PAC Women's Basketball Player of the Week

SHAWNDRA MCDONALD

Washington & Jefferson College 5-3 Sophomore Guard Houston, Tex./Westfield H.S.

McDonald averaged 25.5 points, 7.0 assists, 6.0 rebounds and 2.0 steals per game as W&J went 1-1 at the Elizabethtown Tournament. She scored a seasonhigh 33 points in the loss to Elizabethtown on Saturday.

Also nominated was sophomore center/forward Kelley Richardson of Bethany, senior guard Stephanie Murphy of Grove City, sophomore guard Amanda Swanson of Thiel, and senior guard Trisha Pollock of Waynesburg.

PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison

Bethany went 4-1 over the break, sandwiching a second place finish in Las Vegas and winning the Gettysburg Tournament around a home triumph over Ursuline ... Guard Nikki Babik was the story in Bethany's blowout of Utica, as the 5-7 freshman was 10-of-10 from thre field (including 4-of-4 from behind the arc) and 2-of-2 from the line for 26 points in the Bison's 56-point victory ... The offense struggled against LaVerne, scoring only 11 second half points as the Bison blew an 11-point halftime lead ... Kelley Richardson earned Tournament MVP honors at the Gettysburg Tournament, scoring 28 points and grabbing 16 boards in a win over Ursuline.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J returned to action following the semester break with a 1-1 record at the Coaches vs. Cancer Blue Jay Classic at Elizabethtown College ... On Friday, the Presidents upended Shenandoah 81-68 behind 18 points, eight assists and six rebounds by sophomore point guard Shawndra McDonald ... Tracey Weaver also secured a double-double with 16 points and 10 rebounds, while Rachel Armitage netted 15 points ... W&J held SU's Rosaline Fisher, who averaged 22 points per game entering the contest, to just seven points ... McDonald scored a season-high 33 points in the loss to Elizabethtown.

Grove City Lady Wolverines

The Lady Wolverines went 2-0 at the Elizabethtown Tournament, extending their winning streak to three games ... Senior **Stephanie Murphy** was named MVP of the tourney after scoring 21 points in a 38-point win over Shenandoah ... Freshman **Abby Moose** was named to the All-Tournament team after posting double digit points (12, 10) in both games ... Grove City split a pair of games in Florida, losing at St. Leo 76-52 before topping Flagler 78-62.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Jackets won the Legg Mason Classic at Villa Julie College in Maryland with two victories over the past weekend ... Senior **Shayla Latham** scored 19 points to lead Waynesburg in the title game, a 70-63 win over Galludet ... **Trisha Bullock** averaged 11 points, five assists, three steals and 2.5 rebounds per game in the two wins.

Thiel Tomcats

After the holiday layoff, the Cats returned to the court on Jan. 5 and defeated Pitt-Greensburg 79-70 behind **Sarah Snyder**'s game-high 21 points ... **Amanda Swanson** had a double-double in the home win, scoring 19 points to go along with her game-high 12 rebounds ... **Kerry Gutherie** had 11 points, four rebounds and four assists in the Cat victory.

Westminster Lady Titans

Westminster opened 2002 by dropping a pair of contests at the 2002 Sailfish Classic, hosted by Palm Beach Atlantic College in West Palm Beach, Fla., over the weekend ... WC fell to the host school 59-46, then was defeated by Cardinal Stritch (Wisc.) 81-51 in the consolation contest ... Senior guard Robin Thayer tallied 12 points against Palm Beach Atlantic and 10 more against Cardinal Stritch ... Freshman forward Erica Tallo recorded her first career double-double with 12 points and 10 rebounds against PBAC, then grabbed a career-high 12 boards against CSU ... Junior forward Teale Ganster led the Lady Titans in scoring against Cardinal Stritch with 14 markers.
