PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL PLAYER OF THE WEEK

AMBER BODRICK Thiel College

5-8 Freshman Forward Boardman, Ohio/Cardinal Mooney H.S.

Bodrick captured the award for the second consecutive week after scoring a school-record 51 points for the Tomcats in a 92-89 home overtime win over PAC rival Bethany Wednesday. The 51 markers are the most by any PAC player (male or female) and the most by any women's player in all three NCAA divisions this season. For the week, Bodrick averaged 33.5 points and 9.0 rebounds and shot 57 percent from the field for the 1-1 Tomcats.

Also nominated was junior F **Courtney Irwin** of Bethany, senior G **Tammy Hess** of Grove City, senior F **Lauren Slampak** of Washington & Jefferson, junior F **Denise Kennedy** of Waynesburg, and junior G **Desiree Sterling** of Westminster.

Bethany Bison

The Bison fell victim to a record-setting performance at Thiel, then recovered for a five-point win over Westminster on Saturday ... Thiel's **Amber Bodrick** scored 14 of her school-record 51 points in OT, as the Tomcats scored an im-

probable 92-89 win Wednesday ... G Lisa Mitchell scored all of her team-high 18 points after halftime, while F Courtney Irwin finished with 17 ... BC then had five players score in double figures to pull out a 78-73 triumph over Westminster ... Irwin reached double figures for the fourth straight game with a game-best 16 points, while G Ashley Zemba had 13, Mitchell and G/F Jenny Place both had 11 and C Renee Brandenburg notched 10.



Grove City Wolverines

Grove City fell to 2-4 in the PAC with a hardfought 58-45 setback at Washington & Jefferson Wednesday night ... Grove City limited the Presidents to 35 percent shooting from the field ... However, the Wolverines shot just

29 percent from the floor and committed 23 turnovers ... **Tammy Hess** led Grove City with an 11-point, 10-rebound double-double ... It was her first career double-double ... She is the third different Grove City player to have a double-double this year, joining **Brittany Anderson** and **Rachel McCoy** ... McCoy added 11 points and eight boards.



Thiel Tomcats

The Thiel women went 1-1 in PAC action last week ... Behind freshman F **Amber Bodrick**'s single-game high 51 points, the Tomcats posted a 92-89 overtime win at home against Bethany Wednesday before suffering a 68-44 loss at Thomas More Saturday ... Bodrick's 51 points

are the most by any player in the PAC and the most by any female in all NCAA divisions this season ... Trailing by three vs. Bethany, junior F **Fontella Jones** was fouled on a three-point attempt with no time remaining, giving her the opportunity to tie the game and send it into overtime ... Jones knocked down all three of her free throws to extend the game for Thiel.



Thomas More Saints

Thomas More kicked off the second leg of conference play with a huge win over Thiel as junior **Megan Wood** led

the Saints with 16 points and nine rebounds ... The Saints led start to finish in posting their sixth PAC win and maintaining a first-place tie with Washington & Jefferson ... Thomas More's defense held the Tomcats to just 30 percent shooting ... In the loss to Wittenberg, Thomas More held the Tigers scoreless for more than six minutes as they trimmed a 13-point deficit to one point ... However, they couldn't get over the hump and fell in a key non-conference game.



Washington & Jefferson Presidents

W&J extended its win streak to five games last week with victories over GCC and Waynesburg ... Freshman G **Kaleigh Bangor** nailed a threepointer with five minutes left Wednesday which helped W&J finally put away Grove City ... The Presidents limited GCC to 29 percent (15-of-52) shooting, including just 21 percent in the second

half ... Senior G Leigh Sulkowski led all scorers with 14 points on 5-of-14 shooting, while adding seven rebounds and four steals ... Senior F Lauren Slampak finished with 12 points, six rebounds and four steals, while Bangor totaled eight points, four rebounds and three assists ... W&J used a 23-3 run to begin the second half Saturday and got a late defensive stand to defeat the Yellow Jackets by one point ... Sulkowski led all scorers with 24 points on 8-of-14 shooting ... Slampak added 18 points.

Westminster Lady Titans



Westminster dropped road PAC contests last week at Waynesburg (62-59) and Bethany (78-73) ... Sophomore G/F **Emilee Ackerman** led Westminster with team-high totals of 17 points and four steals against the Yellow Jackets, while junior G **Desiree Sterling** posted a double-double with 12 points and a gamehigh 11 rebounds ... Junior G **Rachel Eaton** and sophomore F **Terese Marszalek** each dished out four assists in the loss ... At Bethany, the Lady Titans managed five scorers in double digits, led by Sterrling with

13 points ... Other top scorers included Ackerman and junior G **Nicole Fee** with 12 points each, while Eaton and freshman G **Gina Brunetti** each scored 10, with Brunetti setting a new career-high ... Sterling and Eaton paced the team in rebounding with eight apiece.



Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

After defeating Westminster, 62-59, Wednesday, Waynesburg nearly upset Washington & Jefferson Saturday, losing 54-53 ... The Yellow Jackets shot 41 percent from beyond the arc against the Titans, as guards **Rachel Dillon** and **Katie Lewandowski** each netted multiple threepointers ... Lewandowski and F **Denise Kennedy**

had 18 markers each, while Dillon netted a season-high 13, including a pair of free throws in the closing seconds to seal the victory Waynesburg staked a 30-22 halftime lead against the Presidents Saturday, however, after an early second-half bucket, the Jackets failed to score a field goal for a 13-minute stretch ... Waynesburg held the Presidents scoreless over the game's final four minutes, but a potential game-winning jumper in the final seconds was blocked by W&J to prevent the upset.

Bethany gets its second crack at PAC-leading Thomas More Wednesday ... The Bison suf-

fered a 71-57 defeat in Kentucky on Jan. 7 ... Lisa Mitchell (16), Jenny Place (15) and Courtney Irwin (15) combined for 45 of the team's 57 points ... In BC's 82-71 victory over Waynesburg Jan. 11, Place netted 21 and Mitchell scored 19 ... Bethany has out-rebounded its opponents in six straight games, which comes after the Bison were on the short-end of the rebounding battle in eight of their first 14 games ... While the Bison are 6-3 at home this season, they are just 1-10 away from Hummel Field House, with the lone win over St. Lawrence at the Rochester Tip-Off Tournament.

Grove City will try to complete a season sweep of Westminster Wednesday ... GCC pulled out a 51-42 home win over the Lady Titans

Jan. 11 ... The Wolverines won last year's meeting in New Wilmington, 70-64, Feb. 5, 2005 and lead the all-time series, 33-21 ... Thomas More makes its first-ever trip to the GCC Arena Saturday ... Thomas More won the first meeting, 74-56, Jan. 16 ... That defeated started Grove City's current four-game slide ... Washington & Jefferson Presidents

at Westminster* (2/4 - 2 p.m.)

Washington & Jefferson took a 10-9 lead in the all-time series with Westminster after knocking off the Lady Titans, 60-41, two weeks ago at the Henry Memorial Center ... Seniors Leigh Sulkowski and Amanda Stanonik both scored

19 points for W&J which outscored Westminster by a 33-17 margin in the second half ... The Presidents also limited the Lady Titans to 29 percent shooting ... Over the past three seasons, W&J has won seven of the eight matchups.
