PAC Women's Basketball Player of the Week

SHAWNDRA MCDONALD

Washington & Jefferson College

5-3 Sophomore Guard Houston, Tex./Westfield H.S.

McDonald earned PAC Player of the Week laurels for the second time this season after averaging 28.0 points, 5.5 assists, 4.0 rebounds, 2.5 steals and 1.0 blocks per game for the 1-1 Presidents. She scored 20 points, including 15 in the second half, in a 53-52 loss to Grove City on Wednesday. McDonald then came back on Saturday with a career-high 36 points in a 76-73 win over Waynesburg. For the week, she connected on 56 percent of her field goal attempts (22-of-39) and 60 percent of her three-point attempts (6-of-10).

Also nominated was sophomore forward/center **Kelley Richardson** of Bethany, senior forward **Erica Youngman** of Grove City, and junior forward **Kyana Bradley** of Waynesburg.

PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison

With two more victories last week, Bethany ran its winning streak to eight games, the longest stretch in Head Coach Jina DeRubbo's five-year tenure ... Guard Kristy Baker erupted for a career-high 27 points as the Bison knocked off Waynesburg Wednesday ... The 5-6 junior, whose previous career-high was 17, was 11-14 from the floor and 5-7 from the arc ... Bethany held a 45-38 advantage on the glass, including 18 offensive boards, and forced 27 Lady Cat turnovers in a 72-55 road win at Thiel ... Forward Kelley Richardson notched her 12th double-double of the year with 26 points and 16 rebounds, while Katie Hardie had 13, Kiki Cohen tallied 11 and Katie Tetzlaw grabbed 10 rebounds.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

The Presidents split a pair of PAC home contests this week, falling to Grove City at the buzzer, 53-52, and defeating Waynesburg, 76-73 ... Both contests came down to last second shots as Erica Youngman's lay-up with one second left gave Grove City the one-point win, however, Waynesburg's Trisha Pollock's potential game-tying three-pointer rimmed out at the buzzer ... Sophomore guard Stephanie Ceraso scored 15 of her 17 points against the Yellow Jackets, marking the second-best scoring day of her career ... Junior forward Amy Strosnider, playing against her hometown team Waynesburg, scored 12 points and grabbed a team-best 10 boards.

Grove City Lady Wolverines

The Lady Wolverines had a four-game winning streak stopped at Westminster on Saturday as the Lady Titans rallied from an 18-point second-half deficit to post a five-point win ... Junior Cara Denniston and freshman Abby Moose scored 12 points each in the loss ... Senior Erica Youngman highlighted the week with a buzzer-beater at Washington & Jefferson on Wednesday that sent the Lady Wolverines to a 53-52 victory and a perfect 3-0 record in the PAC ... Youngman finished with a team-high 10 points and six rebounds ... The win marked nine-year head coach Melissa Lamie's first at W&J's Henry Memorial Center.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Jackets hope to end a season-long five-game losing streak when they travel to face La Roche College in a non-conference matchup Monday evening ... The Jackets defeated La Roche 54-46 on Nov. 19 ... Freshman Candace Newman has scored in double figures in each of the last five Jackets games. scoring 66 points during that span ... Junior forward Kyana Bradley posted 21 points and 18 rebounds in three games last week.

Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats went 0-2 last week and have lost four of their last six contests ... Sophomore Amanda Swanson scored a game-high 27 points with seven rebounds in their 71-61 loss to Westminster ... Thiel pulled to within three, 62-59, with just over a minute to play after Swanson connected on a three, but would not get any closer as the Titans closed the game with seven free throws in the final 62 seconds ... Trailing Bethany 31-25 at the half, the Tomcats allowed the Bison to pull out to a 15-point lead, 46-31, with 14:31 left to play ... Thiel was just 8-of-15 from the line, while Bethany hit 20-of-31 free throws ... Seniors Sara Snyder and Jennifer Barnes each finished with 10 points in the loss.

Westminster Lady Titans

Westminster ran its win streak to three games this week, as the Lady Titans topped PAC opponents Thiel (71-61) and Grove City (67-62) ... Westminster trailed the Lady Wolverines by 16 (37-21) at halftime before rallying for the five-point win ... Barring injury, Lady Titan senior Robin Thayer will likely become the program's all-time leading scorer this week ... Thayer currently has 1,166 career points and is just 20 points away from surpassing Colleen Dion (1,185 points from 1992-96) as the program's all-time leading scorer ... Freshman point guard Alyson Gasper scored a careerhigh 10 points off the bench in the win over Grove City.

Upcoming Game Notes: First place in the PAC will be on the line when the Bison trek to Grove City Wednesday night ... Bethany took two of three from the Wolverines last year, with each team winning on the road and the Bison taking the rubber match in the semifinals of the PAC Tournament ... Grove City leads the series 21-14 ... The Westminster game is a rematch of the Jan. 16 contest, won by the Bison 77-57 in New Wilmington behind **Kelley Richardson**'s 26 points and 17 rebounds ... The Pitt-Bradford match-up is the second meeting ever, the first coming in 1998, a 77-60 Bethany triumph.
