She recorded 15 points and 10 rebounds in the Tomcats' 65-53 road win over Mercer County rival Grove City, then recorded 13 points and 11 boards to lift the Tomcats to a 64-62 home upset over Waynesburg, which knocked the Yellow Jackets out of a three-way for first place in the PAC.

PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL 2011-12 - Week 9 Conference Notes

THIEL UPSETS WU: The race for the 2011-12 PAC women's basketball title took an unexpected turn Saturday, as the three-way tie at the top of the league standings was broken ... Thiel overcame a 10-point halftime deficit to upset Waynesburg 64-62, knocking the Yellow Jackets out of the three-way tie for first and leaving five-time defending PAC champion Thomas More and Saint Vincent alone at the top of the conference standings.

NEWS AND NOTES: Thiel junior F Kelly Barzak averaged 15.5 points and 2.5 blocks per game for the 2-0 Tomcats ... Saint Vincent senior F **Brittany Sedlock** averaged 15.5 ppg, 10.0 rpg, 2.5 apg and 2.0 spg for the 2-0 Bearcats ... Sophomore G **Devin Beasley** averaged 8.5 assists per game and scored a career-high 14 points in a win vs. Geneva for 2-0 Thomas More ... Junior F **Paige Pearce** averaged 10.5 ppg, 12.0 rpg and 4.0 bpg on the week for 1-1 Waynesburg.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: Vanessa Rivera has 341 career assists, two away from fourth place all-time at W&J ... Junior F **Katie Hughes** averaged 9.5 ppg and 5.5 rpg last week for 1-1 Westminster ... Senior G **Audra Droginske** averaged 13.5 ppg and 3.5 rpg for 1-1 Bethany ... **Megan Gebrosky** averaged 11.5 ppg for 0-2 Grove City ... **Samantha Fisher** posted an 18-point, 10-rebound double-double for Geneva at Westminster ... FY G **Becky Rowe** scored a team-best 15 points for Chatham vs. W&J.

PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison (10-7, 6-4 PAC)



Bethany took a split in two league games last week to remain in fourth place in the PAC ... A frigid BC offense set season-lows for field goal percentage (29.3) and 3-pointers (two) in a 70-45 setback to league co-leader Saint Vincent ... **Anne Wilson** and **Katelynn Hackathorn** both scored 10 in the loss ... The Bison overcame a shaky 1st half and rallied from a 9-point halftime deficit to claim a 67-61 win over Grove City and sweep the season series from the Wolverines ... **Audra Droginske** sank 11-of-13 free throws, the most foul shots by a Bison in a game since 2005, to score a game-high 22 ... **Kayla Taormina** dropped in 12 and Hackathorn posted a double-double with 10 points and 11 boards.

Chatham Cougars (3-14, 0-10 PAC)



Chatham fell in both PAC contests this week despite efforts from top performers ... In the 68-30 loss against Thomas More, **Julianne Speeney** led the Cougars with 12 rebounds and eight points ... **Carly Zelenak** was one point shy of a double-double with nine points and 11 rebounds ... The Cougars celebrated their Cougar Fanatic Game honoring seniors **Lizz King** and **Marguerite Sargent** ... In the 85-59 loss to Washington & Jefferson, the Cougars had four players record double digits ... Among them were **Becky Rowe** (15), Zelenak (13), King (14), and Sargent (11) ... In addition to her 14 points, King tallied 11 rebounds for a double-double ... Sargent also had seven rebounds and four steals.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes (3-14, 2-8 PAC)



Geneva has dropped four straight games and have fallen to 3-14 overall and 2-8 in PAC play ... Last week, the Golden Tornadoes gave a pesky effort against Westminster but dropped a 55-43 decision despite **Samantha Fisher's** 18 points and 10 rebounds ... The GTs got another dose of the five-time defending champion Thomas More Saints Saturday in a 78-36 loss in a game that featured an 11-point effort from Fisher ... The Golden Tornadoes are one game back from eighth place in the PAC, which is where they need to finish to qualify for a post-season spot in the conference tournament ... They will look to move toward that end with games against Bethany and Waynesburg this week.

