PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL PLAYER OF THE WEEK

SHAWNDR A MCDONALD

Washington & Jefferson College

5-3 Junior Guard

McDonald averaged 21.0 points, 4.7 assists, 4.7 steals and 4.0 rebounds in three games for Washington & Jefferson last week, as the Presidents went 3-0 and improved to 10-1 on the season with wins over Penn State-Behrend (70-50), Point Park (68-51) and PAC foe Waynesburg (64-35). For the week, she shot 51 percent (24-of-47) from the field, including 50 percent (8-of-16) from three-point range.

Also nominated was junior G/F **Katie Tetzlaw** of Bethany, sophomore G **Abby Moose** of Grove City, junior G **Amanda Swanson** of Thiel, senior F **Kyana Bradley** of Waynesburg, and sophomore F **Erica Tallo** of Westminster.

PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison

Bethany overcame a sluggish first half to outscore Juniata 38-22 in the second half to post a 66-41 win Monday night ... **Kelley Richardson** (15 points, 10 rebounds) and **Katie Hardie** (10 points, 10 rebounds) recorded their fourth and ninth double-doubles of the year in the win ... In the PAC opener Saturday, Bethany shot just 24 percent (10-41) in the second half as they lost a four-point half-time lead and suffered a 67-57 upset to Grove City ... After rallying from an eight-point deficit to tie the game, the Bison went 1-14 from the floor in the final 4:30 ... Richardson tallied game-highs of 18 points and 13 rebounds, while **Katie Tetzlaw** tossed in a career-high 15 points.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J picked up its second win of the season over Penn State-Behrend on Monday evening behind 19 points and six assists from junior G **Shawndra McDonald** ... Freshman G **Jordana Gracenin** chipped in 16 points on 6-of-10 shooting, including 4-of-6 from beyond the arc ... W&J held Point Park to 17 percent shooting in the first half in cruising to the 17-point win on Wednesday ... McDonald once again led the way with 25 markers, seven steals, six assists and five rebounds ... In the conference opener on Saturday, McDonald spearheaded a superb defensive effort and scored 18 points ... The Presidents limited Waynesburg to five first-half field goals and led 41-7 at one point in the first half.

Grove City Lady Wolverines

The streaking Lady Wolverines bounced four-time defending PAC champion Bethany at Hummel Field House Saturday after trailing by as many as seven in the second half ... **Abby Moose** scored 16 second-half points to key the victory while **Christy Faller** added a dozen points off the bench ... **Jocelyn Kempema** chipped in 10 points and four assists ... The Lady Wolverine backcourt of Moose, Kempema and **Cara Denniston** played all 20 minutes in the second half ... Grove City held Bethany to just 24 percent (10-of-41) shooting in the final 20 minutes ... It is the second time in the last three regular-season meetings that Grove City has won at Hummel Field House.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg plays games on three consecutive days, which began with a 64-35 loss to W&J in the PAC opener on Saturday, and a 64-43 win over Chestnut Hill Sunday afternoon at Chatham ... The Yellow Jackets were held scoreless for the first 6:49 of play against W&J, as the Presidents jumped to a 12-0 lead and rolled to a 41-7 halftime lead ... Waynesburg senior F **Kyana Bradley** scored a team-high 13 points and six rebounds ... Waynesburg shot 15 percent (5 for 33) from the field in the first half, before finishing at 23 percent (10 for 32) ... Sunday against Chestnut Hill, **Candice Eyerman** scored 15 points on five three-pointers to lead Waynesburg, while **Rachel Dillon** recorded game high with three steals and seven assists.

Thiel Tomcats

After picking up a 69-54 win at Medaille on Tuesday, Thiel had its first three-game win streak of the season snapped to Westminster 59-49 on Saturday to open the PAC season ... Junior F **Amanda Swanson** paced four Tomcats in double-digits with 14 points, a game-high 13 rebounds, eight steals and four assists ... Senior G **Mayumi Sasaki** and junior F **Danielle Mezzulo** each added 12 while freshman G **Heather Abate** chipped in with 11 in the non-conference victory ... The Tomcats and Lady Titans battled to an 18-18 tie at the half, but Westminster hit 13-of-15 free throws in the second half to land the victory in the conference opener ... Swanson notched a game-high 14 points and nine rebounds.

Westminster Lady Titans

Westminster was 2-1 last week, with the Lady Titans capturing their PAC opener ... After falling at Case Western Reserve 79-63 on Monday, WC rebounded to top Carnegie Mellon 84-71 on Wednesday and Thiel 59-49 in Saturday PAC action ... Senior **Samor Himes** and sophomore **Erica Tallo** tied for team scoring honors at CWRU with 10 points each ... Tallo had team-high totals of 18 points, eight rebounds and two blocked shots at CMU ... Senior G **Ashley Kenney** scored 17 points while adding a team-best four steals, while sophomore G **Erin Morrow** added 12 points off the bench on 5-of-6 shooting ... Kenney had 13 points while adding a career-high seven steals at Thiel. with Tallo and senior G **Jaime Lynn** adding 12 and 11 points, respectively.

Upcoming Game Notes: Bethany leads the series with Waynesburg 17-10 and has owned the Yellow Jackets of late, winning 14 in a row ... The last Waynesburg win was a 49-48 decision in 1995 ... Bethany swept a pair of games last year behind career-nights from two Bison ... **Kristy Baker** dropped in 27 in a 78-48 Bison win in Bethany and **Kelley Richardson** cashed in 35 in a 79-51 triumph at Waynesburg... The highly anticipated match-up with W&J will be the first of the year between the PAC foes ... **Katie Hardie** averaged 26 points as Bethany claimed a pair of 20-point wins last season ... W&J leads the series 32-26.
