Zitt led the Titans to a 2-0 week against PAC competition by averaging 15.0 points and 8.5 rebounds per game. She posted a solid all-around line with 12 points, eight boards, two assists, one block and one steal Wednesday, as Westminster posted a 68-66 upset win at home over third-place Waynesburg. On Saturday, Zitt scored a game-high 18 points and added nine caroms, as the Titans recorded a come-from-behind 61-55 road decision at Thiel.

Also nominated was junior G/F **Kayla Taormina** of Bethany, sophomore F **Carly Zelenak** of Chatham, senior G **Emily Fenton** of Saint Vincent, sophomore F **Moriah Corey** of Thomas More, senior PG **Vanessa Rivera** of Washington & Jefferson, and junior G **Jessia Drayer** of Waynesburg.

### PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL 2011-12 - Week 10 Conference Notes

**TMC/SVC STILL TIED:** The race for the 2011-12 PAC women's basketball title remained tied at the top this week, as league co-leaders Thomas More and Saint Vincent each went 2-0 and remain tied for first entering the final three weeks of the regular season ... Waynesburg suffered its second straight loss Wednesday, falling at Westminster on a **Jenn Cantella** buzzer-beater, but remains in third place in the standings, one game ahead of fourth-place Bethany.

**NEWS AND NOTES:** Waynesburg senior G **Hannah Hunter** and Saint Vincent senior G **Emily Fenton** (19.5 ppg in two SVC wins) each passed the career 1,000-point plateau Wednesday ... Westminster sophomore G **Courtney Zitt** averaged 15.0 ppg and 8.5 rpg for the 2-0 Titans ... Bethany junior G/F **Kayla Taormina** averaged 14.5 points, 6.0 rebounds and 3.5 assists for 2-0 Bethany ... Sophomore F **Moriah Corey** averaged a double-double (11.0 ppg, 10.0 rpg) during a 2-0 week for Thomas More.

**AROUND THE LEAGUE:** Junior G **Jessi Drayer** averaged 21.0 ppg on the week for 1-1 Waynesburg ... Junior F **Kelly Barzak** averaged a double-double (14.5 ppg, 10.0 rpg, 4.0 bpg) for 0-2 Thiel ... Sophomore F **Carly Zelenak** averaged 13.0 ppg for 0-2 Chatham, including a double-double vs. Saint Vincent ... Senior PG **Vanessa Rivera** averaged 9.5 ppg and 9.0 apg for 1-1 W&J ... **Hannah Jo Coneby** averaged 12.0 ppg for 0-2 Grove City ... **Beth DeLuca** also averaged 12.0 ppg for 0-2 Geneva.

# PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

## Bethany Bison (12-7, 8-4 PAC)



Bethany continued its typical second half surge by taking a pair of games last week to improve to 8-4 in the PAC ... The Bison shot a season-best 50 percent from the floor and held a 41-20 rebounding advantage in taking a 66-43 victory at Geneva ... **Anne Wilson** scored 14 of her game-high 16 in the 1<sup>st</sup> half, while **Renee Shepherd** had 12 points, six rebounds and five steals and Kelly Zogran hit for 10 off the bench ... The Bison trailed by as many as 11 in the first half against Chatham but shot 51 percent in the second to rally for a 77-67 win ... **Kayla Taormina** led the rally with 19 of her career-high-tying 24 points after halftime and added six assists ... **Audra Droginske** posted 15 points and seven steals.

## Chatham Cougars (3-16, 0-12 PAC)



Chatham fell in both PAC contests this week despite efforts from top performers ... In the loss against St. Vincent, **Carly Zelenak** led the way with a double-double (13 points, 10 rebounds) ... **Marguerite Sargent** recorded 10 points, seven rebounds, and three steals ... Saturday, Chatham played a close game against Bethany ... The Cougars were in the lead at the end of the first half, 39-33 ... Their performance slipped in the second and Bethany was able to sneak by with a 10-point lead for the 77-67 final ... **Lizz King** recorded 20 points and seven rebounds ... She was joined by Sargent with 15 points and Zelenak with 13 points, seven rebounds, and six steals.

## Geneva Golden Tornadoes (3-16, 2-10 PAC)



Geneva women's basketball has dropped six consecutive games and sits at 3-16 overall and 2-10 in the conference ... The Golden Tornadoes still have an opportunity to reach the eight-team PAC post-season tournament with a late-season surge ... They are just one game behind Grove City for that eighth place spot as they welcome the Wolverines to Metheny Fieldhouse Wednesday night ... Last week, Geneva dropped PAC games to Bethany and Waynesburg despite double digit scoring efforts from **Beth DeLuca** and **Samantha Fisher** ... The GTs have six conference games remaining on the regular season schedule, including Grove City and Chatham this week.

