PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL PLAYER OF THE WEEK

MARY JANE EATON

Westminster College

5-7 Senior Forward Rimersburg, Pa./Union H.S.

Eaton averaged 21.0 points, 9.5 rebounds and 2.5 steals per game as the Lady Titans went 1-1 in PAC play. She posted a game-high 25 points with 11 rebounds and four steals in a 65-55 loss to league leader W&J Wednesday, then posted a team-best 17 points and eight caoms in a 64-51 win at Waynesburg Saturday.

Also nominated was junior F **Jenny Place** of Bethany, freshman F **Rachel McCoy** of Grove City, and junior G **Leigh Sulkowski** of Washington & Jefferson.

PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison

The Bison women continue to slip toward the middle of the PAC after splitting two contests this week with conference foes ... Against Grove City, the women were held to only one field goal over the final 11 minutes in a 61-50 loss Saturday ... Katie Resanovich scored a team-high 10 points while Jenny Place scored nine points ... Nicole Vlajkovich garnered a team-best 13 rebounds in the loss ... Against Waynesburg, Bethany kept the Yellow Jackets winless in the PAC, pulling out a 78-73 victory ... Place controlled the pace of the game by tying her career-high with 24 points and nabbing eight rebounds - both of which were also gamehighs ... Nikki Babik added 20 points for the Bison.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J's win streak reached seven games last week as the Presidents posted wins at Westminster and vs. Thiel ... The Presidents won the battle of the PAC's top two teams Wednesday as juniors Leigh Sulkowski and Lauren Slampak combined for 40 points and 15 rebounds ... W&J took a 32-26 halftime lead and held off a second half rally to earn the win ... Sulkowski finished with 24 points, while Slampak added 16 ... Fifteen different Presidents scored on Saturday in the 26point rout of Thiel ... Sulkowski scored 21 points in 20 minutes, while junior F Amanda Stanonik added 10 markers ... Freshman F Maria Hillenbrand added eight points and five boards ... Sophomore G Katie Davies chipped in with six points and four assists.

Grove City Lady Wolverines

Grove City closed the first half of the PAC schedule with a pair of victories last week, holding the opposition to a combined 100 points in the two games ... Four GCC players scored 10 points each in Saturday's win at Bethany: Abby Moose, Rachel McCoy, Sandy O'Keefe and Rachel Romance ... The Wolverines held Bethany to one field goal over the final 13 minutes ... Moose had four of Grove City's 13 steals ... Romance added six assists and three steals in the win ... Moose had a team-high 15 points against Thiel while McCoy added 14 points and nine rebounds ... Brittany Anderson posted a 12-point, 10-rebound double-double, the first of her career.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg remains winless in PAC play with losses to Bethany (78-73) and Westminster (64-51) ... Against the Bison, the Yellow Jackets shot 42.6 percent from the field, their highest in seven games ... Senior G Ashley Urban tied her career-high with 18 points on 7-of-12 shooting, including 4-of-8 on three-pointers ... Junior Candice Eyerman scored 17 points in the loss, after consecutive games being held under 10 points ... Reserve G Katie Lewandowski added 16 points against the Bison and 13 against the Titans ... Westminster limited Waynesburg to 27.8 percent shooting and forced 16 turnovers ... Junior G/F Trista Murphy led the Jackets with 15 points, while Eyerman led the team with eight | eight apiece ... Freshman G Emilee rebounds.

Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats suffered a pair of road losses last week, falling at Grove City (73-50) Wednesday and at Wash. & Jeff. (84-58) Saturday ... Against the Wolverines freshman G Ariel Venesky knocked down a three to chip the lead to 10 (48-38) at the 11:05 mark of the second half before the Wolverines outscored the visitors 15-4 over the next 7:13 to go up 21 (63-42) ... Senior C Kristen Benjamin led Thiel with 15 points and a career-high 14 rebounds ... Sophomore G Nicole Valentino added 11 and nine boards ... Against W&J, sophomore F Fontella Jones paced Thiel with 13 points and three assists ... Valentino and junior G Heather Abate each added eight points in the loss.

Westminster Lady Titans

Westminster split a pair of PAC games last week, falling to W&J 65-55 Wednesday in a battle for first place before rebounding with a 64-51 win at Waynesburg Saturday ... The Presidents snapped the Lady Titans' five-game win streak despite a career-high 25 points and 11 rebounds by senior F Mary Jane Eaton ... Senior F Erica Tallo also grabbed a team-best 11 rebounds ... Eaton added four steals and freshman F Cherrell Triplett recorded a game-high four blocked shots ... Westminster broke open a 30-30 halftime tie by outscoring Waynesburg 34-21 in the second half ... Eaton led the team in scoring with 17 markers, while tying Tallo for team rebound honors with Ackerman added 13 points.

Freshman G **Emilee Ackerman** also reached double figures in scoring with 12 points, including 11 in the opening half.
