McGrath had a monster week for

the Bearcats, averaging 26.5 points, 9.5 rebounds, 4.5 steals, and 3.0 assists for the 1-1 Bearcats. In the team's 68-66 overtime loss to Thomas More on Wednesday, she posted a game-high 26 points, while adding 10 rebounds and three steals. In the Bearcats' 88-74 win over Thiel on Saturday, she went for a career-high 27 points, with nine rebounds, six steals, and four assists. In the two games, she went 19-for-36 from the field and 10-for-13 from the foul line, while hitting five three-pointers in the two games. On the year, she ranks 9th in the PAC in scoring (12.3 pts/gm), 10th in rebounding (6.5 rpg), and first in steals (63).

Also nominated was junior G Anne Wilson of Bethany, sophomore G Kelly Muffley of Thiel, senior C Nicole Dickman of Thomas More, junior G Vanessa Rivera of W&J, senior F Elisha Jones of Waynesburg, and sophomore F Katie Hughes of Westminster.



PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL 2010-11 - Week 9 Conference Notes

THOMAS MORE REMAINS UNBEATEN: An overtime clash of Top 25 women's programs highlighted the PAC basketball schedule on Wednesday ... An offensive rebound and layup with two seconds left in the first overtime was the difference as #2 Thomas More edged #23 Saint Vincent 68-66 ... The win lifted the fourtime defending PAC champion Saints into sole possession of first place ... Thomas More also defeated Grove City 51-31 on Saturday to now stand at 17-0 and 9-0 in conference play.

NEWS AND NOTES: Saint Vincent's Devin McGrath averaged 26.5 points, 9.5 rebounds, and 4.5 steals last week ... Thomas More's Nicole Dickman averaged 14 p.p.g. last week, including the game-winning put-back against No. 23-ranked Saint Vincent ... Waynesburg's Elisha Jones led the Yellow Jackets this week with 18.5 p.p.g. ... Vanessa Rivera scored a game-high 20 points in W&J's 75-64 victory at Bethany ... Christine Slater led Grove City with 17 points over Westminster.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: Thiel's Kelly Muffley had a career-high 28 points and also pulled down 11 rebounds against Saint Vincent ... Geneva's Alyse Scrarsella posted a double-double against both Waynesburg (14 pts., 10 rbds.) and W&J (18 pts., 11 rbds.) ... Colleen Kiss scored 18 points in Chatham's win over Thiel ... Westminster's Katie Hughes came off the bench and averaged 12 points against both Grove City and Bethany ... Anne Wilson led Bethany with 18 points against W&J.


Bethany Bison (8-9, 3-6 PAC)

The Bison split a pair of games last week, losing at home to W&J and beating Westminster on the road ... Bethany managed to trim a 14-point 2nd half deficit down

to 3, but could get no closer in falling 75-64 to W&J ... The offense was paced by Anne Wilson with 18 and Kayla Taormina with 17 ... After trailing by 1 at halftime at Westminster, BC outscored the Titans 35-23 after the break to pick up a 56-45 win and sweep the season series ... Kelly Zogran came off the bench to hit four three-pointers and score a team-leading 12, while Katelynn Hackathorn notched 11 markers and six boards ... Wilson went 6-for-6 from the foul line in the last minute to clinch the win and finished with 8 pts and 6 assists and Taormina totaled 7 pts and a team-high 8 rebounds.

SVC went 1-1 on the week, suffering their first PAC loss of the year in overtime to Thomas More on Wednesday, before recovering for an 88-74 win over Thiel on Saturday ... In the 68-66 setback to Thomas More, SVC recovered from a 14-

pt halftime deficit to out-score the Saints 38-24 ... TMC scored the only two field goals of the overtime, including a buzzer-beating layup for the win ... Devin McGrath led both sides with 26 pts and 10 rbds, while Brittany Sedlock scored 19 ... The Bearcats again had to recover from a sluggish first half against Thiel, breaking open a 39-39 halftime tie to out-score the Tomcats 49-35 in the second frame, shooting 61% from the floor ... Five Bearcats scored in double-figures, again led by McGrath (27) and Sedlock (19).

Thomas More Saints (17-0, 9-0 PAC)

Thomas More extended its season-opening winning streak to 17 games last week with a pair of PAC wins ... The Saints were ranked No. 2 last

week in both the D3hoops.com Top-25 and the WBCA USA Today/ ESPN Coaches' Poll ... In the two games last week the Saints had three players average in double-digit scoring as Nicole Dickman averaged 14.0 ppg, including the game-winning put-back in the Saints' overtime win over No. 23-ranked Saint Vincent, Chelsea Tolliver averaged 11.0 ppg., and Amy Stultz averaged 10.0 ppg ... Dickman also led the team in rebound with 8.5 rpg, while Stultz led the team in assists with six and Katie Kees led the team in blocks with six

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (13-4, 6-3 PAC)

Waynesburg swept a pair of games with PAC opponents this past week and are currently on their third winning streak of at least three games this season ...

The Yellow Jackets beat Geneva 64-54, and followed that up by completing a season sweep of Chatham with a 61-43 triumph ... Elisha Jones led the attack with a team-best 18.5 ppg ... She also pulled down nine rpg, blocked a squad-best four shots and played 34 minutes per game ... Brittany Spencer averaged a double-double in each of Waynesburg's two on 12 pts and 10 rpg ... The Jackets also got 11.5 ppg from Hannah Hunter, who averaged a team-high 6.5 apg, and 11 ppg from Jessi Drayer ... Both Hunter and Drayer averaged four steals per game.

Chatham Cougars (6-11, 2-7 PAC)

The Cougars broke a four-game losing streak this week with a PAC victory over Thiel ... With the score knotted at 55

with six seconds remaining, Sonjia Hoston was at the foul line and made one-of-two attempts ... Colleen Kiss scooped up the rebound and was fouled on her attempt at a shot ... Kiss connected on both of her free throw attempts and Chatham earned the 58-55 win ... Kiss finished the game with 18 pts, while teammate Carly Zelenak grabbed a career-high 10 rbds ... Chatham then hosted Waynesburg on Saturday ... The Yellow Jackets took a seven pt lead in the second half and went on a 17-5 run in the final nine minutes to secure the win ... Kayla Hilko and Lizz King each scored 10 pts in the loss ... Hoston finished the game with a game-high nine rebounds.

Grove City Wolverines (9-8, 5-4 PAC)

Grove City closed the first half of the conference schedule with a 66-57 win at Westminster ... Four Wolverines scored in double figures ... Christine Slater led the way

with 17 pts, followed by Alison Wells (14), Megan Gibson (11) and Megan Gebrosky (10) ... Saturday, Grove City opened the second half of conference play with a 51-31 lose to undefeated Thomas More ... The Wolverine defense limited the Saints to 35 percent shooting while forcing 20 turnovers ... Grove City made just one of its first 24 shots from the field, however ... Leah Gibson led the Wolverines with nine pts ... Monday, Grove City led No. 19 Mount Union 31-24 at halftime but the Raiders rallied for a 65-43 win ... Slater led Grove City with 21 pts.

Thiel Tomcats (3-14, 2-7 PAC)

Thiel dropped a pair of games last week to fall to 3-14 on the season ... Thiel fell to Chatham 58-55 ... The game went back and forth for most part, but free-throws down the

stretch gave the Cougars the win ... Ashley Davis led the way for the Tomcats as she had a double-double (11 pts, 14 rbds) ... Jasmin Jones also played well as she had a team-high 16 pts ... Chatham Cougars at Thomas More* (1/26) vs. Saint Vincent* (1/29)


