5-7 Junior Guard Clearfield, Pa./Clearfield H.S.

Swanson averaged 22.0 points, 8.0 rebounds, 6.0 assists and 6.0 steals in a pair of Thiel victories last week, as the Tomcats posted non-conference wins over La Roche (77-59) and Penn State-Behrend (73-51). She scored a season-high 30 points in the La Roche win, then tallied her third "double-double" of the season with 14 points and 10 rebounds against Behrend.

Also nominated was senior G **Kiki Cohen** of Bethany, junior F **Leigh LeGare** of Grove City, freshman G **Candice Eyerman** of Waynesburg, and sophomore F **Mary Jane Eaton** of Westminster.

Bethany Bison

Bethany won its sixth consecutive game with a 22-point victory at Pitt-Bradford... The Bison spotted the Panthers a 14-0 lead, rebounded to take a one-point half-time lead and then outscored the hosts 44-23 in the second half to pull away... Guard **Kiki Cohen** tied her career-high with six three-pointers and led the way with 22 points... Forward **Katie Hardie** had 16 and center **Kelley Richardson** collected 15 points and 13 boards... Bethany continues to build on its best start since the 1996-97 season.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

Washington & Jefferson gets back to action after being idle last week with two non-conference contests, before opening PAC play on Saturday evening at Waynesburg ... The Presidents travel to Penn State-Behrend on Monday and then host Point Park in Washington on Thursday.

Grove City Lady Wolverines

The Lady Wolverines roughed up a pair of central Pennsylvania opponents last week in their final non-conference tuneups ... Leigh LeGare helped lead Grove City past Altoona with 13 points and a career-best 18 rebounds while Christy Faller added 15 points, 10 rebounds and six assists in the triumph ... Sophomore Abby Moose sparked the victory over Juniata at the Grove City College Arena by tying a career-high with 23 points and grabbing 10 rebounds ... Cara Denniston chipped in eight points, seven boards and six assists while Sandy O'Keefe (12) and Jocelyn Kempema (10) also scored in double-figures.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg sandwiched sluggish losses around a dominating win during the week of three home games ... The Jackets started the week with a 50-45 loss at home to Pitt-Greensburg on Monday, which included a 15:30 scoring drought in the first half ... The next day Waynesburg cruised to a 70-57 win over Frostburg State, as freshman G Candice Eyerman tied her own school record with nine three-pointers in the game to score a career-high 33 points ... The Jackets finished the week with a 71-56 loss against Mount Aloysius Saturday ... Senior forward Kyana Bradley had a monster game for the Jackets with a season-high 25 points to go with her 11 rebounds, four assists, two blocks, and two steals.

Thiel Tomcats

Junior G Amanda Swanson paced the Tomcats with a season-high 30 points, seven steals, six rebounds and six assists in their 77-59 win over La Roche ... La Roche trimmed the Thiel lead to six, 40-34, with 1:53 to play but the Tomcats forced nine second-half turnovers to preserve the win ... Freshman G Heather Abate hit for a career-high 20 points and led the way to a 73-51 win at Penn State Behrend ... Swanson finished with 14 points and a game-high 10 boards to go with six assists and five steals while junior F Danielle Mezzulo added 12 points and seven rebounds.

Westminster Lady Titans

Westminster split a pair of non-conference road games last week, falling to Mount Union 77-70 on Monday before snapping a three-game losing streak at Allegheny 70-60 on Thursday ... Sophomore F Mary Jane Eaton, making her first career start at MUC, posted careerhigh totals of 13 points and 14 rebounds ... Seniors Ashley Kenney and Jaime Lynn tied for team scoring honors with 14 points apiece, while senior Jennifer Petures and sophomore Erica Tallo added 12 markers each ... Sophomore Alyson Gasper dished out a team-high five assists ... Tallo posted team-high totals in five categories at Allegheny: points (19), rebounds (13), assists (four), blocks (four) and steals (four) ... Her point and block totals set new career-highs.

vs. Juniata (1/13 - 7 p.m.) vs. Grove City* (1/18 - 4 p.m.)

Upcoming Game Notes: Juniata leads the series with the Bison 2-0, although this is the first meeting between the teams since 1992, an 88-73 Bison loss... Grove City leads the series with Bethany 22-16, although the Bison took two of three last year ... The Lady Wolverines took the first clash 75-73 at GCC, but the Bison rebounded with a 71-65 win in the regular season finale and a 60-55 victory in the PAC Tournament championship game ... **Kiki Cohen** led the way in the first Bethany win with 23 points and **Katie Hardie** totaled 16 points and 14 rebounds in the PAC clincher.
