, 3-1 PAC)



Bethany won both games at the Bahamas Shootout and at 7-4, are off to their best start since 2003-04, the last time they won the PAC title ... The Bison pulled out a 63-61 win over Milwaukee School of Engineering, as they held on at the end as MSOE missed three chances to tie or win in the final 19 seconds ... **Renee Shepherd**, **Katelynn Hackathorn** and **Taylor Verrico** all scored 12 in the win ... The Bison held Immaculata to 19 first half points and cruised in the second half to claim a 76-54 triumph on the second day, as Bethany improved to 4-0 all-time in the Bahamas ... **Anne Wilson** tallied a team-best 15 points and dished out 4 assists, while **Kayla Taormina** notched 13 points.

## Chatham Cougars (2-8, 0-4 PAC)



The Cougars fell to Pitt-Greensburg 60-53 in non-conference play on Wednesday ... **Lizz King** was the leading scorer for Chatham with 18 points ... She was 4-for-5 on three-point field goal attempts ... **Marguerite Sargent** recorded 13 points and nine rebounds ... The Cougars tied the game eight times, but were unable to pull out the win ... Chatham was able to stay within 11 points of the Panthers for the duration of the competition.

## Geneva Golden Tornadoes (1-10, 0-4 PAC)



Geneva dropped its 10th straight game Monday night as head coach **Lori Wynn** returned to her old stomping grounds at Malone University ... The women's team also hit the road over the break with a pair of losses at the Big Easy Challenge in New Orleans ... **Beth DeLuca** led the team in scoring in both games, including a 20-point effort in a loss to SUNY-Plattsburgh ... The 10-game losing streak marks the first time in school history that a Geneva women's team has dropped ten straight in a single season ... The school record of 13 straight losses was set at the end of the 1988 year and the beginning of the 1989 campaign.

## Grove City Wolverines (2-9, 1-3 PAC)



The Grove City women's basketball team dropped a pair of hard-fought decisions on the road at NAIA programs last week ... Friday, Grove City fell to Roberts Wesleyan, 60-48 ... The Wolverines trailed 49-46 with one minute left before falling ... **Hannah Jo Coneby** paced GCC with 14 points and **Sadie Malone** pumped in 11, including three three-point goals ... **Leah Gibson** fired in 14 points Saturday in a 64-57 setback at Houghton ... Grove City nearly erased a 13-point deficit over the final three minutes ... The Wolverines return to PAC action this week with games at Westminster and Chatham ... The games are part of a stretch in which Grove City is playing eight of 10 games on the road.

## Saint Vincent Bearcats (9-2, 4-0 PAC)



SVC continued its excellent start to the season with a pair of wins over the holiday break to improve to 9-2 on the season ... First, the Bearcats throttled Capital, 84-66, on the road in a game that saw SVC shoot 57.1 percent (32-of-56) from the field and 52.9 percent (9-of-17) from three-point range ... Four players scored in double figures and six players recorded at least one trifecta ... Against Ramapo, SVC was unable to recover from an 18-point halftime deficit and fell, 79-64, on the first day of the Juniata Holiday Classic ... SVC rebounded the next day posting a 73-55 win over Misericordia ... The Bearcats out-scored the Cougars, 56-23, over the final 28 minutes of the game to pull away.

## Thiel Tomcats (2-9, 2-2 PAC)



Against Catholic, junior G **Kelly Muffley** was the lone Tomcat player in double figures as she finished with 10 points, five rebounds and four steals ... Junior F **Kelly Barzak** added five points and a game-best 10 points ... Against St. John Fisher, Muffley again led the Tomcats with 19 points and six rebounds ... Barzak finished the game with 17 points and seven rebounds ... Junior G **Julia Monteleone** went 5-of-8 from the floor, including 4-of-7 from three-point range, to finish with 14 points and five assists in just her second start of the season ... Senior G **Ashley Davis** chipped in with 11 points and four rebounds.

## Thomas More Saints (8-3, 4-0 PAC)



Thomas More, which is ranked No. 17 in the WBCA Top-25 and No. 25 in the D3hoops.com Top-25 went 1-2 during the Holiday break ... The Saints had two players average in double-figure scoring as junior G **Allison Long** averaged 12.3 points per game and sophomore G **Katie Kitchen** averaged 11.3 ppg ... Kitchen led the team on the boards with 9.7 rebounds per game and recorded her first career double-double in the Saints win over Bluffton as she scored 18 points and pulled down 10 rebounds ... Long also led the team in assists with eight and steals with 13 ... For the season, Kitchen leads the team in scoring with 15.4 ppg., and sophomore F **Moriah Corey** is tops in rebounding with 7.4 rpg.

## Washington & Jefferson Presidents (6-5, 1-3 PAC)



W&J enters the heart of PAC play riding a season-long, three-game winning streak ... The Presidents swept two games in the Bahamas Sunshine Shootout, defeating Immaculata 73-51 and Goucher 65-34 ... Senior **Ashley Kirkpatrick** was named Tournament MVP after posting 32 points and 16 rebounds during the two games ... Senior PG **Vanessa Rivera** dished out 14 assists and was also named to the All-Tournament Team ... Rivera posted her second career double-double with 12 points and 10 assists during the Presidents' New Year's Eve victory over La Roche ... Kirkpatrick chipped in 10 points and nine boards, while senior **Courtney Walsh** added a game-high 14 points.

## Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (9-2, 4-0 PAC)



Waynesburg ended 2011 with a pair of victories that ran its current winning streak to seven games ... The Yellow Jackets downed Hiram in a physical battle by the final score of 58-54 back on Dec. 19 and wrapped up the calendar year with an 81-48 triumph over the College of Wooster this past Saturday ... As she has done all year, senior PG **Hannah Hunter** put up prodigious numbers for the Jackets ... Over the two victories, Hunter averaged 17.5 points, 5.5 rebounds, five assists and three steals per win ... Sophomore F **Elaine Hasek** pulled down a team-best 8.5 rebounds per game ... Junior Gs **Jessi Drayer** and **Brittany Spencer** averaged 12.5 and 10.5 points per game, respectively.
