Kust also drew two of the PAC's top players (Thiel's **Amber Bodrick**, TMC's **Jayme Thiem**) on the defensive end and helped hold the duo to a combined 7-of-27 shooting.

Also nominated was senior G Caelyn DiSanti of Bethany, sophomore F Kayla Hilko of Chatham, sophomore F Christine Slater of Grove City, senior F Kristen Humphrey of Thomas More, sophomore F Elisha Jones of Waynesburg, and junior G Amy Dolsak of Westminster.

NCAA D-III provisional members Saint Vincent and Geneva continued their torrid play, as the Bearcats and Golden Tornadoes each went 2-0 last week against PAC competition.

WHO'S HOT: Freshman Christine Carugati led 3-0 Geneva with 15 points vs. Fredonia and a season-high 19 against Waynesburg ... Junior G Amy Dolsak led Westminster to a 2-0 week by averaging 14.0 points and 6.0 rebounds ... Sophomore F Christine Slater averaged 14.3 points and 11.0 rebounds per game for 2-1 Grove City ... Senior F Kristen Humphrey averaged 15.5 points and 8.5 rebounds per game for 1-1 Thomas More ... Elisha Jones averaged 15.0 points and 6.5 rebounds for 0-2 Waynesburg.

Freshman Emily Fenton hit two game-winning free throws for Saint Vincent with 5.2 seconds remaining in a 70-69 PAC win over Bethany ... Susannah Cartland had her first Bethany double-double with 14 points and 10 boards in a loss at Saint Vincent ... Towanda-Michelle Warren scored 18 points for Thiel in a loss to W&J.


Thomas More Saints (11-2, 5-1 PAC)

edge for the No. 1 seed in the PAC Tournament ... 