## Grove City Wolverines (4-15, 3-9 PAC)



Grove City dropped a pair of games against PAC pace-setters Thomas More and Saint Vincent last week ... In a 66-52 setback against Thomas More Wednesday, the Wolverines held the Saints to 6-for-21 (29 percent) shooting in the second half ... **Leah Gibson** led GCC with 17 points while **Hannah Jo Coneyby** added 12 points and seven rebounds ... Coneyby paced Grove City with a dozen points and Gibson collected 10 Saturday in an 81-52 setback against Saint Vincent ... GCC shot 49 percent (23 of 47) from the field, but allowed the Bearcats to shoot 55 percent (31 of 56) ... **Megan Gebrosky** recorded five assists ... The Wolverines will visit Geneva Wednesday night before hosting Westminster Saturday.

## Saint Vincent Bearcats (16-3, 11-1 PAC)



The Bearcats went 2-0 this week behind a pair of 29-point victories ... In Wednesday's 74-45 win over Chatham, senior G **Emily Fenton** matched her career high with 23 points as she became the 24<sup>th</sup> player in program history to eclipse the 1,000-point plateau ... She joins classmate F **Brittany Sedlock**, who reached the mark earlier this season at Messiah ... SVC had its highest scoring half of the season in the first half at Grove City on Saturday, racing out to a 48-28 lead at the break ... In the win, junior F **Devin McGrath** posted game-highs in every stat category ... She led all players with 17 points, nine rebounds, six assists, three steals and two blocks.

## Thiel Tomcats (5-14, 5-7 PAC)



The Tomcats went 0-2 last week against the Presidents of Washington & Jefferson and the Titans of Westminster ... In the loss to the Presidents, junior F **Kelly Barzak** recorded her third double-double of the season when she led Thiel with 15 points, 10 rebounds and three blocks ... She went 4-of-8 from the floor and 7-of-8 from the free throw line ... Senior G **Ashley Davis** was the Tomcats' other lone scorer in double figures with 14 points and four rebounds ... Against Westminster, once again Barzak had a big game with 14 points, 10 rebounds, and five blocks ... **Kelly Muffley** (15 pts) and Davis (12 points) were the only other Tomcats in double-figures, as the Tomcats fell 61-55.

## Thomas More Saints (15-4, 11-1 PAC)



Thomas More went 2-0 last week by defeating Grove City and Washington & Jefferson both on the road ... Sophomore G **Katie Kitchen** led three Saints, who averaged double-figures scoring with 18.5 points per game ... Joining her in double-figures was junior G **Allison Long** with 17.5 ppg., and sophomore F **Moriah Corey** with 11.0 ppg., and 10.0 rebounds per game for a double-double ... For the season, Kitchen leads the team in scoring with 14.7 ppg., and Corey leads the team on the boards with 67.1 rpg. ... The Saints are shooting 41.9 percent from the field as they are connecting on 492-of-1,174 field goals and have forced 386 turnovers.

## Washington & Jefferson Presidents (10-9, 5-7 PAC)



W&J earned a season-series split with Thiel by downing the Tomcats 66-51 Wednesday in Washington ... Senior **Kayla Strimel** tied a career-high with 17 points ... Senior PG **Vanessa Rivera** added five points, nine assists, four rebounds and four steals ... During the week, Rivera moved into sole possession of fourth place on the all-time assist list at W&J with 359 ... Senior **Blair Cotton** led W&J with 16 points and seven rebounds in an 83-64 loss to Thomas More Saturday ... Rivera narrowly missed a double-double with 14 points and nine assists ... The Presidents and Saints were tied 41-41 with 17:15 remaining, but an 11-0 TMC spurt proved to be the difference.

## Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (14-5, 9-3 PAC)



Waynesburg bounced back from a heart-breaking loss at Westminster with a home win against Geneva ... After dropping a 68-66 contest with the Titans, the Yellow Jackets shot 50 percent from the field on their way to a 78-42 win over the Golden Tornadoes ... Four different Jackets reached double digits in the victory ... The quartet was led by junior G **Jessi Drayer**, who poured in a game-high 19 points ... Drayer had a big week, averaging a team-high 21 ppg ... Junior F **Paige Pearce** and senior PG **Hannah Hunter** averaged 11.0 and 10.0 points per game, respectively ... Hunter joined the Jackets' 1,000-point club and eclipsed 400 career assists Wednesday after going for 18 points and two helpers in the loss.

## Westminster Titans (6-12, 6-6 PAC)



On Wednesday versus Waynesburg, the Lady Titans came out of the gates shooting 53.8% from the floor and 67% from beyond the arc in the first half ... Junior **Jenn Cantella** finished off the Yellow Jackets as time expired in regulation with a jumper to win it 68-66 ... Classmate **Danielle Gilmore** scored a career-high 13, including 7-of-10 from the free throw line ... In the win on Saturday at Thiel, the Titans shot an impressive 87% (20-for-23) from the free throw line as sophomore **Courtney Zitt** led the way with 18 points and nine rebounds.
