# PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL PLAYER OF THE WEEK

## KATIE RESANOVICH

**Bethany College** 

6-0 Senior Forward/Center Jefferson Hills, Pa./Serra Catholic H.S.

Resanovich led Bethany to a 2-0 record by averaging 15.5 points, 11.0 rebounds and 2.5 blocked shots per game, while shooting 61 percent (14-of-23) from the field. She tallied 17 points and 15 rebounds as the Bison opened defense of their PAC title with a 77-67 win over Thiel.

Also nominated was junior G **Leigh Sulkowski** of Washington & Jefferson, junior G **Candice Eyerman** of Waynesburg, and sophomore G **Desiree Sterling** of Westminster.

## PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

### **Bethany Bison**

Bethany ran its win streak to four games last week, posting wins at Frostburg State (82-77) and at home vs. Thiel (77-67) in the PAC opener for both teams ... Jenny Place scored 17 points – three points off her career high – and pulled down 11 rebounds at FSU ... Senior Nikki Babik contributed a team-best 20 points while Courtney Irwin and Katie Resanovich turned in 19 and 14 points, respectively ... Resonavich's 17-point, 15-rebound effort led an otherwise balanced attack against the Tomcats ... Irwin added 20 points and 10 rebounds, while Babik contributed 17 points and five assists.

### Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J picked up a key regional victory over Thomas More Tuesday, then opened conference play by snapping Waynesburg's six-game win streak ... The Presidents trailed by 10 points at halftime vs. Thomas More, but junior G Leigh Sulkowski scored 15 of her 20 points in the second half to lead the W&J comeback ... Sulkowski added 10 rebounds, while sophomore F Amanda Stanonik had 14 points and six rebounds ... W&J held Waynesburg to 28 percent shooting Saturday as Sulkowski paced the Presidents with 19 points and 11 boards ... W&J led by just one point at halftime, but Stanonik keyed a 13-3 run in the second half ... Junior G Courtney Janczak nailed finished with 14 points, while Stanonik added 12 points and nine caroms.

## **Grove City Lady Wolverines**

Grove City dropped three straight games last week, including a pair at home ... Westminster closed the first half with an 11-2 run and maintained a double-digit lead the entire second half ... Freshman Rachel McCoy led Grove City with 17 points and three blocks ... Against Behrend, Grove City outscored the Lions 12-1 in the final 1:50 but fell 52-51 ... Rachel Romance's potential game-winner glanced off the rim at the buzzer ... Shannon Overdorff had a career-high 11 points while Romance and Jocelyn Kempema also had 11 ... The Wolverines opened the week with a 74-64 setback at Case Western Reserve ... Sandv O'Keefe led GCC with 21 points while McCoy had 12 points and four blocks.

### Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Yellow Jackets extended their winning streak to six games with a 62-54 victory over Carnegie Mellon before falling to W&J in the PAC opener ... Wavnesburg shot 50 percent from the field in the second half to eliminate a 12-point halftime deficit at CMU ... The Jackets went on a 21-8 run in the opening minutes of the second half, then allowed the Tartans to score only three points in the final 3:30 ... Guards Ashley Urban and Katie Lewandowski led the Jackets with 15 points each ... The Presidents forced 13 turnovers and limited Waynesburg to a 27.6 shooting percentage in the PAC opener ... Candice Eyerman finished the game with 18 points, including season-best 6of-9 from three-point territory, and five rebounds and two assists.

### **Thiel Tomcats**

Thiel dropped its only contest last week, falling at Bethany 66-76 in the PAC opener for both squads ... The Tomcats went on a 9-0 run to go up by nine points (26-17) with just under eight minutes to play in the first period ... The Bison took the lead at the 4:14 mark on a Jennie Place lay up and went into the half sporting a five-point cushion (41-36) ... Bethany took its first double-digit lead at 68-57 with 7:30 left and cruised to the 10-point win ... Senior F Kristen Benjamin paced the Tomcats with a gamebest 23 points and seven rebounds ... Sophomore G Nicole Valentino added 12 points and five rebounds, while sophomore F Fontella Jones chipped in with 11 points and 10 rebounds.

### Westminster Lady Titans

Westminster ran its win streak to three games following victories over La Roche (70-42) and PAC rival Grove City (72-49) last week ... Senior F Erin Morrow had a team-high 10 points against the Redhawks, as 13 different Lady Titans dented the scoring column ... At GCC, sophomore G Desiree Sterling and Rachel Eaton split team-high scoring honors with 14 points apiece ... The 14 markers by Eaton set a new career-high, while Sterling (who was a perfect 4-of-4 from three-point range) added a gameand career-high 10 rebounds for her first career double-double ... Freshman G Emilee Ackerman also reached double figures in scoring with 12 points ... Senior G Alyson Gasper dished out a gamehigh eight assists in the victory.
