W&J won both its games last week, while Saint Vincent rallied from the TMC loss by winning at Thiel Saturday. **NEWS & NOTES:** Thomas More and W&J were ranked 14th and 22nd, respectively, by the WBCA and 17th and 23rd by <u>D3Hoops.com</u> last week... W&J has now won eight straight games, with senior PG **Kennan Killeen** averaging 14.5 ppg and 5.0 apg in a 2-0 week ... Geneva's **Alyse Scarsella** had two double-doubles for the 1-1 GTs last week, averaging 20.0 ppg and 13.5 rpg ... 
