PAC Women's Basketball Player of the Week

KELLEY RICHARDSON Bethany College

6-0 Sophomore Forward/Center Follansbee, W.Va./Brooke H.S.

Richardson averaged 21.5 points and 16.5 rebounds per game, leading Bethany to a 2-0 week with wins over PAC rivals Westminster and Washington & Jefferson. She tied her career-high with 17 rebounds in the win at Westminster. The PAC leader in field goal percentage shot 16-of-24 (.667) from the field for the week and is shooting 56.7 percent for the season. With two more double-doubles this week, she now has 11 on the season.

Also nominated was junior forward **Jessica Jenkins** of Grove City, sophomore guard **Rachel Armitage** of Washington & Jefferson, and freshman guard **Candace Newman** of Waynesburg.

Bethany Bison

Bethany ran their winning streak to six games with a pair of 20-point victories ... At Westminster, Kelley Richardson had 26 points and tied a career-high with 17 rebounds ... Bethany held the Titans to 31 percent shooting for the game as they avenged a pair of losses to Westminster last year ... In the PAC opener against W&J, Bethany raced out to a 16-2 lead and the Presidents moved within single digits only once the rest of the way ... Katie Hardie (24 points, 10 rebounds) and Richardson (17 points, 16 rebounds) posted double-doubles in the triumph ... Four Bison averaged double figures for the week: Richardson (21.5), Hardie (20.0), guard Kiki Cohen (14.0) and guard Nikki Babik (11.0).

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J went 2-1 last week, including a 63-59 win over Penn St.-Behrend giving the Presidents a season sweep over the Lions ... Libby Gasior was the hero against PS-B, hitting a short jumper with twoseconds left then stealing the inbounds pass to secure the win ... Shawndra McDonald had 18 points and eight rebounds, while Rachel Armitage added 16 points ... Armitage scored a game-high 18 points on Wednesday to lead W&J past Thiel, 58-53 ... On Saturday, Bethany jumped out to an early 23-7 lead and never trailed in the 86-66 win ... Armitage drained four trevs en route to a team-high 20 points against the Bison, while McDonald and Amy Strosnider each added 17 markers.

The Lady Wolverines have won three games in a row and six of their last seven after going 2-0 in the first week of league play ... A dozen Lady Wolverines scored in the Waynesburg win led by freshman **Abby Moose**'s 12 points ... Junior **Christy Faller** tossed in 11 points on 5for-6 shooting and junior **Jessica Jenkins** contributed nine points and 10 boards off the bench in the win over Thiel.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Jackets had four players in double figures Sunday; however they dropped a 79-62 decision to Pitt-Greensburg ... It was UPG's fourth consecutive victory ... Freshman **Candace Newman** has scored in double figures in each of the last three Jackets games ... She has scored 42 points during that span.

Thiel Tomcats

Thiel began the week with a 77-53 victory over visiting Medaille on Jan. 14, but lost two straight PAC contests to go 1-2 last week ... Senior Jennifer Barnes had a hot hand shooting the three, hitting 3of-4 for 17 points while senior Sara Snyder finished with 14 points and seven rebounds ... In their Jan. 16 loss to W&J, the Cats held a 27-21 halftime advantage over the Presidents, but W&J came out strong in the second half ... Sndyer finished with 13 points and nine rebounds for the Cats ... In Saturday's 65-61 loss to Grove City, the Cats fell behind 33-25 at halftime and closed to 60-58 with 2:15 left, but would get no closer...Sndyer led the Cats with a gamehigh 21 points and nine rebounds.

Westminster Lady Titans

Westminster split a pair of games against PAC opponents last week, faling to Bethany 77-57 before topping Waynesburg 66-47 ... The loss to the Bison marked the team's first loss against a PAC opponent since joining the league (WC went 10-0 vs. the PAC last season) ... Senior guard **Robin Thayer** led the Lady Titans in scoring in both games, posting 17 markers against Bethany and 21 at Waynesburg ... Thayer now has 1,129 career points and is just 57 points from surpassing **Colleen Dion** (1.185 points from 1992-96) as the program's all-time leading scorer.

The Bison split with Thiel last season, losing in Greenville, 80-66 before rebounding for a 71-41 victory in Bethany ... The Green and White maintain a 21-16 advantage over Thiel in the series.
