On Saturday at Grove City, she again scored 19 points, while grabbing a team-high eight rebounds and adding three assists and two steals. She enters this week second in the PAC in scoring (16.2 pts/gm), while leading the conference in rebounding (9.3/ gm)


Bethany Bison (7-8, 2-5 PAC)

points ... Brittany Sedlock led the way with her sixth double-double of the year (19 points, 11 rebs), while Maria Baroffio and Devin McGrath each scored 14 ... SVC shot 52 percent from the field for the game ... On Saturday, SVC trailed 28-23 at the half before the Bearcats ended the game on a 22-5 run for the 64-56 comeback win ... Sedlock again posted 19 points, with eight rebounds, while Melissa Mansur tallied six steals, as SVC forced 24 turnovers while committing a season-low 8.

In the two games last week, three Saints averaged in double-figure scoring as Chelsea Tolliver averaged 13.5ppg, Nicole Dickman averaged 11.0 ppg., and Katie Kitchen averaged 10.5 ppg. ... Katie Kees led the team in rebounding and blocks with 9.0 rpg and seven block shots ... For the season, the Saints are shooting 43.0% from the field on 372-of-866 shooting ... Tolliver leads the Saints in scoring with 14.8 ppg., and Dickman adds 13.5 ppg.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (11-4, 5-3 PAC)

Waynesburg made program history on Saturday when they snapped a 27-game losing streak to Wash. & Jeff. with a 78-65 win ... After trailing by two at half-

time. Wavnesburg out-scored their opponents 45-30 over the final 20 minutes of play to pick up the victory ... The Jacket offensive effort was led by guard Brittany Spencer, who went off for a game-high 20 pts ... Guard Jessi Drayer put together another solid all-around game in her first season by racking up 17 pts, a game-high eight rbds and four assists ... She also swiped a contest-best two steals ... Forward Elisha Jones chipped in 14 pts to the winning effort and point guard Hannah Hunter added 11 to go along with five assists, which tied for the game high in helpers.

Chatham Cougars (5-10, 1-6 PAC)

Megan Gebrosky fired in 19 pts, including five three-point goals . Beaver County native Christine Slater pumped in 18 pts and Leah Gibson added 16 ... The victory gave Grove City four wins in a six-day span ... Saturday, Grove City's bid for an upset of No. 25 Saint Vincent fell short as the Bearcats closed the game on a 22-6 run ... Slater posted 20 pts and 11 rebounds while Gibson added 15 pts ... The Wolverines surrendered 21 offensive rebounds ... Slater is the active scoring leader in the conference with 1,396 points.

Thiel Tomcats (3-12, 2-5 PAC)

Thiel picked up their second win as they defeated Westminster 68-59 ... Ashley Davis and Kelly Barzak led Thiel as they each had a double-double on the

day (Davis - 14 pts and 12 rbds; Barzak - 11 pts and 10 rbds) ... Jasmin Jones also scored in double figures (12) ... Game two saw Thiel play against the No. 3 ranked Thomas More Saints ... The Tomcats held their own against the number one team in the conference but were still defeated 77-65 ... Kelly Muffley led the charge as she led all scorers in the game with 17 pts ...
