McGrath posted a season-high 22 points while adding 11 points, six blocked shots, four assists and three steals as Saint Vincent handed Thomas More its first PAC loss of the season, 68-65. The win lifted the Bearcats into a three-way tie for first in the PAC with the Saints and Waynesburg. Previously on Wednesday, she recorded a game-high 12 points in just 21 minutes in a 69-33 league victory over Geneva, giving her weekly averages of 17.0 points, 8.0 rebounds, 3.5 blocks, 3.0 assists and 3.0 steals per game. For the week, McGrath shot 65 percent (11-of-17) from the field and 75 percent (12-of-16) at the foul line.

Also nominated was senior G **Anne Wilson** of Bethany, senior G **Lizz King** of Chatham, junior G **Leah Gibson** of Grove City, junior F **Kelly Barzak** of Thiel, junior G **Allison Long** of Thomas More, senior F **Ashley Kirkpatrick** of Washington & Jefferson, senior PG **Hannah Hunter** of Waynesburg, and junior F **Katie Hughes** of Westminster.

PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL 2011-12 - Week 8 Conference Notes

SCHEDULE MIDPOINT: The race for the 2011-12 PAC women's basketball regular season title will reach the halfway point following Wednesday's games, with Saturday's contests kicking off the second half of the conference double round robin schedule ... As we approach the midway point, there is a logjam at the top of the conference standings with five-time PAC champion Thomas More, Saint Vincent and Waynesburg all tied for first place with one league loss apiece.

NEWS AND NOTES: Saint Vincent handed Thomas More its first PAC loss behind 22 points and 11 boards by junior F **Devin McGrath** ... Senior G **Anne Wilson** led Bethany to a 2-0 week by averaging 13.5 ppg, 5.5 rpg and 3.0 apg ... Junior G **Allison Long** averaged 20.5 ppg for 1-1 Thomas More, with a career-high 26 in a loss at Saint Vincent ... Junior F **Katie Hughes** averaged 16.0 ppg and 6.5 rpg for 1-1 Westminster, including her fourth career double-double (18 pts., 10 rebs.) vs. Bethany.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: Senior PG **Hannah Hunter** averaged 16.5 ppg, 5.0 rpg and 5.0 apg for 1-1 Waynesburg ... Senior G **Lizz King** averaged 16.3 ppg for 1-2 Chatham, including a career-best 26 vs. Thiel ... Junior F **Kelly Barzak** averaged 16.5 ppg, 8.5 rpg, 4.0 bpg, and 2.5 apg for 1-1 Thiel ... Senior F **Ashley Kirkpatrick** averaged a double-double (12.0 ppg, 10.0 rpg) for 1-1 W&J ... Junior G **Leah Gibson** averaged 14.0 ppg for 1-1 Grove City ... **Beth DeLuca** averaged 13.5 ppg for 0-2 Geneva.

PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison (9-6, 5-3 PAC)



The Bison won a pair of conference games to firmly take over fourth place in the PAC ... By turning 20 Thiel turnovers into 29 points and recording a 26-9 scoring advantage from the bench, BC turned aside the Tomcats 76-63 ... **Katelynn Hackathorn** and **Kayla Taormina** both had 14 and **Anne Wilson** fired in 12 ... In Saturday's game at Westminster, neither team held a lead larger than seven points, but Bethany staved off the Titans for a 65-62 triumph ... Wilson scored nine of her 15 points in the second half and also posted six rebounds, five assists and two steals, while Taormina and **Renee Shepherd** both had 10 ... Taormina also had seven rebounds and three assists and Shepherd blocked three shots.

Chatham Cougars (3-12, 0-8 PAC)



Chatham fell in both PAC contests this week despite efforts from top performers ... Monday, they snapped a 10-game losing streak against Penn State-Greater Allegheny ... In the loss against Westminster, **Lizz King** continued to be a top scorer with 11 points and six rebounds ... **Marguerite Sargent** was also on the leaderboard with nine points, nine rebounds ... King continued to excel in the loss at Thiel with a career-high 26 points ... Nine of her points were from 3-point goals ... **Carly Zelenak** recorded 12 points and nine rebounds ... **Julianne Speeney** rejoins the Cougars with nine points and four rebounds ... The Cougars had five players record double digits in the win against Penn State-Greater Allegheny, led by Sargent with 16.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes (3-12, 2-6 PAC)



Geneva's women could not build on its two-game win streak from a week ago and lost games to Saint Vincent and Washington & Jefferson last week by an average of 28 points ... The offense could not get going in either game as the Golden Tornadoes averaged only 37.5 points in those two losses ... **Beth DeLuca** scored a team high 11 points against Saint Vincent and added 16 more points against W&J ... **Samantha Fisher** started her first game of the season on Saturday and responded with nine points and nine rebounds in 34 minutes of action ... Geneva will travel to Westminster and Thomas More next week before returning home on January 25th.

