Bethany Bison

The Bison had their five-game win streak against PAC teams stopped with losses to W&J (71-61) and #3 Thomas More (81-55) ... Bethany man-

aged to cut a 14-point second half deficit down to two, but W&J was 10-for-10 from the foul line down the stretch to secure the win ... Lisa Mitchell came off the bench to score 18 and Kelly Goode added 15 points, seven rebounds and six assists ... Against unbeaten Thomas More, BC led by six (19-13) early on, the second largest deficit the Saints have faced in a PAC game this year, but TMC rolled to a 45-28 halftime lead ... Goode scored a team-high 12, while Tara Harris and Stephanie Shafer both fired in 11.



Geneva Golden Tornadoes

Rivalry week ended with a record of 1-1 as Geneva defeated Westminster Wednesday, but suffered an upset loss to Grove City Saturday ...

Head coach **Ron Galbreath** returned to Westminster for the first time since ending his career as the men's coach for the Titans and watched his team dismantle Westminster 73-46 ... **Renee Rawding** posted 27 points on 6-of-8 shooting from three-point range, while **Allyson Clarke** added 24 points ... Saturday, the Golden Tornadoes could not get their offense on track and fell 54-45 at Grove City ... Geneva converted just five field goals in the second half as the Wolverines rallied from a four-point halftime deficit.



Saint Vincent Bearcats

The Lady Bearcats split a pair of PAC contests ... Wednesday against first place Thomas More, SVC trailed by as few as seven points on two different occasions late before the Saints held off the rally

... Janelle Reed scored a game-high 13 points, while Laura Klimchock added 11 ... The Lady Bearcats rebounded Saturday, and beat visiting Westminster 91-64 ... Reed again led the way, scoring 31 points, going 13-of-20 from the field including five three-pointers ... Klimchock added 17 points, Ashley Campbell a career-high 15, and Caryn Glassbrenner 11 ... Glassbrenner also equaled her single-game school record with seven blocked shots.



Thomas More Saints

Freshman **Nicole Dickman** recorded her first two career double-doubles as No. 3 Thomas More remained unbeaten with two wins over

PAC teams ... Dickman tallied a career-high 19 points with 10 rebounds in the Saints win over Bethany, and scored 11 points with a career-high 14 rebounds as Thomas More held off Saint Vincent Freshman **Caitlin Mauch** set a new career scoring high, twice, this week ... She scored 10 points at Saint Vincent, then topped her effort with 12 against the Bison.



Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

After posting their lowest offensive point total in recent history Wednesday against Chatham, Waynesburg played a solid game Saturday, but

suffered a 55-50 loss to Thiel ... Against the Cougars, the Yellow Jackets managed just 27 points, including just six in the first half on 1-of-18 shooting from the field ... Over the weekend, three starters scored in double figures and freshman F **Elisha Jones** finished with a double-double of 13 points and 10 rebounds ... Junior Fs **Jeanette Wonsettler** and **Michaelene Jones** added 12 and 11 points, respectively ... The Yellow Jackets led by as many as 11 points in the second half before Thiel rallied to seize control.



Chatham Cougars

Chatham was 2-1 on the week, including earning a 68-36 non-conference win over visiting Wilson College to open the week on Monday ... Libby

Soeder led the Cougars with 13 points. Chatham used a balanced scoring attack and stifling defense to win at Waynesburg 46-27 on Wednesday ... **Kayla Hilko** had a team-high nine points ... Saturday the Cougars lost to W&J on the road by a 72-43 margin ... **Brittany Brown** had 14 points in defeat.



Grove City Wolverines

Grove City's second-half surge continued last week as the Wolverines earned a pair of victories ... Defense played a pivotal role in each win ... The Wolverines forced 22 Thiel turnovers and lim-

ited Thiel to just 29 percent shooting from the field ... Against Geneva, Grove City yielded just 19 second-half points in rallying from a 26-22 halftime deficit ... **Shannon Overdorff** led GCC with 17 points at Thiel Wednesday, while **Krista Beechy** added 12 ... Saturday, freshman **Christine Slater** had 12 points and nine rebounds while **Brittany Anderson** added 10 points ... Overdorff recorded nine points, eight boards, six assists, and three steals.



Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats finished the week 1-1, falling at home to Grove City 65-54 Wednesday before winning 55-50 at Waynesburg Saturday ... Against GCC, junior

G Amber Bodrick tallied 16 points, 12 rebounds and eight assists ... Junior G Catie Sieber added 14 points and four rebounds, while freshman F Kim Stitt chipped in with six points and 10 boards... Bodrick filled the stat sheet for the Tomcats in their win against the Yellow Jackets, finishing with 26 points, 12 rebounds, six steals, four blocks and three assists ... The Tomcats finished with a 41-38 rebounding advantage against Waynesburg and recorded a season-high 16 steals.



Washington & Jefferson Presidents

The Presidents increased their win streak to four games and took over sole possession of second place in the PAC last week ... Sophomore F **Maggie Gibson** had a monster game against Bethany with 26 points (11-of-14 shooting), nine rebounds, three

assists, two blocks and two steals ... Gibson leads NCAA Division III in shooting percentage ... Junior F **Emily Hays** added 19 points, while sophomore PG **Kennan Killeen** drained all 12 of her free throw attempts ... Senior F **Jen Rogers** pumped in a career-high 23 points Saturday versus Chatham ... Gibson pulled down 15 rebounds, while sophomore G **Stephanie Smith** had eight assists.

Westminster Titans



Westminster is in the midst of a season-long three-game losing streak after suffering a pair of 27-point losses to D-III provisional members last week ... The Titans lost at home to Geneva,

73-46, Wednesday before losing 91-64 at Saint Vincent Saturday ... Senior G/F **Emilee Ackerman** averaged a team-high 21.0 points per game ... Her 16 points and 10 rebounds vs. Geneva was her eighth double-double of the season ... Ackerman also scored 26 points at Saint Vincent as she moved into fourth place on the team's career scoring list with 1,202 points, surpassing **Colleen Dion**'s mark of 1,185 from 1992-96.

After playing four of the last five games on the road, the Bison return home Wednesday to host Waynesburg ... Bethany won the first meeting this season 65-47 on Dec. 5, as they forced 39 Yellow Jacket turnovers ... **Kelly Goode** led all scorers with 19 points ... Saturday, Bethany will try to even the season series with Geneva after suffering a 79-68 overtime loss on Dec. 8 ... The Bison forced OT on a late hoop by Tara Harris, but the Golden Tornadoes scored the first six points of the extra session to seize control.

Geneva is playing W&J for the first time in 20

In the all-time series, Geneva leads 4-2 in just six previous meetings ... Saturday, Geneva will look for the season sweep against Bethany after a 79-68 victory back on December 8th ... In that win, **Allyson Clarke** posted 25 points and 18 rebounds to lead the way.

Four players reached double figures, including **Jennifer Teski**'s career-high 14 points, as the Saints defeated Thiel, 84-46, earlier this season ... TMC leads the series with the Tomcats, 5-0 ... W&J and Geneva meet for the first time in Washing-

ton since the 1987-88 season Wednesday ... Geneva has claimed four of the previous seven meetings in history, including a 48-46 defensive struggle on Dec. 5 in Beaver Falls ... W&J's last win in the series came on Jan. 12, 1982, in Beaver Falls by a 57-53 margin ... W&J has won 15 of the last 19 games in the Grove City series and leads throughout history by a 33-22 count.



Westminster Titans

The Titans won at Grove City, 50-45, on Dec. 5 and lost at Thomas More, 79-59, on Dec. 8 ... **Emilee Ackerman** scored 24 and 20 points to lead the Titans in each game, respectively ... The Saints were ranked 11th in the nation when they last played Westminster ... Now, TMC is ranked third as the highest-ranked women's basketball team in PAC history.
