KRISTA BEECHY Grove City College

5-9 sophomore forward Winesburg, Ohio Berlin Hiland H.S.

Beechy averaged 17.0 points, 11.5 rebounds and 5.5 assists per game last week for the Wolverines, who posted




wins over PAC opponents Waynesburg (62-52) and Saint Vincent (65-54). She totaled 14 points, 14 boards and five assists in GCC's first PAC win of the season against the Yellow Jackets Wednesday, then recorded 17 points, nine caroms and six assists at home against SVC, including the first five points of a 9-0 GCC run to close the game.

Also nominated was freshman G **Kelly Goode** of Bethany, junior G **Jayme Thiem** of Thomas More, sophomore G **Stephanie Smith** of Washington & Jefferson, and senior G/F **Emilee Ackerman** of Westminster.

Bethany Bison



Chatham, BC trailed by 14 at halftime, but rallied for a 67-60 win ... **Kelly Goode** scored 17 of her 23 in the second half to lead the comeback and **Caelyn DiSanti** scored 10 ... Against Westminster, six of seven players who saw time scored in double digits and the Bison turned 26 Titan turnovers into 30 points, as they scored an 83-66 victory ... **Kaitlin McCormick** tied a career-high with 17 points and set new career-bests with eight rebounds, eight steals and four assists.



Geneva Golden Tornadoes

Geneva found its lost offense Saturday in an impressive 36-point victory over Thiel ... Coming off its worst offensive performance of the sea-

son (34 points) against third-ranked Thomas More, Geneva shot 48% from the field against Thiel to pick up victory #13 on the season ... **Allyson Clarke** posted her ninth double-double of the season with 18 points and 11 rebounds, while **Renee Rawding** scored 15 points, including an 8-9 effort from the foul line ... Geneva's defense continues to be one of the stingiest in the PAC, allowing opponents just over 50 points per game ... Geneva held Thiel to just seven first half field goals and a 26% shooting mark.



Saint Vincent Bearcats

The Lady Bearcats dropped two contests last week ... In Wednesday's 83-57 home loss to W&J, Saint Vincent shot just 16 percent from the field in the first half (5-of-31), and was unable to recover

... Janelle Reed and Laura Klimchock each scored 15 points in the defeat, SVC's third straight to the Presidents ... Saturday, SVC dropped a 65-54 decision at Grove City ... Down 14 with less than 10 minutes remaining, the Lady Bearcats came back to pull to within two, 54-52, at the three-minute mark, but were unable to get any closer ... Klimchock and Reed again led SVC in scoring, with 16 points apiece, while Caryn Glassbrenner added 10 rebounds.



Thomas More Saints

No. 3 Thomas More got defensive in extending its record-setting start as the Saints allowed a season-low 34 points, twice ... The

two opponents managed to shoot 24 percent from the field and 19 percent from behind the arc ... Senior **Amanda Link** and junior **Jayme Thiem** combined for 26 points on 9-of-9 shooting to help boost TMC to the victory at Chatham ... Freshman **Nicole Dickman** was the only player to reach double figures in the Geneva victory, scoring 10 points.



Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Yellow Jackets suffered a pair of losses last week, extending their losing streak to 14 straight overall and six PAC games ... Despite a career-

high 18 points from senior G **Amanda Mitchell**, Waynesburg dropped a 62-52 contest against Grove City Wednesday ... In that game, the Yellow Jackets led at halftime for the first time all season and shot 41.2 percent from the field – their second-best performance of the season ... Saturday, the Yellow Jackets suffered their 21st consecutive loss to Washington & Jefferson, 67-51 ... Freshman F **Elisha Jones** set a career-high with 20 points while adding six rebounds and two steals against the Presidents.

Chatham Cougars

Chatham dropped two PAC games at home last week, falling to Bethany 67-60 and unbeaten and #3-ranked Thomas More 70-34 ... The Cougars held

a 36-22 halftime lead over Bethany on a 50 percent shooting effort from the floor ... Bethany rallied in the second half by connecting on five shots from behind the arc ... **Kayla Hilko** led Chatham with 10 points ... In the second game of the week, Chatham lost to visiting Thomas More ... Sophomore **Libby Soeder** scored 12 points for Chatham in the loss ... The Cougars rebounded Monday night with a 68-36 non-league home win over Wilson.



Grove City Wolverines

Grove City posted a pair of double-digit victories last week ... Wednesday at Waynesburg, freshman F **Christine Slater** fired in 20 points in her first collegiate start ... Sophomore **Krista Beechy**

added a 17-point, 14-rebound double-double, along with five assists ... GCC outscored Waynesburg 42-29 in the second half ... Saturday, Beechy (17) and Slater (16) combined for 33 points in a 65-54 victory over visiting Saint Vincent ... Grove City closed the game on a 9-0 run ... Beechy also had nine rebounds and six assists, while **Brittany Anderson** grabbed a season-high 15 rebounds ... Grove City owned a 44-26 edge on the glass.



Thiel Tomcats

Thiel suffered a pair of PAC losses last week, falling at home on Wednesday to Westminster 66-49 and on Saturday at Geneva 80-44 ... Against the Titans,

sophomore G Michelle George and sophomore F Jasmin Jones each paced the Tomcats with 12 points ... Jones totaled a gamehigh 11 rebounds while George chipped in with three rebounds and a pair of assists ... Against Geneva, Jones led Thiel with 11 points, eight rebounds and four steals ... Junior G Amber Bodrick finished with 10 points, six rebounds and three steals while junior G Catie Sieber added 10 points and four rebounds.



Washington & Jefferson Presidents

W&J snapped its two-game losing skid with victories over Saint Vincent and Waynesburg last week ... Wednesday in Latrobe, 13 different Presidents scored led by sophomore G **Stephanie Smith**'s 15 points ... The Presidents held a 41-20 halftime lead

and led by as many as 40 points in the second half ... Sophomore F Maggie Gibson collected her ninth double-double with 12 points and 11 rebounds, while junior F Emily Hays added 12 points and five boards ... Gibson entered last week as the nation's fourth-leading field goal shooter ... Smith fired in a career-high six three-pointers on Saturday and finished with a game-high 22 points.



Westminster Titans

Westminster split two PAC road games last week, winning 66-49 at Thiel and losing 83-66 at Bethany ... Senior G/F **Emilee Ackerman** averaged 30 points per game, including a career-

high 33 points in a loss at Bethany and a game-high 27 in a win at Thiel ... Ackerman also averaged 11.5 rebounds per game including a season-high 12 at Bethany ... Freshman G Kaitlin McCarthy scored 10 points while dishing out a game-high six assists and tying a career-high with seven rebounds in the Thiel game ... Junior G Gina Brunetti reached double figures in the loss at Bethany with 13 points.

Bethany faces two stern tests this week when they travel to W&J Wednesday before a showdown at #3 Thomas More Saturday ... Bethany was swept by W&J last year, although they led the Presidents 36-24 at halftime of the game at W&J before falling 67-54 ... The Presidents have won four straight over the Bison and lead the all-time series 39-30 ... Saturday's meeting with the third-ranked Saints is the highest ranked team Bethany has played since opening the 2002-03 season with a match-up at #3 Wilmington.




Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

This will be Geneva head coach Ron Galbreath's first trip to the Buzz Ridl Gymnasium as a coach since coaching the Westminster men's team for 25 seasons (1969. 1975-98) ... Westminster beat Saint Vincent, 77-45, earlier this season behind Emilee Ackerman's game-high 24 points.
