Grove City junior F **Christine Slater** was named to the All-Tournament team at Wittenberg after posting 16 points and 15 boards in an OT loss to Wilmington ... **Renee Rawding** scored 13 points to lead Geneva in a 75-48 non-league win over Carlow ...