Grove City Wolverines (4-13, 3-7 PAC)



The Grove City College women's basketball team dropped a pair of hard-fought battles last week in conference play ... Against Thiel Wednesday night, three Wolverine players scored in double figures ... **Hannah Jo Coneby** led Grove City with 15 points, followed by **Megan Gebrosky** with 12 and **Leah Gibson** with 10 ... Gibson also had four assists and **Kelsey Shirey** had three assists ... Saturday at Bethany, Shirey fired in a team-high 14 points and Gebrosky had 11 ... Shirey also had nine rebounds ... GCC led by as many as 13, 24-11, in the first half and led 31-22 at halftime ... Grove City will host conference co-leaders Thomas More and Saint Vincent this week .

Saint Vincent Bearcats (14-3, 9-1 PAC)



Since losing to Waynesburg on Jan. 4, SVC has amassed a five-game win streak by an average of nearly 20 points per game ... SVC cruised to a pair of 20+ point victories this week at Bethany (70-45) and against Westminster (66-44) behind strong first-half performances ... Against the Bison, the Bearcats scored the first 13 points of the game ... Bethany cut the lead to eight points before freshman G **Jessica Welch** hit three trifectas within a seven-minute span to propel the guests to victory ... Junior F **Devin McGrath** recorded a game-high 15 points while senior F **Brittany Sedlock** posted a double-double of 14 points and 12 rebounds ... Against Westminster, Sedlock posted a game-best 17 points.

Thiel Tomcats (5-12, 5-5 PAC)



Thiel women's basketball won back-to-back PAC games against Grove City and Waynesburg last week ... Junior G **Kelly Muffley** led a quartet of Tomcats in double figures Wednesday evening against Grove City, finishing with 15 points and 10 rebounds for her third double-double of the season ... Junior F **Kelly Barzak** added 14 points, three assists and three blocks ... Senior G **Ashley Davis** totaled 12 points and eight rebounds while junior G **Kiki Jackson** had 12 points and three assists ... In the big win over Waynesburg, Muffley and Davis each scored 13 ... Barzak led the Tomcats with a game-high 17 points along with eight rebounds and a pair of blocks ... Senior G **Rianne Thornton** chipped in 10 points.

Thomas More Saints (13-4, 9-1 PAC)



Thomas More went 2-0 last week by defeating Chatham and Geneva ... The Saints averaged 73.0 ppg, while holding their two opponents to 33.3 points per game ... Sophomore G **Katie Kitchen** led the team in scoring with 14.0 ppg in only 16.5 minutes per game ... Sophomore G **Devin Beasley** led the Saints in scoring against Geneva with a career-high 14 points and fellow sophomore G **Malori Schmidt** added a career-high nine points ... For the season, Kitchen leads the team in scoring with 14.2 ppg., and sophomore F **Moriah Corey** leads the team on the boards with 6.7 rpg. ... The Saints are shooting 41.5 percent from the field (438-of-1,056) and have forced 359 turnovers.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents (9-8, 4-6 PAC)



W&J dropped a 47-43 home decision to Waynesburg Wednesday ... The Presidents were limited to just 23.9 percent (16-67) shooting ... Senior PG **Vanessa Rivera** was the lone double-figure scorer with 15 points ... W&J failed to make a three-pointer for the first time in 30 games ... The Presidents bounced back with an 85-59 victory at Chatham Saturday ... W&J has now won all 18 meetings throughout history with the Cougars ... Freshman **Valerie Dunlap** scored a career-high 16 points and pulled down 12 rebounds for her first double-double ... Senior **Ashley Kirkpatrick** also recorded a double-double with 19 points and 10 boards ... W&J's bench outscored Chatham's reserves 53-0.
