PAC play will continue each Wednesday and Saturday for the remainder of the 2008-09 regular season, which will conclude on Saturday, February 21.

WHO'S HOT: Chatham rode its defense to a 4-0 record over the break, as the Cougars held three of their opponents under 50 points ... Nicole Dickman averaged 15.8 points and 6.5 rebounds per game for 3-1 Thomas More, with the only loss coming to #9 Oglethorpe ... Janelle Reed of Saint Vincent made the All-Tournament team at the Saint Xavier Invitational after averaging 21 points and four steals per game ... Freshman F Towanda-Michelle Warren scored 20 points for Thiel in an 82-76 PAC road win at Bethany.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: Val Hamilton scored 15 points for Geneva in an 86-62 victory against NAIA member Carlow ... Christine Slater scored 18 points for Grove City in a 53-48 road loss at Carnegie Mellon ... Bethany senior G Kaitlyn McCormick averaged 15.0 points, 6.0 rebounds and 4.5 steals for the 1-1 Bison ... Callie White averaged 13.5 points and 6.8 rebounds for 2-2 Waynesburg during the holidays ... Amy Dolsak averaged 10.0 points and 6.3 rebounds for 1-2 Westminster over the break.


#### Bethany Bison (4-7, 0-3 PAC)

Bethany ran their win streak to three with a 62-49 victory over Marietta before break, but the string was broken with an 82-76 loss to Thiel Saturday .

The Bison forced 22 turnovers and grabbed 26 offensive rebounds in the Marietta victory to offset 31 percent shooting ... Anne Wilson and Stacy Goode had 10 points each off the bench ... The Thiel contest saw 57 fouls, 76 free throw attempts and six players fouled out ... Kaitlyn McCormick set one career-high with 22 points, matched another with eight steals, but BC's cold-shooting did them in again, as they hit just 29 percent (24-of-82) and missed all 14 three-point attempts ... Wilson went 10-for-10 from the foul line to finish with 16 points.

#### Geneva Golden Tornadoes (4-5)

Geneva put an end to its three-game losing streak with an impressive 86-62 victory over Carlow University last week ... The Golden Tornadoes shot GOLDEN TORNADOES 53% for the game, including 7-of-13 from three-

SVC then took part in the St. Xavier Holiday Tournament in Chicago, falling 75-67 in the tourney opener to host St. Xavier, ranked seventh in the NAIA, and then dropping a 74-73 overtime setback to NAIA foe Siena Heights in a game that saw 15 ties and 16 lead changes ... SVC returned back to winning form in a big way on Saturday, defeating Geneva 75-52 as seven players scored at least nine points for the Lady Bearcats.


#### **Thomas More Saints** (10-1, 4-0 PAC)

Thomas More (9-1, 4-0 PAC) moved up to No. 4 in both the WBCA and d3hoops.com polls over the holiday break ... The Saints are 10-0 when hold-

Thomas More is shooting 50 percent from the field on 298-of-596 shooting and have outrebounded their opponents 421-317 ... straight overall for the Cougars, who also earned wins against Saint Vincent, Cal Tech and Claremont Mudd-Scripps during the winter break ... Chatham has been outstanding on defense during the win streak, holding three opponents under 50 points ... Chatham has gotten contributions from throughout the lineup with Brittany Brown, Allason Holt and Courtney Smith all averaging more than 10 points per game during the streak ... Chatham returns to action when it hosts Geneva on Wednesday, January 7 at 7 p.m.

Laura Miller led the Wolverines with 12 points while Raeann Szelong added 10 points and three assists ... Grove City led 23-14 at halftime.

#### Thiel Tomcats (6-4, 2-2 PAC)

Thiel began the new year with a 82-76 victory over Bethany Saturday ... Even though the Tomcats burst out the gates with a 14-0 run, it was the Thiel defense