Grove City Wolverines (4-11, 3-5 PAC)



The Grove City women's basketball team went 1-1 in PAC play last week ... Wednesday, the Wolverines edged visiting W&J 68-65, giving Grove City its first home win against the Prexies since February 2, 1999 ... **Leah Gibson** led Grove City with 17 points ... **Megan Gebrosky** (16), **Alicia Maust** (12) and **Hannah Jo Coneby** (10) all joined Gibson in double figures ... Coneby also had 11 rebounds ... Grove City shot 46 percent (23 of 50) from the floor ... Saturday at Waynesburg, the Wolverines fell to 3-5 in the league with a 79-51 setback at Waynesburg ... Gibson paced GCC with 11 points and **Kelsey Shirey** contributed nine points and seven rebounds ... Grove City shot just 19 percent from the field in the first half.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (12-3, 7-1 PAC)



For the second time in three years, SVC defeated Thomas More at home, this time a 68-65 win ... The only two times the Bearcats have beaten the Saints since joining the PAC were in Saturday home games at 2 p.m. ... The forward duo of **Brittany Sedlock** and **Devin McGrath** combined for 46 points, 16 rebounds, eight assists and seven steals in the win ... The two also finished 24-of-30 at the free-throw line, with each making 12 foul shots ... Freshman **Elle Collins** added 10 points, including two trifectas ... Saint Vincent shot a season-best 41 free-throws in the game ... At Geneva Wednesday, SVC raced to a 45-22 halftime lead before cruising to the 69-33 win ... McGrath led all scorers with 12 points.

Thiel Tomcats (3-12, 3-5 PAC)



In the loss to Bethany, junior G **Kelly Muffley** registered game highs in both points (19) and rebounds (12) ... Junior F **Kelly Barzak** finished the game with 17 points, eight rebounds and a career-high four assists, and three blocks ... Against Chatham, finished with 16 points, nine rebounds and five blocks while teammate senior G **Ashley Davis** produced her second double-double of the season with 12 points and 10 rebounds ... Muffley chipped in 13 points and four rebounds, sophomore **Beth Hines** and junior **Julia Monteleone** finished with nine and eight points respectively.

Thomas More Saints (11-4, 7-1 PAC)



Thomas More went 1-1 last week as it defeated Waynesburg, but fell to Saint Vincent on the road ... Two Saints averaged in double-figure scoring as junior G **Allison Long** averaged 20.5 points per game, including a career-high and a game-high 26 points against Saint Vincent and sophomore G **Katie Kitchen** averaged 12.0 points per game ... Junior F/C **Katie Kees** led the team in the boards as she averaged 8.0 rebounds per game against the Yellow Jackets and Bearcats ... For the season, Long leads the team in scoring with 14.4 ppg., and sophomore F **Moriah Corey** leads the team on the boards with 6.8 rpg. ... The Saints are shooting 40.7 percent from the field and have forced 301 turnovers.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents (8-7, 3-5 PAC)



The Presidents saw their 12-game win streak at GCC Arena come to an end as they fell to Grove City 68-65 on Wednesday ... Senior **Blair Cotton** led the team with 15 points and also added five rebounds ... Senior **Ashley Kirkpatrick** added nine points and 13 boards ... W&J bounced back to defeat Geneva 62-42 on Saturday ... The Presidents turned 34 Geneva turnovers into 39 points ... W&J shot just 29 percent (19-of-64), but was aided by solid free throw shooting (20-of-26) and a season-low six turnovers ... Kirkpatrick contributed 15 points, seven rebounds, four blocks and three steals ... Senior PG **Vanessa Rivera** added seven points, five assists and four steals.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (12-3, 7-1 PAC)



It was an up-and-down week for Waynesburg, which saw its nine-game win streak snapped at the hands of Thomas More Wednesday ... The Yellow Jackets led the Saints 40-38 at halftime, but ice cold shooting doomed Waynesburg down the stretch as Thomas More picked up a 74-58 win ... The Orange & Black bounced back with a 79-51 home win over Grove City Saturday ... The Jackets led by 30 at halftime and cruised on to the victory ... Three different WU players averaged double digits in scoring over the 1-1 split ... Senior PG **Hannah Hunter** led the trio with a 16.5 ppg average. She was followed by junior Gs **Jessi Drayer** (15.5) and **Brittany Spencer** (13.0).

Westminster Titans (3-11, 3-5 PAC)



Junior F **Katie Hughes** led Westminster with her fourth career double-double with game-highs of 18 points and 10 rebounds versus Bethany ... In last week's games, she led Westminster with 13-for-28 shooting for 32 points and 13 rebounds.
